RUCORDS AS THE SONIC WEAR LEVE

Our retail reporters have been rather vocal for years about what they view as the declining quality of record pressures.

Part of the problem is that our ears play games with us. For example, American record junkies often rave about Earope in pressings. While Europeans think that pressings from the ISA are to be sought out. These divergent perceptions are, of course, mutually exclusive.

Another part of the problem is that the electronics industry has made great advances in the last ten years. Today's his fidelity equipment, of even modest price levels, is annazingly sophisticated compared to years past. During this same period of time there has not been an equal advance in the proporty of the property of the proper in mass production, record pressing techniques.
