Arrest Made In Eric Mansfield Murder

As first reported in the Dec. 7 **R&R Country Daily**, Metro Nashville police have made an arrest in the **Eric Mansfield** murder investigation. **Deonvelt Miller**, 16, has been apprehended for the crime, according to a police spokesperson. Mansfield, Dir./Creative Services for Warner Bros./Nashville, was shot on the evening of Nov. 11 while sitting in his car near his East Nashville home. A reward of \$26,000, including \$25,000 from Warner Bros., had been offered for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the perpetrator.

Band Escapes Tragic Crash

Sawyer Brown were involved in a fatal crash Saturday near Topeka, KS. A 24-year-old single mother of three, driving alone, pulled out in front of the band's tour bus, which was traveling at approximately 50 mph. Jessica Mossman's car was caught under the bus, and both vehicles caught fire. Mossman died instantly, while the band was just able to escape before the bus was consumed. The group's show that night was postponed to Dec. 17.

Reward Offered In Garcia Murder

KUZZ/Bakersfield has posted a \$10,000 reward through the Kern County secret witness program for the arrest and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the murder of MD **Karen Garcia**. Initially thought to be of natural causes, Garcia's death has since been ruled a homicide.






