Apparently, stations operate on 'fear,' waiting for the Biblical Billboard or Cash Box before adding a record. Fear does not encourage creativity! I'm sick of radio in this town as are most people within or without of my peers. I've discussed it with an endless filibuster I could give you here, but I could give you here, but God I hope somebody will wakeup and discover true sales in this business as opposed to radio airplay.

Reviewer's Reaction: As part of this summer's Ann Arbor Art Fair (a really large scale, citywide, four day big deal visited by thousands) The Eclipse Jazz Collective, the same people who produce jazz shows for the University of Michigan, decided to bring some aural stimulation to what is still a primarily visual festival. 48 hours of quality music, mostly jaz and all performed by Ann Arbor musicians, was presented from 3 stages set up among the exhibits and booths. We at WCBN-FM set up phone lines at one stage and broadcast nearly 24 hours of the music. Melodioso, a 5 man salsa-jazz group probably received the

strongest audience reaction. Their set which closed Thursday evening's activities was wildly received by a street rull of people who didn't expect to be dancing in the street. Melodioso combines the light-as-a-feather feeling of the first Return to Forever group with a pulsing percu, six bottom. Flute, keyboards and lots of rhythm are the simple incredients. The set was mostly instrumental but did include short vocal passages, sometimes in Spanish. Melodioso has put together in engaging blend that some to "cross-over" to a non-Latin audience more effectively than the two Columbia "Fania All-Stars" Lp's. I believe that authentic salsa, judiciously programmed, can add a plansingly wotic edge to a progressive-FM on dure. After reading the Concepts section in the August 1 issue, I felt that I had to write to disagree with your conclusions.

All of the evidence offered on the Gregg Allman album is correct I think. However, I think you may have erred in your conclusion,

I would suggest that rather than politics fading away and rock and roll continuing on, what is more likely is that most radio programmers today never had any political interest in Gregg's drug involvement and if they were interested in the Cher affair, it was only on the level of a teen magazine or people magazine reader.

Rather than playing his album because they hold no grudges I believe they play his album because they are familiar with his name. There seems to be a heavy reliance upon the rames from the late 60's and early 70's. The continuation of airplay on an artist because of consistently high quality

of recording is meritous, but I would rather suspect the continued airplay is because most programmers don't ha an ear for music and therefore rely on 'hames' for prodon't have gramming.

I think we are all well aware of countless albums released by people that signify they would have been wiser to retire some years ago. I think perhaps the same can be said for many programmers who are in their present positions because they have not yet decided what they want to do for a living

There was a time and there was a music called progressive. We now cop to a name called AOR. Although that is supposed to be my particular field of expertise, I would think that the most appropriate designation would be MOR.
