OUR RELATIVE CHARTING, AS SEEN BELOW, RESEMBLES BASEBALL'S BATTING AVERAGES. IT ESTABLISHES A RATIO BETWEEN THE IDEAL, (HEAVY AIRPLAY AT EVERY STATION WHICH REPORTED); AND THE WEIGHTED COUNT THAT A RECORDING HAS ACTUALLY EARNED. THIS MATHEMATICAL FORMULA IS APPLIED TO EACH RECORD—FIRST REGIONALLY, THEN NATIONALLY. A DUAL WEIGHTING SYSTEM IS USED TO DERIVE THE COUNT. IT ADJUSTS FOR MARKET SIZE AND FOR HEAVY OR MODERATE AIRPLAY. THESE CHARTS SHOW THE RELATIVE INTENSITY OF RADIO AIRPLAY FOR BOTH NEW AND ESTABLISHED RECORDINGS.

Johnny "Guitar" Watson's band turns out to be a solid back-up band, which we all knew before. Masters of funk, they are light on melody line. Still, given what they set out to do this is a good job.)

Richard Beirach/HUBRIS/ECM 1-1104 (At times Richard Beirach's solo piano is the essence of melancholy beauty. "Sunday Song" is a lovely example of that high plane. The music is on the finer side of jazz. It is where jazz meets classical training. Cerebral.)

Paul Motian Trio/DANCE/ECM 1-1108 (Dance, in this case, is an outside exercise. Slightly obtuse it creates a space just to the right of reality. Inviting and interesting, it asks more questions, than it resolves.)

Oregon/VIOLIN/Vanguard VSD 79397 (Moments of exhilaration raise this album's common denominator well above the standard. In combination with Zbigniew Seifert's violin, Oregon reaches yet another peak in their adventurous musical climb. The music is not easy as it draws from a thousand years of musical tradition, both past and future.)

CONCEPTS

DAVID SWINGS AT GOLIATH

NAIRD met in San Francisco a few weeks ago. They are the National Association of Independent Record Dealers. In other words, anti-NARM. This organization of the small record labels is an attempt, by them, to find ways of competing in a world of mega-companies. To put NAIRD into perspective, its bigger members are Flying Fish and Takoma.

The organization is just beginning to face the problems of these often esoteric labels. It has a long way to go.

There are two fronts on which they should be attacking actively. The first is tactical: what can they do immediately? The second is strategic: what can they work toward in the future?

On a tactical level they are doing something and that is the convention itself. Their trade show concept is good and something to be expanded on. However, it does have the inherent problem that is created naturally by these kinds of things. While there is rivalry between many of these labels, they still end up talking to themselves at the convention, not to the rest of the industry. They tend to rehash, amongst themselves, the problems they already know they have. Still, the convention idea is good, especially in the workshop sense.

Another, most important tactical maneuver is the joint maintenance of a mailing list. By pooling their resources, a list of extraordinary accuracy and detail would save thousands in wasted mailings each year by targeting the media people who would be most likely to use specific types of music. This is an idea which was floating around but one which was explained away by fairly lame excuses. It should be jumped on.

On the strategic side, NAIRD could be a full-fledged lobbying instrument. Inside the industry, it could work toward getting a faster cash flow from distributors back to the labels. This is a critical problem for many of the labels and facing it alone can be frustrating.

Secondly, as a lobbyist in Washington, the organization could be seeking the expansion of media sources such as cable T.V. and radio. The esoteric label would likely benefit from expansion on the principle that an expanded media requires more diverse kinds of entertainment for smaller and smaller slices of the whole audience.

These suggestions are just the beginning and are only meant to wet the appetite of those involved. They are made with the knowledge that these companies have the best chance for survival if they stay lean while efficiently using every tool at their disposal.

MERIT ALBUMS CONTINUED

- Stormin' Norman & Suzy/OCEANS OF LOVE/Polydor PD 1-6116 (Through an overzealous production it is obvious that Stormin' Norman & Suzy possess lots of energized talent. Joel Dorn might be a better producer for them since he is quite adept at recreating past musical styles. Here Suzy's exceptional singing has to fight for position.)
- Sunrise/Buddah BDS 5697 (The name Sunrise projects competence with a lack of real creativity. That is what they give you musically too. An energetic performance and an impressive guitar bring them up but cannot give them needed style.)
- Tuff Darts/Sire SRK 6048 (Halving the difference between mainstream and punk rock, Tuff Darts brings a measure of sophistication to new wave. Their music isn't that basic. Their images are compulsively repulsive. They go both ways. Tuff Darts is a good band on all levels.)
- Uriah Heep/INNOCENT VICTIM/Warner Bros. BSK 3145 (The Heep history has been characterized by a few musical songs amongst many things which were centered in power alone. This Lp seems to reverse the percentages. Their writing seems to be up a notch or two, and their rocking under control.)
- Van Halen/Warner Bros. BSK 3075 (If you had been wondering where the new Deep Purple's were coming from stop wondering. Van Halen's instant radio acceptance demonstrates the continuing strength of the power band formula. This band is good at it.)
- James Vincent/WAITING FOR THE RAIN/Caribou JZ 34899 (Vincent's sound has lightened up appreciably and now has a warm feeling. He works a thin line between R&B and jazz. When he gets a decent melody into the mixture a refreshing feel is yielded.)
- Dexter Wansel/VOYAGER/Philadelphia International JZ 34985 (Dexter Wansel is potentially a musician of major consequence. He often chooses to work in a pop R&B format which is limiting. On this album, he stands alone and some of his true ability comes through. A racy talent.)
- Willie Weatherly/COME THE DAWN/Blake Company AW 14050 (When he reaches for outside material the album gets better but, then Willie's writing isn't bad either. A distinct barroom feel gives the record an agreeable turn in spite of barely adequate sound quality. Distributed by IRDA, Nashville, Tenn.)
- Kenny Wheeler/DEER WAN/ECM 1-1102 (Wheeler's horn leads a top-notch group of players through his pleasing tunes. The play of Garbarek, Abercrombie, Holland, DeJohnette and Towner out-do the tunes. So that, the performances are more striking than the music. Satisfying.)
- Lenny White/ASTRAL PIRATES/Elektra 6E-121 (The story on the jacket is cute but, the music inside is not as impressive. Especially the "Pursuit" side which floundered as much as it knifed forward. On the whole, the album is not always musical in its quest for adventure. You'll respond more to the apparent hard work than to pleasing tunes.)
- Bobby Womack/PIECES/Columbia JC 35083 (Womack is a talent who, in spite of past successes, hasn't gotten enough recognition. Noted for writing naturally sewn melodies, it should be expected that these Pieces would fit together nicely. They do.)

SATISFACTORY ALBUMS

(Albums of acceptable quality, which, of themselves, require only secondary progressive radio consideration.)

- Mickey Carroll/LOVE LIFE/Coconut Grove AN-14033 (Though Mickey's songs aren't bad they don't get off as they might have. In this anemic setting they only imply the life which they might possess. Tempo is the main problem. Potential. Distributed by IRDA, Nashville, Tenn.)
- Ron Chrislock/ODE TO A WARRIOR/Silent Thunder C 1007 (Ron's weak voice insists on singing ballads which only accentuate his least developed talent. He sounds good only when his voice is harmonized by another. The writing is fair, improvable if he was not trying to write wrenching emotion into every note. Write: Box 381, Monterey, Ca. 93940.)
- Roger Glover/ELEMENTS/Polydor PD 1-6137 (The three minute song form is a marvelous format because it requires a concise musical message. It forces the creator to edit. Elements is an example of Glover operating without an editor. Each of the four pieces wanders aimlessly at least half of its running time. He did not have that much to say. The second track on each side holds some interest.)
- Phil Keaggy Band/EMERGING/New Song NS 004 (Most Christian rock weakens on the writing level. Phil Keaggy Band weakens at the performance level. Phil's notable guitar is let down by an underdone rhythm section and by his fair vocals. It could have mad it.)

SATISFACTORY ALBUMS CONTINUED

- Pantano-Salsbury/HIT THE SWITCH/Solid Rock SRA 200 (Writing leaves Pantano & Salsbury on the short end of the singer/songwriter genre. Their sound is gentle and they seem able to deliver an understated message. "I Need You" is best and got buried at the end of side one. Write: 7046 Hollywood Blvd., Suite 707, Hollywood, Ca. 90028.)
- Parlet/PLEASURE PRINCIPLE/Casablanca NBLP 7094 Pleasure Principle, on the whole, wastes a good performance on unworthy material. That is uncharacteristic of producer George Clinton's work. The production is crystal clear, is more in character.)
- Judas Priest/STAINED CLASS/Columbia JC 35296 (Halford's vocals often cross the line from singing to screaming. He leads the audacious Judas Priest in a purposely pretentious brand of rock fury. Their writing is fair.)

UNDISTINGUISHED ALBUMS

(In our opinion, below standard Lps except where noted.)

- Yokohama, California/Bamboo BBP - 001-77 (Unfortunately for a good cause the level of writing in Yokohama, California is beginner. The performance level is a step above. Their desire to project Asian Americans to the forefront is laudable and quality music is a good way to make their statement. But, it has to be good. Write: Box 1678, Los Gatos, Ca. 95030.)

FRINGE ALBUMS

(Good albums which are not progressive, yet hold some interest for progressive audiences.)

- Roy Ayers/LET'S DO IT/Polydor PD 1-6126 (Separating himself from Ubiquity has an effect on Roy's music. For his solo Lp he smooths the sound out. He always conjured quality and that hasn't changed. Try "When Is Real Real?" and "Freaky Deaky.")
- B & G Rhythm/Polydor PD 1-6132 (Their names tells the story. They have produced a good rhythm track into which limited melodic lines are woven. The formula is standard stuff. Competent.)
- Gene Cotton/SAVE THE DANCE/ Ariola America SW 50031 (A powerful pop artist Gene sings only round songs, each one arranged to be a hit single. They all crash the hook and force you to tap your foot. Solid stuff.)
- Stan Getz/LIVE AT MONTMARTRE/Inner City 1040 (Stan Getz was a smooth operator when he started many years ago. Time has made him even smoother. This set is an airy sound dessert. Easy.)
- Louis Hayes/THE REAL THING/Muse MR 5125 (Unlike many drummer lead albums Louis Hayes doesn't mistakenly take over his album. His drums are, however, the forceful undertone which they should be, as he drives some nice melodies home.)
- Jermaine Jackson/FRONTIERS/Motown M 7-898R1 (The maturing of Jermaine comes through his music. From the thrust of "Let It Ride" to the class of "Castles Of Sand" he shows a broad talent. There is more too.)
- Morris Jefferson/SPANK YOUR BLANK BLANK/Parachute RRLP 9003 (Jefferson joins the funky legions with a touch of S & M. "Dr. Spank" is the track which leans into a guitar solo and generally makes itself interesting. The Lp seems well made.)
- Kongas/AFRICANISM/Polydor PD 1-6138 (This disco Lp gains some favor because it adds an African rhythm flavor to enhance itself. Also, the Lp boasts some songs. "Gimme Some Lovin'" (the 2nd cut on the first side) and "Tattoo Woman" are very playable.)
- McCrarys/LOVING IS LIVING/Portrait JR 34764 (One of the better pop R&B albums in some time, yields lots of pleasing music. Some is usable in progressive context. Start with the first track on each side. The family's strong writing is the basis for their successful album.)
- Houston Person/WILD FLOWER/Muse MR-5161 (A steady force, Houston Person is a fine club jazzier. The liner notes tout his regular employment, which, for any musician, is quite a credit. Easy.)
- Red Rodney/RED, WHITE & BLUES/Muse MR 5111 (Red presides over a fast moving combo set which spins out of another era. The combo is notable for its members, Richie Cole, Roland Hanna and Buster Williams, all of whom hold up their portion of the load. Comfortable.)
- The Swingers Orchestra/AMERICAN MUSIC HERITAGE/Gang AN-14036 (A return to the 1930's. Since The Swingers Orchestra sounds like a bogus name, it is hard to tell exactly who this big band really is or was. Their style is hot and their playing isn't bad. Write: IRDA, Nashville, Tenn.)
- Ubiquity/STARBOOTY/Elektra 6E-120 (Roy Ayers always involves himself with a higher level of music. Here, as producer, he leads his back-up band to the heart of funky music. Their performance is tight, though the music tends to be one dimensional toward the rhythm side.)

MERIT PLUS ALBUMS CONTINUED

- Tom Robinson Band/THE T. R. B. PRE-ALBUM/Harvest SHPO 879079 (Robinson proves the axiom that to get a message across you need music which stands up with or without the message. The six songs in this pre-album are characterized by dynamic writing and by special performance energy.)
- Les Tamblyn/CROWN CR 1007 (Les is a balladeer of heightened sensitivity. Because he does not attack, he might not get noticed as easily as a belligerent rocker but, the skills needed to make this Lp exceed those needed by others. Every song is worthwhile.)

MERIT ALBUMS

- Average White Band/WARMER COMMUNICATIONS/Atlantic SD 1962 (If you weighed the melodic vs. the rhythm aspects of the A. W. B. formulation, it would be out of balance significantly toward rhythm. Of course, it should be evenly balanced. Still, A. W. B. survives mostly on their infectious feel.)
- Be-Bop Deluxe/DRASTIC PLASTIC/Harvest SW-11750 (Bill Nelson invests each Be-Bop Deluxe Lp with style and few strong songs. Drastic Plastic is no exception. It does seem to be time for the group to make a stylistic move forward as this album tends toward restatement.)
- Belle Epoch/MISS BROADWAY/Big Top 76008 (This is not the disco Lp it appears to be, at least not on side one. There you will find some deeply rooted, blues based music of some appeal. Lack of performance credit disrespects the truly insightful playing and some good songs. Side two is disco.)
- Bootsy's Rubber Band/BOOTSY? PLAYER OF THE YEAR/Warner Bros. BSK 3043 (This Bootsy album has the same crazy attitude as previous albums but, it isn't always as musical. The songs work at a minimum. A strong performance brings them up. "Roto-Rooter" is the high point in music and humor.)
- Dee Dee Bridgewater/JUST FAMILY/Elektra OE-119 (Dee Dee is a fine singer. Here she only begins to use her ability. That, of course, is by design. The Lp's whole approach uses the finest players to play well within themselves a fairly straight form of R & B music. Showing the range of many of the key musicians breeds the expectations which result in these feelings. The album is satisfying but, not the adventure it might have been.)
- B. T. G./STREET ACTION/Mercury SRM 1-3713 (Without Randy the band isn't the same. His writing and his thrust is missed. While the album is C. K., it is noticeably deflated on the performance side.)
- Christ Child/HARD/Buddah BIS 5700 (Already the philosophical underpinning of punk rock defines as Christ Child, intense new ravers, emerge out of the canyons of Malibu, Ca. Songs are the bottom line regardless of genre and this band has some worthy entries. They also use some fresh arranging tricks. Good show.)
- Chick Corea/THE MAD HATTER/Polydor PD 1-6130 (We all know the musical credits earned by Chick. His greatest credit is that he never stops growing and exploring. This album does more of that exploratory work-his use of strings is exemplary, they don't sweeten, instead they heighten. One area which he has not conquered is songwriting. Jazzmen, as has been mentioned here before, seem to have difficulty fitting melody and lyric together.)
- Country Store/LIVE/Widge Runner RRR 0012 (Marked by a broad range of material chosen from traditional collections as well as old and new writings, Country Store charms a country spirit. Every song is a winner both in choice and performance. Passable sound quality still allows an appreciation of the pickin'.)
- Loggins & Messina/THE OPEN/Linn & Lamb L.L-1035 (An appealing musical setting supports songwriting which just gets by. Melodies and lyrics are merely acceptable. The only one song isn't overbearing. Distributed by Word in Waco, Texas.)
- Brian Elliot/Warner Bros. BSK 3048 (Thought put off by the pop arrangements which dominate side one, there is no denying the quality of Brian's writing. Special songs spin out of the grooves with surprising consistency. Side two is dominated by a realer feel splitting the Lp in half between top 40/MOB and the more believable.)
- Fireworks/Myth MSB - 4587 (Their name is not an accurate representation of their music. However, if you don't mind the Jesus preaching, Fireworks will fill a soft rock gap. Pleasant. Distributed by Word Records, Waco, Texas.)
- John Fisher/INSIDE/Light LS-371b (The message is a little thick and the pace tends to drag. Apparently God only appreciates ballads. Still, the production job is high end and the tunes are reasonably smooth. Distributed by Word in Waco, Texas.)

MERIT ALBUMS CONTINUED

- Photomaker/Atlantic SD 19165 (Photomaker places itself in the center of the rock & roll universe. Under control power drives home good songs with big guitars and deep throated harmonies. Though they create nothing new, they do make a hit sound by combining known elements.)
- Don Francisco/FORGIVEN/Newsax NP 13042 (Don is a real songwriter. He is probably the best of the Jesus rockers. His lyrics never trip over themselves on their way to The Word. And his tunes are round too. Distributed by Word, Waco, Texas.)
- Carlos Garnett/THE NEW LOVE/Muse MR-5123 (Vigorous Latin rhythms fuel interest in Garnett's music. These rhythms encourage and stimulate the soloists. Melodic strength results solidifying both the top and the bottom of his music.)
- Glider/United Artists UA LA 414-G (It is their commanding performance, more than anything else, which distinguishes Glider. Ted Myers' writing is solid, giving the band a stable base from which to operate. Side one is materially stronger.)
- Hoodoo Rhythm Devils/ALL KIDDING ASIDE/Fantasy F-9543 (Their songs are good but won't knock you over. Still, you'll be impressed with the consistent quality of All Kidding Aside. Naturally, the Rhythm Devils' rhythm moves fluidly. Side two is a little heavy on the orchestrations.)
- R. H. Hudson/CLOSER TO YOU/Cotillion SD 5204 (Some of R. H.'s Lp is a little too pop but, the soul of this man is embedded in classic rhythm and blues. A couple tracks on each side prove that to the delight of anyone who cares about the roots of our music.)
- Tom Hunter/COMIN' HOME/Long Sleeve 101 (An around-the-campfire feeling is projected by a pleasant Tom Hunter album. The old folkie aura takes you back, conjuring reminiscences of times past. All of his songs are pleasing. Write: 276 Sycamore, Mill Valley, Ca. 94941.)
- Jimmie Mack/Big Top BT 76007 (Starting with a great rock and roll name is nice but, follow-through is everything. Jimmie Mack and band demonstrate in the first track that they are solid rockers. They show, in the rest of the Lp, that when they get fancy their potency drops off. Basic 4/4 and a good song are the targets.)
- Manfred Mann's Earth Band/WATCH/Warner Bros. BSK 3157 (Choice of material is a critical element with Manfred's band. This time it is O.K., but not much more. Tracks depend on the group's considerable jamming skills to soar. "Quinn The Eskimo" gets an impressive update.)
- Country Joe McDonald/ROCK & ROLL.../Fantasy F-9544 (Start with the musically stronger side two. As a whole its better tunes and restrained production make it more fun. The vocals are not always in the forefront of the mix as they should be. Joe is one of the survivors.)
- Brownie McGhee & Sonny Terry/YOU HEAR ME TALKIN'/Muse MR 5131 (Recorded back 16 years ago, the blues of Brownie & Sonny remains the same, real and relevant. They play the same way today. Several classic blues tunes spice the Lp.)
- James Moody/BEYOND THIS WORLD/Vanguard VSD 79404 (Most of Moody's mood is held together by a funky rhythm base. He may play flute or saxophone or sing a song over it but, the texture is the thing. His singing and his lyrics aren't always the best.)
- NRRO/AT YANKEE STADIUM/Mercury SRM 1-3712 (The band has always been a good one, even in their totally raucous days. Always it was, and it remains. Al Anderson's guitar which is special. NRRO will always be a fine bar band.)
- The Other Side/Delise DSR-9502 (A very lucky band. The Other Side, was given the chance to rescue their own album. Instrumentally augmented and, most important, remixed this record jumps easily from the Undistinguished pile it was in last year, to the Merit file this year. Much improved.)
- Robert Palmer/DOUBLE FUN/Island ILPS 9476 (Palmer has a knack for generating tight little funky shufflers. They keep things moving even when his melodies are only fair. A track or two on each side stand out.)
- Terje Rypdal/WAVES/ECM 1-1110 (When Rypdal opens up, his guitar soars on inspired melodic lines. The other players on Waves do not seem nearly as musical by comparison. Terje could bring his music a few milliquintines inside, without selling out, and he would bring the guitar world to its knees.)
- Shamrock/Fluke Company AW 14049 (Through the mystery comes some pretty impressive jazzy music. Complete absence of credits leaves no hint as to who Shamrock may be. Musically, a jazz combo emerges which generates surprisingly good movement. The lead playing is generally mild; electronic piano, saxophone and guitar. But, when that guitarist cranks it up they get hot. Distributed by IRDA of Nashville, Tenn.)

Jefferson Starship/EARTH/Grunt BXL 1-2515 (Earth provides a blueprint for sustained success. Starship combines outside material with their own to insure high quality music to perform. Then they perform it with enthusiasm and singular style. Side one is slightly better than side two but, two goes out very strongly. It is the several tracks which soar that elevate this Lp.)

MERIT PLUS ALBUMS

(All Merit and Merit Plus Albums are recommended for serious progressive radio consideration, recognizing that not all of these recommendations are suitable for all stations. The Merit Plus Albums distinguish themselves with an extra vitality.)

The Carla Bley Band/EUROPEAN TOUR 1977/Watt 8 (When you hear the multinational lineup of players in Carla's band, the expectation is heavily spaced jazz. Elton Dean and Roswell Rudd stopped playing it straight while still in diapers. To your surprise, you'll discover a very digestible brand of jazz, highlighted by inventive playing and a marvelous sense of humor. Their "Star Spangled Banner" stands next to Jimi's and The Holy Modal Rounders' "Stars & Stripes Forever.")
California Zephyr/IN THE SADDLE/Iron Horse (A rollicking band of Western hillbillies. You may join up after you hear California Zephyr. From yodeling to a cappella harmonizing this band paints a bright spot across your ears. Write: Box 281, San Anselmo, Ca. 94960.)
Bob Dylan/SOUNDTRACK - RENALDO & CLARA/Columbia AS 422 (This pre-album displays the dynamism Dylan is injecting into his current music. He is consciously adjusting to the intensity of the 70's. That's true, whether or not the audience perceives it. Dylan is not old business yet.)

MERIT PLUS ALBUMS CONTINUED

Walter Egan/NOT SHY/Columbia JC 35077 (Several special songs highlight Walter's second album creating a situation similar to his first Lp. At the base is his writing skill but, the tightly controlled production style contributes to success too. It stops just short of restraint.)
Robert Gordon With Link Wray/FRESH FISH SPECIAL/Private Stock PS 7008 (Gordon enhances his perfect recreation with a perfect batch of songs. Link Wray is just the right guitar foil too. Consistency.)
Dan Hicks/IT HAPPENED ONE BITE/Warner Bros. BSK 3158 (How nice it is to hear the orally fixated Dan Hicks again. His mellow, sly style is still disarming. This Lp was done in 1975 as part of a never to be released film yet, it feels as fresh as today's sour mash.)
Little Feat/WAITING FOR COLUMBUS/Warner Bros. 2BS 3140 ("Tight Is Right" is the stated motto and no statement applies better. The Feat feel is captured here in its natural, live habitat. Their good songs sound even better when lighted by these vibrant performances. Fine sonic quality enhances it too.)
Michael Mantler/MOVIES/Watt 7 (Michael Mantler comes in from the avant side for the second time to teach a lesson in fusion music. He generates intensity on all levels. Winning tunes and a wise and judicious use of advanced ideas make Movies both challenging and enticing. Write: J. C. O. A.)
John Martyn/ONE WORLD/Island ILPS 9492 (An original. John's slurred vocals tend to obscure the quality of his writing. His songs are pretty straight in their construction while they are set in musical weirdness. It all works together beautifully.)
The Pirates/OUT OF THEIR SKULLS/Warner Bros. BSK 3155 (The Pirates were an imitation rockabilly band in pre-Beatles England. In a back to the basics time like this, things come full circle and their style moves center stage with a resounding rock 'n' roll success. Rooted.)
Gerry Rafferty/CITY TO CITY/United Artists UA-LA 840G (Rarely does an album contain as many round songs. Gerry's years have honed his talent and smoothed all rough edges. The result is a harmonious City To City.)
Smokey Robinson/LOVE BREEZE/Tamla T7-359R1 (Years later Smokey remains the cream of the crop. Two or three songs in this silken smooth Lp are so fine they transcend a pop production and require airplay.)
