RADIO STATS

OUR RELATIVE CHARTING, AS SEEN BELOW, RESEMBLES BASEBALL'S BATTING AVERAGES. IT ESTABLISHES A RATIO BETWEEN THE IDEAL, (HEAVY AIRPLAY AT EVERY STATION WHICH REPORTED); AND THE WEIGHTED COUNT THAT A RECORDING HAS ACTUALLY EARNED. THIS MATHEMATICAL FORMULA IS APPLIED TO EACH RECORD—FIRST REGIONALLY, THEN NATIONALLY. A DUAL WEIGHTING SYSTEM IS USED TO DERIVE THE COUNT. IT ADJUSTS FOR MARKET SIZE AND FOR HEAVY OR MODERATE AIRPLAY. THESE CHARTS SHOW THE RELATIVE INTENSITY OF RADIO AIRPLAY FOR BOTH NEW AND ESTABLISHED RECORDINGS.

INTERVIEWS AVAILABLE - Sept. 11th marked the 4th anniversary of the U.S. - sponsored coup which overthrew the democratically-elected government of Salvador Allende and installed a vicious military junta in its place in Chile. Sept. 21st will mark the 12th month since agents of the Chilean secret police assassinated a former high official of the Allende government in exile here, Orlando Letelier, as well as a young American woman, Ronni Karpen Moffitt, on the streets of Washington, D. C. The Justice Dept. has issued no indictments in the case, and is hopelessly compromised by its dependence on information from the C. I. A.

To promote interest in this case and a clearer understanding of current U.S. - Chile relations, the Letelier-Moffitt fund for Human Rights in making available to all interested news departments interviews with experts on the C. I. A. in Chile, foreign intelligence operations in the U. S., and the investigation into last year's assassinations.

Reporters may have a particular interest in telephone interviews with Isabel Letelier, now the President of the Chile Committee for Human Rights, and Michael Moffitt, who was riding in the car with Orlando Letelier and his wife Ronni when a bomb attached to its undercarriage exploded.

On the other hand, a few overt rockers punch up the set. A very well timed adjustment. Again, the song choices are perfect.)
Small Faces/PLAYMATES/Atlantic SD 1913 (Fresh. With a true sense of rhythm and blues Small Faces reunites. Only Ronnie Lane has been replaced by Rick Willis. Steve Marriott has been guilty of a few excesses in his day but, this isn't one of them. Instead, restraint and big back beat marks an album in which what was necessary was used, nothing more. And it is all built on several special songs.)

MERIT PLUS ALBUMS

Caldera/SKY ISLANDS/Capitol ST-11658 (Latin-jazz-fusion music is Caldera's motif. Only the second track on each side goes swirling off into never-never land. The rest of their LP is in exhilarated perpetual motion. Fine recording quality enhances it further.)
Cate Brothers Band/Asylum 7E-1116 (Fundamental music. The Cate Brothers Band attempts nothing fancy. They are out there on a limb, completely dependent on their songs to carry them. They do, consistently.)
Harry Chapin/DANCE BAND ON THE TITANTIC/Elektra 9E-301 (Chapin is one of the few artists prolific enough and worthwhile enough to generate a two record set of consistent quality. He has so much to say. Former complaints about production excesses fade in direct proportion to their controlled use here.)
Jack DeJohnette's Directions/NEW RAGS/ECM 1-1103 (Super players, including John Abercrombie, saturate the air. DeJohnette's drumming style, quite uniquely, boils underneath the main spray. It is the intensity and the playmanship which are involving as opposed to the melodies.)
Gentle Giant/THE MISSING PIECE/Capitol ST-11696 (Gentle Giant adds a little nasty streak as they split the difference between their customary cerebral style and straight dosage rock. It is not less arty, it is instead a more balanced mixture. More super playing. The sound quality is on the harsh side at times.)
Daryl Hall & John Oates/BEAUTY ON A BACK STREET/RCA AFL1-2300 (Christopher Bond's production has given Daryl & John their most polished album. The Hall & Oates style remains, he didn't step on that. He enriched it with meticulous care applied to rather complex arrangements. Solid.)
Richie Havens/MIRAGE/A&M SP 4641 (Well into his 2nd career Richie is one of the 60's artists who has found the energy key to the 70's. It was so simple, his natural dynamism needed to be matched with an intensified accompaniment. Good tunes take care of the rest.)
Heart/MAGAZINE/Mushroom MRS-5008 (Legal problems aside, this is probably Heart's best total album. Partially because of the outside material, which is better than their own, and partially because of the recording quality, this LP holds up top to bottom. Live or in the studio it is a forceful package.)
Chris Hillman/CLEAR SAILIN'/Asylum 7E-1104 (Hillman's round melodies are presented in such a natural way that they tend to be taken for granted. The fact is that albums this complete, and this easy on the ear, are relatively few in number.)
Jackie Lomax/DID YOU EVER HAVE THAT FEELING?/Capitol ST-11668 (Lomax sounds like he's singing in the other room. But, that sound on his voice and that ram-bunctious rhythm feel underneath him combine to help establish his individuality. Organic melody writing assures enjoyment even though it sometimes has to fight a fairly big production tangle.)
Missouri/Panama PRS-1022 (Rarely is a group released on such an obscure label so surprisingly good. The infectious rock style of Ron West's aggregate is undeniable. Fine playing and better than average songs cause the excitement. Write: Box 8111, Kansas City, Mo. 64112.)

Gary Peacock/TALES OF ANOTHER/ECM 1-1101 (Keith Jarrett and Jack DeJohnette spend lots of time keeping out of the way, so that Gary Peacock's bass carries to the top. The result is a very spacious, delicate LP. It's the musical equivalent to a Japanese watercolor, impressionistic and intellectual but not breathtaking. The "Trilogy" on side two is most involving because Jarrett goes to the front.)
Collin Walcott/GRAZING DREAMS/ECM 1-1096 (Too often Walcott's sitar/jazz borrows time to warm up in the manner of ragas. However, once warmed his melodies can be stirring. The Indian instruments - sitar and tabla - are a natural in a jazz format as a group like Oregon proves.)

MERIT ALBUMS

Frankie Armstrong/... OUT OF LOVE.../Bay 206 (For folkies Frankie Armstrong is a find. A majority of her music is chosen from traditional collections. Still, it is Frankie's steadily powerful voice which marks this album. The accompaniment is minimal. Write: 1516 Oak St., Alameda, Ca. 94501.)
Roy Bookbinder/RAGTIME MILLIONAIRE/Blue Grass 2023 (With Leon Redbone around others in the folk-blues revival school have to endure second place. Roy is entertaining and an obvious student of the form but, he too must fight the battle. The mixing of the recording itself gets a little muddled up.)
Chivo Borraro/BUENOS AIRES BLUES/Catalyst CAT-7917 (More dedicated to mood than melody. However, Chivo's moods are rather enticing. His South American heritage brings a fresh feel and new ideas to Latin jazz. Smooth most of the time, you will appreciate the occasional eruptions of intensity.)
Boxer/ABSOLUTELY/Epic PE 34812 (Living up to their name Boxer's rock is muscular and not childish. They have all of the moves, however, they lack some of the writing finesse to be a true champion. Still, the band lists some real talent in its lineup.)
Brian & Brenda/SUPERSONIC LOVER/Rocket PIG-2291 (The R&B duet is a staple rock format. The first side of the Brian & Brenda album contains some excellent examples of it, while side two is somewhat less endowed. A lack of credits is unexplainable.)
China/Rocket PIG-2292 (Top flight players give a level of recognition to China before their record even turns. It is some no name songs, not players, which detain the band at the border. A few tunes on each side make it through, especially the opening two.)
Michael Clark/FREE AS A BREEZE/Capitol ST-11680 (His high gear is a big nightclub singer voice. Though he uses it judiciously those pipes are obviously Clark's ace card. His songwriting is O.K., wisely augmented by a few sure-thing outside tunes.)
Lisa Dal Bello/MCA-2249 (Here is a case where production savvy keeps Lisa's songs acceptable. Her delivery does its part too. She sings in a dramatic rock style which gets the most out of songs which ordinarily might not be too whistleable.)
Willie Dixon/WHAT HAPPENED TO MY BLUES/Ovation OV-1705 (Willie Dixon, reportedly, was the man who applied the name rockabilly to the music Chuck Berry brought him in the '50's. True or not that story establishes the position Dixon should command as regards everything which has come since. He is the embodiment of urban rockin' blues and this LP does nothing to change that fact.)
Doobie Brothers/LIVIN' ON THE FAULT LINE/Warner Bros. BSK 3045 (It's the same thing on every album. The feel is grooved while the writing struggles somewhat. Each LP overcomes the problem more or less well while the Doobie Brothers consistently grow in popularity. "Little Darling" and "Nothing But a Heartache" are best.)
Dr. Feelgood/SNEAKIN' SUSPICION/Columbia PC 34806 (Previously reviewed as an import. No pretense, just good ole rock 'n' roll music. It's always in style and Dr. Feelgood always has a place when core music is required.)
Jay Ferguson/THUNDER ISLAND/Asylum 7E-1115 (Jay has nothing much to say in this album. His lyrics are mere expediences while his tunes are good but, show no special spark of originality. The bouyant Bill Szymczyk production keeps it listenable and feeling all right.)
Hummingbird/DIA MOND NIGHTS/A&M SP-4661 (Confidence in the writing skills of Hummingbird is less than in their musicianship. Melodies have to get beyond merely good to get noticed. Their otherwise tasty style is pleasing.)
Klaatu/HOPE/Capitol ST-11633 (Klaatu has been seduced by those notices which made Beatles comparisons. This LP is filled with arranging tricks and a host of gimmicks almost to the exclusion of music. There is no similarity to the Liverpoolians here, largely because the Beatles never ever forgot what the album's purpose was, songs.)

- Charlie Mariano/REFLECTIONS/Catalyst CAT-7915 (Mariano is probably Europe's leading horn player. His approach is post-Trane and his melodies can be searingly bitter-sweet. Here he gathers the top Finnish players, including Jukka Tolonen, for a spontaneous brawl. Most memorable track is Mariano's "Thiruvar Bolam.")
- Carol McComb And Friends/LONG CAN TAKE YOU HOME AGAIN/Bay 302 (Acoustic music and lots of ballads. If there is a criticism of this quietly melodious album it would be that its pace is too regular on the slow side. Carol is pleasant anyhow. Write: 1516 Oak St., Alameda, Ca. 94501.)
- Sam Mitchell/BOTTLENECK-SLIDE GUITAR/Picking Mule KM 129 (If you like slide guitar mark down the name of Sam Mitchell. Like the players from the British blues scene of the 60's, he has done his homework. In a rockin' context he could be a killer. He gets by as a singer too. Write: Box 3233H, Berkeley, Ca. 94703.)
- Nighthawks/SIDE PICKET SHOT/Adelphi AD 415 (Perfectly named, The Nighthawks are rockers of the first order. Their heroes are the originators, not those who filled in rock's middle period. When they hit their stride, The Nighthawks fly.)
- Caroline Peyton/INTUITIVE/Bar-B-Q8 (Caroline is an excellent singer who in a technical sense gets a beautiful production to demonstrate her abilities. In a conceptual sense she has been lead astray because her album attempts to do everything instead of focusing on a limited area. Tinges of country, gospel blues, jazz and folk music all filter through at one or another time. Still the delivery is very pleasing. Write: 114 S. Grant, Bloomington, Md. 47401.)
- Shawn Phillips/SPACED/A&M SP-4650 (To the Shawn Phillips cadre these bits and pieces, which were left off other albums, will fill in some history. To outsiders it will be a major "so what." As always Shawn's music takes itself too seriously and rarely opens up.)
- Randy Pie/FAST FORWARD/Polydor PD 1-6113 (A solid rock performance delivers a journeyman Randy Pie album. There's nothing fancy in it, either in its conception or presentation. The songs are good too.)
- Jean-Luc Ponty/ENIGMATIC OCEAN/Atlantic SD 19110 (Enigmatic Ocean waits around for Ponty solos. The written music is pleasant but, often seems to be preparation for something else - the solos - instead of essential in and of themselves. Fusion intensity keeps it moving.)
- Rex/WHERE DO WE GO FROM HERE?/Columbia PC34865 (In spite of Rex's thrust the music is never unintelligible. The songs are only passable, except for the notable "Chains On My Heart," depending on a potent performance to connect. Power bands unite!)
- Slim Richey's Jazz Grass/Ridge Runner RRR0009 (Similar to Texas swing except that the Jazz Grass concept leans toward the mountains for its country aspect. Texas Swing is somewhat more sophisticated. Both musics are fun and after that is said, little else matters. Much of the material is from the jazz world of an earlier time. Write: 103 Fondren, Ft. Worth, Tex. 76126.)
- Rush/A FAREWELL TO KINGS/Mercury SRM 1-1184 (Boldness was never a problem for Rush. Clarity has, however, been a real problem. A Farewell... brings those elements together in a pungent stew which includes a serious attempt at lyric writing too. The whole deportment of this record, inside and outside, declares genuine, if a bit pompous, growth.)
- Even Stevens/THORN ON THE ROSE/Elektra 7E-1113 (You can tell a Shel Silverstein lyric even if you are half listening. They are always clever. Stevens has made other albums but, the lack of what has become standard overproduction in country-folk music albums, keeps this one in bounds. A well manicured Lp throughout.)
- Streetdancer/RISING/Dharma D-807 (You will have to appreciate Streetdancer's jazz/rock intensity partially by inference. An inside out mix is almost always emphasizing the wrong element. There's more drum kit than anything else. Further, the Lp's dynamic range is very narrow. Still, the band has melded the power of rock and the moves of very contemporary jazz into a unique brew.)
- John Taylor-Norma Winstone-Kenny Wheeler/AZIMUTH/ECM 1-1099 (This combination of keyboards, voice and horns manages to be musical, spacey and aetheral at different times. The mood is depression resulting in an album which reflects the most common state of contemporary societal mind. Mental.)
- Johnnie Taylor/REFLECTIONS/RCA APL 1-2527 (Some fundamentally well crafted songs set in a basic rhythm and blues format make Johnnie Taylor appealing. He doesn't write but, he certainly can sing. Nothing fancy, the essential is all that's needed.)
- Tennessee Farm Band/COMMUNION/Farm TFB-1013 (Over the period of 3 or 4 Lp's the Farm Band has developed into a thoroughly professional unit. Their music has evolved into an easy, rocking style sporting pleasing melodies. Even their homegrown cover design has matured. Here's one commune which seems to have made it into the seventies. Write: Summertown, Tenn. 38483.)

- Thin Lizzy/BAD REPUTATION/Mercury SRM 1-1186 (Bad Reputation seems a shade thicker and more bot-tomy than other Lizzy albums. Tony Visconti's presence is felt as the harmonized guitars and Phil's voice are restrained somewhat. Still, Lynott's writing is potent stuff and even through an album which favors its second side, he emerges a winner.)
- Jane Boss/AN ALBUM OF SONGS/Bay 207 (The material is American folk music. It has the nasal twang of the prairie and the hills. It is done well however, Jane's voice isn't always tough enough to sustain it. Wisely, it is often harmonized. A folkie's delight. Write: 1516 Oak St., Suite 320, Alameda, Ca. 94501.)
- Bob Welch/FRENCH KISS/Capitol ST-11663 (He still puts teeth into his rock 'n' roll. But, the improvement musically over Paris is substantial. Solid writing and the influence of his old Fleetwood Mac connection are the basis for the great leap.)
- White Horse/Capitol ST-11667 (There's a future here. White Horse finds the groove. Admirably, they find a way to do it their own way. Smooth harmonies, pleasing songs and a mild rock setting fill the pegs of their formula. Recorded clarity enhances general appreciation.)

SATISFACTORY ALBUMS

- (Albums of acceptable quality, which, of themselves, require only secondary progressive radio consideration.)
- Jeff Harrington/Centerpiece 2601 (All of the moves are here but the songs aren't. Jeff's writing reaches adequate at the high end. That leaves the cozy jazz chordings dangling. A case where presentation gives the artist a decent shot. Write: 5002 West Old Shakopee Rd., Minneapolis, Minn. 55437.)
- Various Artists/LESBIAN CONCENTRATION/Olivia LF 915 (Notable as a document. It is not the hard core lesbian proselytizing which holds this Lp back. Instead it is that too many of the tunes are not good enough. Long before lyric is applied to melody the difficulty existed. Still, quality is found in Teresa Trull's "Prove It On Me Blues," Chris Williamson's "Sweet Woman," BeBe K'Roche's "Kahlua Mama" and Teresa's "Woman-Loving Women." Write: Box 70237, Los Angeles, Ca. 90070.)

FRINGE ALBUMS

- (Good albums which are not progressive, yet hold some interest for progressive audiences.)
- Ron Carter Quartet/PICCOLO/Milestone M-55004 (Ron Carter's Quartet hovers at the top of the line in the combo category. They play together noticeably better than other groups. Further, this isn't a jam, it is instead a live performance by a stable unit. Enjoyable.)
- Calvin Keys/CRISS CROSS/Ovation OV 1804 (Light fingered Calvin Keys provides a mellow flow of jazzy melodies. Some special harmonizing on "Aunt Lovey" highlights side one, while the opening two tracks of side two find contemporary energy.)
- Masabumi Kikuchi Sextet/MATRIX/Catalyst CAT-7916 (The Japanese absorption of American music is complete. This very crafty sextet operates a rather sophisticated brand of mainstream jazz in a totally accomplished way. They, unfortunately, bring nothing original to the field.)
- Nichols & Raymond/WE'RE ONLY HERE FOR YOU/Soul Deep DM-772 (Pretty. An MOR-folk duo, N & R features sweet harmonies over a light rock base. String sweeteners add the refinement which glosses over the mellow. Nice tunes keep them an outside possibility.)
- Bert Sommer/Capitol ST-11684 (Ron Dante produces singles. They are always very big and busy and a little raggedy. Here they are collected on a 12" disc. Bert Sommer is the guy with the good voice who is strictly out of the center.)

SPECIAL PROGRAMMING

- (Spoken, poetry - comedy and extraneous musics.)
- Sandy Baron/HOW IT FOUND GOD, ZEN, YOGA.../20th Century T-537 (The audience laughs too much and too hard and sometimes at the wrong times. His neo-Lenny material is mildly funny at best. Audition before airing.)
- Jean-Michel Jarre/OXYGENE/Polydor PD 1-6112 (Jarre is a popularizer not a creator. His music is standard conceptually. Played on synthetic instruments they momentarily conjure images of a roller skating rink. The question for Jean-Michel is whether he truly understands the instruments he is operating. Klaus Schultz is unthreatened.)
- The Memphis Nighthawks/JAZZ LIPS/Delmark DS-216 (The Memphis Nighthawks took their name from a band in the 30's. Neither organization was from Memphis, although presumably they were and are nighthawks. Their music is related to Dixieland. These Nighthawks play with surprising punch and precision. Fun if taken in short doses.)

Cecil Taylor/THE GREAT CONCERT OF/Frestige P-34003 (Taylor, in case you've been away, is the mysterious guru of advanced jazz composition. Captured here in a 1969 Parisian concert he manages, light years later, to be light years ahead of much of today's new music. His composition "Second Act of A" is as relentlessly intense and diversely tumultuous as we've heard but, it is much more whole and logical. Still, it is difficult stuff to absorb.)

Various Artists/FLAT PICKING GUITAR FESTIVAL/Kicking Mule KM 206 (It is striking how many crafty guitar players there are in all categories of playing. These flat pickers certainly rank high. Their folk music can fill gaps with worthwhile sound. Write: Box 3233H, Berkeley, Ca. 94703.)

Various Artists/I GOT RHYTHM/Kicking Mule KM 132 (Dale Miller - USA, Ton Van Bergeyk - Holland, John James - Wales and Sam Mitchell - England, each play an assortment of old jazz tunes on guitar. They are magnificent players, especially the Dutch and the Englishman. The best of the tracks offer an interesting break from the norm. Write: Box 3233H, Berkeley, Ca. 94703.)

King Harry/DIVIDED WE STAND/EMI EMC 3188 (A solid rock band on all levels. Almost totally self-contained, King Harry is a complete production unit in and of itself. Led by a big voice they perform a standard brand of rock music with notable care. Merit.)

Brent Titcomb/Manahar (Titcomb is a veteran Canadian singer/songwriter introduced here in his first solo l.p. Because this isn't a big budget production, he was forced to rely on his writing to bring the album across. It is considerable and it argues the virtues of smaller budgets Merit Plus.)

CONCEPTS

EQUAL & OPPOSITE REACTIONS

One scattered notion about new wave music deserves a short mention. It has to do with the physical law of equal and opposite reactions.

For years Walrus has been spitting against the wind as regards overproduction. Some people have gotten the mistaken idea that we hate violins on principle. Of course, that's not true. What plagues us, and too many records, is a reliance on string sweeteners to do either one of two things which we believe to be anti-art. One is sweetening to fill in an arrangement which doesn't stand on its own and the other is to broaden the artist's appeal so a larger audience can be reached. Stock fillers are a bore.

The point is that sweetening has developed into a foregone conclusion. The more that they proliferate, the more they invited an equal and opposition reaction. New wave music is it.

The music rejects all but what is essential to transmit the message. Further, many of the artists insist on black and white, basic l.p. covers in reaction to the glossy rock-chic l.p. covers which have made the record industry one of the largest users of commercial art in the world.

Hip New York writers call it minimalism. In any case, the refreshing thing about new wave music is that it takes rock & roll back to the basics. Every few years rock music needs a new sense of the streets to rejuvenate it.
