RADIO STATS

OUR RELATIVE CHARTING, AS SEEN BELOW, RESEMBLES BASEBALL'S BATTING AVERAGES. IT ESTABLISHES A RATIO BETWEEN THE IDEAL, (HEAVY AIRPLAY AT EVERY STATION WHICH REPORTED); AND THE WEIGHTED COUNT THAT A RECORDING HAS ACTUALLY EARNED. THIS MATHEMATICAL FORMULA IS APPLIED TO EACH RECORD—FIRST REGIONALLY, THEN NATIONALLY. A DUAL WEIGHTING SYSTEM IS USED TO DERIVE THE COUNT. IT ADJUSTS FOR MARKET SIZE AND FOR HEAVY OR MODERATE AIRPLAY. THESE CHARTS SHOW THE RELATIVE INTENSITY OF RADIO AIRPLAY FOR BOTH NEW AND ESTABLISHED RECORDINGS.

SATISFACTORY ALBUMS CONTINUED

Thor/KEEP THE DOGS AWAY/Midsong MCA-2337
(Macho rock. The beefcake cover ties together with the name Thor and with the writing, ("I'm So Proud, To Be The Man I Am.") Manhood is defined at the lowest level and the music is too.)

FRINGE ALBUMS

(Good albums which are not progressive, yet hold some interest for progressive audiences.)

Moe Bandy/SOFT LIGHTS.../Columbia KC 35288 (Moe possesses another of those big Texas voices. He sings songs about a life which has been pushed around and injured by the great social contest. Pretty pure stuff.)
Linda Clifford/IF MY FRIENDS.../Curton CUK 5021
(Though working from the more pop side of the rhythm and blues spectrum, Linda finds credit in an earthy presentation. Curtis Mayfield consistently involves himself with music of that sort. A track like "Gypsy Lady" is very usable.)
England Dan & John Ford Coley/SOME THINGS DON'T COME EASY/Big Tree BT 76006 (Their MOR-folk formula persists, though a few tracks on side two slip through the glaze. Seals & Coley have to think about changing up on the format to avoid burning themselves out.)
Benny Goodman/LIVE AT CARNEGIE HALL/London 2PS 918/19 (Benny Goodman is a class act. He always has been and the recording which commemorates the 40th anniversary of his historic Carnegie Hall concert reflects that heritage. Can you imagine the 40th anniversary of Woodstock?)
Gringo/United Artists UA-LA 845-G (The Gringo image portrayed on the jacket does not match the pop rock music inside. Mixed communication shows bad media savvy. The music is O.K. if you have Top 40 ears.)
Samuel Jonathan Johnson/MY MUSIC/Columbia JC 35323 (His writing is only adequate but his voice is super. It is, wisely, placed in a dominant position in the mix. The mix is of high quality play which does much to make S.J.J. a serious new contender.)
Roberta Kelly/GETTIN' THE SPIRIT/Casablanca NBLP 7089 (This may be too pop to play but, Roberta's album of disco-gospel music must be noted at least, as a first of its kind.)
Nigel Olsson/Columbia JC 35048 (Nigel and Paul Davis have produced an album in which each decision was resolved in favor of the overdone. They attempted to make an epic in a back-to-the-basics age. The songs are pretty good - Olsson's writing - and the performance excellent otherwise. "Say Goodbye To Hollywood" is least affected.)
Woody Shaw/ROSEWOOD/Columbia 35309 (A fine acoustic jazz performance. You can feel the inter-relations of instruments as they fold around each other. This is not a recorded jam. Shaw, and producer Michael Cascuna, have gotten the players to talk to one another.)
Stanley Turrentine/WEST SIDE HIGHWAY/Fantasy F-9548 ("Stan's Thing" is the only track which is not touched by the orchestrations. West Side Highway does seem to keep the orchestrations under better control than in previous Lps. The combo playing, in and around the sweeteners, is admirable.)
Various Artists/SOUNDTRACK - A HERO AIN'T NOTHIN' BUT A SANDWICH/Columbia PS 35046 (Mellowness. This soundtrack, partially written by Hubert Laws, is warm and unobtrusive. It fills in the background amiably.)

SPECIAL PROGRAMMING

(Spoken, poetry - comedy and extraneous musics.)

Dale Miller/GUITARIST'S CHOICE/Kicking Mule KM 137
(Unlike other players, Dale does not overwhelm you with footwork. He plays with simple precision, leaning toward the baritone strings. A nice interlude.)
Jean-Pierre Rampal/SAKURA/Columbia M 34568 (Rampal is a superior musician but, that alone is not the reason for his acclaim. As this Lp demonstrates he has a built in sense of the intriguing. Flute and harp converging on Japanese melodies is fresh, interesting and stimulating.)
The Rutles/Warner Bros. HS-3151 (The Rutles forever.)
Various Artists/MELODIC CLAWHAMMER BANJO/Kicking Mule KM 209 (The spectrum from deliberate hard hitters to flailing pickers is represented. As Steve Martin says, the banjo is a happy instrument. This is a happy album.)

BLACK MUSIC VS. PROGRESSIVE/AOR RADIO

I'm curious about the process which has led to the gradual exclusion of most black music from progressive/AOR radio. Today, with some exceptions, it is increasingly difficult to find stations which program any but "crossover" black music and, God forbid, that you would hear two black songs back to back or the black music of the 50's and 60's.

It appears that sometime in the last 8 years someone decided that the young, white audiences who listen to the type of radio represented in these pages do not listen to black music. This seems a pretty narrow point of view considering the increased awareness about programming to the 25-34 demographics which now represent the largest portion of our population. Lest we forget, people in this

age group grew up on black music (Stax, Motown, etc.) and if you find that hard to believe, trot down to your local Top 40 station and check out their surveys from 1956 thru 1966. Better still, next time you're on the air try backing that Bob Seger cut with some Chuck Berry, or if you're real adventurous follow Led Zepplin with Freddie King.

MERIT PLUS ALBUMS CONTINUED

- Marla Muldaur/SOUTHERN WINDS/Warner Bros. BSK 3162 (If there is an objection to any part of a song's presentation it never has anything to do with Maria. Her singing is one of those time capsule experiences, unique at least. Up tempo tracks are favored here.)
- The Red Clay Ramblers/MERCHANTS LUNCH/Flying Fish FF-055 (Rambunctious good humor infects and enhances the bluegrass fling that is known as The Red Clay Ramblers. This album is fun from beginning to end.)
- Renaissance/A SONG FOR ALL SEASONS/Sire SRK 6049 (Each album is a restatement and further perfection of their folk-classical idiom. Renaissance does not knock you down but, they have become a dependable benchmark, a reliable source of quality music.)
- Root Boy Slim & The Sex Change Band/Warner Bros. BSK 3160 (Bands with lousy names can't be good musically - so when a group with a name like Root Boy Slim & The Sex Change Band comes along you have to like them instantly. The humor and the quality of their music carries through in a natural arc. Like a sane Beefheart.)
- Mike Santiago/WHITE TREES/Chiaroscuro CR-193 (Tumultuous, energy injected jazz hits at the heart of contemporary music. Mike's guitar, and his band, play in the fusion idiom without giving up their jazz essence to do it. Nice melodies also contribute. Write: 221 W. 57th St., New York, N.Y. 10019.)
- Richard Torrance/DOUBLE TAKE/Capitol SW-11699 (Making gains with the audience with each album, Torrance has now come up with what sounds like a clincher. Side one is hot. Aside from the first-track-singles-syndrome, Carter, his producer, has generated steam with this session.)
- Various Artists/STIFFS LIVE/Stiff STF 0001 (You'll be surprised at how many solid songs this sampler contains. Live Lps, like this one, tend to be less appealing. Represented are Nick Lowe, Wreckless Eric, Larry Wallis, Elvis Costello and Ian Dury.)

MERIT ALBUMS

- Norman Blake/BLACKBERRY BLOSSOM/Flying Fish FF-047 (An infinitely better player than singer, Norman's new album lists to one side because of that imbalance. His accompaniment is almost enough to float the Lp on its own. Blake picks with a firm stroke.)
- Bryan Bowers/THE VIEW FROM HOME/Flying Fish FF-037 (Known as an extraordinary entertainer, Bryan's album just begins to get that point across. Still, it boasts a spiritual folk tradition and an unmatched love for autoharp music. Folky.)
- British Lions/RSO RS-1-3032 (A solid rock and roll band. The British Lions do what is necessary. They write and play well and wisely, they augment their songs with a few notable outside songs. Impressive consistency highlights the Lp.)
- Tyrone Davis/I CAN'T GO ON THIS WAY/Columbia JC 35304 (The first tune on this album may be called, "Get On Up (Disco)" but, the heart of Tyrone Davis is an R&B heart. That cardiac delight comes through clearly when the commercial additives are jettisoned. Seek the heat.)
- Eumir Deodato/LOVE ISLAND/Warner Bros. BSK 3132 (Arrangers are a plague to real music because their training tends to even everything out - to put a lush wash over everything. Deodato is an arranger who has been guilty of that in the past. Love Island is mild and it is arranged but, it never strays toward excess thereby making itself one of his best efforts.)
- Ian Dury/NEW BOOTS & PANTIES!!/Arista-Stiff STF0002 (Previously reviewed as an import. Strange little ditties, a strange little voice and a strange looking little Ian Dury. Obviously excellent accompaniment permits Ian's weirdness to make it.)
- Mike Finnigan/BLACK & WHITE/Columbia JC 35258 (Really talented people sometimes have great difficulty in focusing their ability. Mike has been one who fits that description. On Black & White, Ron Nevison's big scale production encloses Finnigan's spectrum into a single powerhouse flow. It gets too big at times, especially on side one, but, the good rock and roll is worth digging out. The album has an undeniable energy going for it.)
- John Handy/WHERE GO THE BOATS/Warner Bros. BSK 3170 (Working well within his ability John Handy cruises through a very contemporary Lp. The dynamism happens inside the funky rhythms and not in the solo spots. Pleasant.)
- Z. Z. Hill/LET'S MAKE A DEAL/Columbia JC 35030 (So good for so long. Z. Z. Hill's music has gone too long unnoticed in spite of natch'l songs and his gritty voice. Texas rhythm and blues.)
- Hounds/UNLEASHED/Columbia JC 35085 (Hounds is a standard hard rock band dressed in punk duds. Singing with a sneer is John Hunter's forte, his writing tends to be adequate. Another opening act.)

MERIT ALBUMS CONTINUED

- Kris Kristofferson/EASTER ISLAND/Columbia-Monument JZ 35310 (Kris' low key style yields one of two reactions, boredom or a spiritual connection. Rarely is the reaction in between. Easter Island comes up with a 50-50 split. It's arrangements are notably creative.)
- Hubert Laws/SAY IT WITH SILENCE/Columbia JC 35022 (The album contradicts its name by being the antithesis of silent. Instead it tends to be overdone in Hubert's orchestrated jazz manner. "The Baron" is a hot lead off track of note.)
- Mance Lipscomb/YOU'LL NEVER FIND ANOTHER... / Arhoolie 1077 (Believability is always an issue in music. With the earthen sounds of Mance Lipscomb that law is defied. He is so much the real thing that any question would be rejected out of hand. Root music.)
- Ralph MacDonald/THE PATH/Marlin 2210 (Side one of Ralph's album is a major music statement. He traces his heritage in the excellent rhythm piece which titles the Lp. Side two is lighter. It is his current, produced background music which permits only "It Feels So Good" to heat up. The three parts of "The Path" should be separated by play-through bands.)
- Bob Marley & The Wailers/KAYA/Island LPS 9517 (Lightening up, Marley's themes are not as angry and his arrangements are more varied. He is an incredible vocalist, so even if his songs no longer possess their former urgency, he is still able to stir the juices.)
- Ellen McIlwaine/United Artists UA-LA 851-H (The important and most notable aspect of this Lp is that it harnesses the enormous talent possessed by Ellen. Good songs were chosen and she demonstrates her ability as a vocalist. But, her guitar playing is almost completely sublimated. While it needed to be controlled and directed, this takes it too far in the other direction. It is the reason the Lp goes flat at times.)
- The Nielsen-Pearson Band/Epic JE 34984 (This review had appeared too far in advance of the Lp's release. Strength at all positions. Reid Nielsen's voice is the kind which establishes itself indelibly. Especially, since he is singing solid material in front of an equally solid presentation. They start a stronger side one with a super Hall & Oates sound-alike called "Home.")
- The Outlaws/BRING IT BACK ALIVE/Arista AL 8300 (A live Outlaws recording demonstrates the brute force Southern rockers can generate. They put on a good show for the audience and it translates onto their record.)
- Mike Pinera/ISLA/Capricorn CPN 0202 (Mike Pinera is an average writer with a good singing voice, a superior guitar stroke and one super song which leads off his album. "Alone With You" has everything, the feel and the guitar.)
- Sir Douglas Quintet/LIVE LOVE/Texas Re-Cord Co. TRC 1007 (This temporary reformation of the Sir Doug Quintet has to draw on warm feelings. Their Texas style applied to organic songs, songs which seem to spring from the soil, transcends momentary trends. File under fun. Write: Box 19, Bulverde, Tex. 77163.)
- Steven T./WEST COAST CONFIDENTIAL/Dream DA 3500 (His songs come out of the street - a fashionable place from which to draw references. Steven T. is, for the most part, complemented by Kim Fowley's production. However, somewhere in the process some of the vocals lose presence. The rock is best. Write: 240 Madison Ave., New York, N.Y. 10016.)
- Allen Toussaint/MOTION/Warner Bros. BSK 3142 (This New Orleans legend has been a magic music man more for others than for himself. Though there isn't a misplaced note here, you'll find that those special tracks which explode in your ears are limited. It's good all the way through.)
- Various Artists/REGGAE SAMPLER/United Artists SP-167 (One of the saddest musical moments in the 70's has to be the failure of reggae music to capture a mass audience. It is a genuinely liberating form even when played by its unknowns.)
- Various Artists/SOUNDTRACK - BLUE COLLAR/MCA 3034 (Though some of the Blue Collar soundtrack is music to back up the film, it is also true that some of it is very upfront. Powerful blues tracks featuring the likes of Capt. Beefheart and Ry Cooder distinguish this album of more than movie music.)

SATISFACTORY ALBUMS

(Albums of acceptable quality, which, of themselves, require only secondary progressive radio consideration.)

- Mark Cohen/FARE WELL, TRAVELLER/Folkways FS5352 (Mark Cohen is a valuable folk/rock writing find. That fact is almost masked by this below demo quality recording. Fare Well, Traveller wets the appetite for more Mark Cohen. Write: 43 W. 61st St., New York, N.Y.)
- Perry Robinson/THE TRAVELER/Chiaroscuro CR-190 (The Traveler is all over the place. It's sometimes too far outside and other times too far inside. It isn't very musical and it doesn't sound like this quartet is a unit. They need direction which only comes with time. Write: 221 W. 57th St., New York, N.Y. 10019.)

(These records which, in our opinion, deserve special mention because they come closest to perfecting their musical genre regardless of progressive radio application.)

STRONGLY MERITORIOUS

(We feel that these Lp's have an extra edge.)

Lou Reed/STREET HASSLE/Arista AB4169 (Street Hassle may not be very commercial but it is evidence that the very first punker is still out there trying to deal with it. He, Reed, never turned into the rock & roll dilitante others have. His special intensity, attitude and vulnerability result in a unique blend. Lou would hate hearing his special music called street art but, it is.)

MERIT PLUS ALBUMS

(All Merit and Merit Plus Albums are recommended for serious progressive radio consideration, recognizing that not all of these recommendations are suitable for all stations. The Merit Plus Albums distinguish themselves with an extra vitality.)

Atlanta Rhythm Section/CHAMPAGNE JAM/Polydor PD 1-6134 (Presentation was never an ARS problem. Writing, on the other hand, has been. That now seems to be in the deep, darkened past. Champagne Jam wins on all scores; material, performance and production are top notch.)

Jimmy Buffett/SON OF A SON.../ABC AA-1046 (Jimmy tends to retreat into an introverted style. That reduces the impact of his quality writing. Here a punchy album gives his especially clever lyric writing a chance to be heard.)

Charlie/LINES/Janus JXS 7036 (A bouyant presentation, highlighted by smooth harmonies keeps Charlie in contention. The material is good and it gets its best shot in a remarkably alive recording. Side one is where it happens.)

Clifton Chenier & His Red Hot Louisiana Band/Arhoolie 1078 (Frustration at closed minded music taste reaches a high point around the music of Clifton Chenier. Music which is so original and which feels so good from the inside out must have a larger potential audience than it has reached. He sings "Take Off Your Dress" in cajun.)

MERIT PLUS ALBUMS CONTINUED

Deaf School/ENGLISH BOYS - WORKING GIRLS/Warner Bros. BSK 3169 (However you slice it, Deaf School is a potent rock band. Not only is their performance dynamic but, their songs resound too. Hot.)

Fingers Akimbo/COWTOWNS & OTHER PLANETS/Biscuit City BC 1319 (Progressive folk music is a rare treat. Lots of extraneous influences flow through Fingers Akimbo's music. The starting point is mountain music. Though it may not be commercial, this group advances the cause of folk music by avoiding the traps of tradition while respecting it.)

Michael Franks/BURCHFIELD NINES/Warner Bros. BSK 3167 (The jazzy Michael Franks style depends on a delicate balance. His fragile songs and voice make it because the accompaniment is so solid. It takes the best players to pull it off and he has often had them. A gentle pace changer.)

Gil Goldstein/PURE AS RAIN/Chiaroscuro CR 201 (A jazz find. Gil is an artist painting in musical pastels. He plays his lovely melodies on acoustic piano most often, moving to a Rhodes on occasion. Each tune benefits from a sculptured arrangement. The one song "Boy Inside a Drum" is a tasty union of sensitivity and craft. "Beantown" is on the hot side.)

Woody Harris/AFTER DINNER MINTS/Kicking Mule KM 133 (Woody Harris has made a guitar album which reaches above the artistic average. His jazz pieces are written and practiced so that they are at once expressive and precise. His music and his album are demanding.)

Marc Jordan/MANNEQUIN/Warner Bros. BSK 3143 (A mellow West Coast feel makes Marc's songs rest easy on the ear. They turn naturally with or without the feel. Mannequin sounds like the Lp which will take Jordan out of the sessionman click.)

Delbert McClinton/SECOND WIND/Capricorn CPN-0201 (In previous recordings Delbert has proven to be a deeply rooted performer and one with an uncanny ear for good songs. This album moves him into contemporary music focus while bringing those admirable qualities along for the ride. He is no longer strictly a country artist, Delbert McClinton is an artist with no qualifications.)

Melanie/PHONOGENIC.../Midsong MCA 3033 (Melanie's writings are as good as the songs she has chosen to sing. There is also parity between her distinctive vocalizing and the songs which results in an easy to digest quality recording. Not Just Another Pretty Face.)
