# RADIO STATS

OUR RELATIVE CHARTING, AS SEEN BELOW, RESEMBLES BASEBALL'S BATTING AVERAGES. IT ESTABLISHES A RATIO BETWEEN THE IDEAL, (HEAVY AIRPLAY AT EVERY STATION WHICH REPORTED); AND THE WEIGHTED COUNT THAT A RECORDING HAS ACTUALLY EARNED. THIS MATHEMATICAL FORMULA IS APPLIED TO EACH RECORD—FIRST REGIONALLY, THEN NATIONALLY. A DUAL WEIGHTING SYSTEM IS USED TO DERIVE THE COUNT. IT ADJUSTS FOR MARKET SIZE AND FOR HEAVY OR MODERATE AIRPLAY. THESE CHARTS SHOW THE RELATIVE INTENSITY OF RADIO AIRPLAY FOR BOTH NEW AND ESTABLISHED RECORDINGS.

Reviewer's Reaction: First impressions of new artists are obviously unpredictable at best. When these initial reactions are closely reminiscent of another decade when rock 'n' roll was born, from the early 50's on, one may too quickly classify or typify that artist with a "nostalgia" attitude, evoking images of Elvis Presley or Roy Orbison. Fine, but that is the superficial. We must not rely on first impression to the exclusion of closer, beneath the surface reaction. So, what have you got? Robert Gordon and Link Wray. What the live show drives home is the medium itself. Yes, they redo many early tunes of Presley and rock crooning; but, when you have perhaps the best vocal performance this material has ever received (with all due respect), then you transcend simple nostalgia. Then you have a timeless medium flawlessly executed. No longer the music of the 50's, but every bit as much the sound of NOW as anyone. Rock 'n' roll 1978, and with Link Wray absolutely so hot on his axe that you can't believe your ears, you realize that this is one of those rare performances where it gets better with every song just when you thought it couldn't possibly get any better.

Reviewer's Reaction: Jay Ferguson led off the show. His four piece band performed energetically and tightly. Jay did his bit as a semi-acrobatic keyboardist and vocalist. Audience response to his antics (admittedly overboard at times) was exceptionally warm, especially in light of the imminent appearance of beloved Heart. Heart's show was powerful, but flawed. Billows of smoke is a very tired stage cliché that remains in their repertoire. The up-tempo tunes tend toward a sameness that becomes a bit tedious after a while as do the shamelessly obvious Led Zeppelin vocal and instrumental rip-offs. Yet, Heart is a band to be reckoned with. Ann Wilson is a very strong vocalist and stage leader and sister Nancy is an excellent and versatile musician. The boys in the band play admirably, with the lead guitar work most compelling. Heart evidently enjoys Corvallis (Ann & Nancy's parents went to college here and evidently the vice-versa is true). However, by playing the same two encore numbers in the exact order that they did during a gig here one year ago, Heart leaves one with a hollow feeling.

# CONCEPTS

## WHO'S ON FIRST?

Probably the most telling argument for radio people to do audience research spilled glibly out of the mouth of one of the top concert promoters in the country recently. His observation went to the heart of whether radio people know what is in fact, going on or whether most of what is going, is going on in their heads.

As it happens, one of the thorniest philosophical problems in concert promoting is filling out the bill after the star is set. Equally difficult is the club booking of a relatively new band. Will the concert fit together? Is this new band ready for this venue? Are they ready to open a show?

This particular promoter seeks advice wherever he can. In the quest for answers he has often asked the radio people he knows in perfusion. His voice expressing a note of resignation said that 75% of the time a jock's notion of

what will work, what will draw, is wrong. It is gotten to the stage that when he is advised that a booking will work he turns it down and vice versa.

What this means is hard to say. But, it surely means that many of the radio people this promoter talks to are not in phase with the audience. It might be that they are ahead of the audience, that their likes and dislikes are too hip. For example, many would be shocked to know how few people in the street would recognize Elvis Costello's name, yet he is a radio star.

The point is, at least from this man's observation, that we should not assume that we are all throbbing in time to our audience. It is not an automatic symbiosis.

## SATISFACTORY ALBUMS CONTINUED

Screamin' Jay Hawkins/I PUT A SPELL ON YOU/Versatile NED 1125 (A junky kind of production pulls together loose ends from the two sides of Jay Hawkins' career. Scrap the tin pan alley tunes and select out of the remaining blues songs the best. Try "I Put A Spell On You," "Move Me" and "I Need You." Write: 39 W. 55th St., New York, N. Y. 10019.)

Judas Priest/ROCKA-ROLLA/Import IMP 7001 (Previously reviewed as an import. Judas Priest plods along as moderately hard rockers. Their songs are not very melodious causing most of their problems. There are some players in the band but, they have been heard to produce a cliché or two.)

## FRINGE ALBUMS

(Good albums which are not progressive, yet hold some interest for progressive audiences.)

Renee Armand/IN TIME/Windsong BXL 1-2708 (Progressive pop. Dig out "Beggarmen.")

Billy "Crash" Craddock/Capitol ST 11758 (Side two contains a melancholy pop-country ballad repertoire. It is the feel of side one which shows the deeply rooted Craddock essence. As a whole the album probably reflects a struggle inside Billy's mind, as to who he wants to be.)

Kenny Dale/RED HOT MEMORY/Capitol ST-11762 (A western feel dominates Kenny's pop country sound. When the strings subside his clean-cut songs are not an impossible fit. "Some Kind of Wonderful" adds some rocks to it.)

Freddy Fender/SWAMP GOLD/ABC AA-1062 (Freddy's Texified remakes of old rhythm and blues are wonderful. In combination with Huey Meaux, he touches a chord in anyone with a strongly rooted musical past. Side step the popisms.)

Fuzzy Haskins/RADIO ACTIVE/Westbound WT 6102 (Wisely, Fuzzy attempts to steer his own funky course. He could have gotten trapped in the P-Funk area which is already roped off. However, with all of the maneuvering Fuzzy does not show us solid melodies.)

Eddie Jefferson/THE MAIN MAN/Inner City 1033 (Though produced by Leon Thomas, the main influence on this Lp is Slide Hampton's big band arranging which backs Eddie's jazzy vocals. Eddie is a pioneer in a style of lyric writing which was popularized by Lambert, Hendricks & Ross and Dan Hicks & The Hot Licks in the early and late 60's. Still, the magical Eddie Jefferson tune is "Moody's Mood For Love.")

Duke Jordan Quintet/DUKE'S DELIGHT/Inner City 2046 (There is a tune called "Sultry Eve" which cues the kind of sophisticated combo Duke has assembled. Lead by the smoothly harmonized trumpet-saxophone combination the band cruises through its easy material.)

Letta/A&M SP 4688 (Not just another singer, Letta is a graceful songstress who reaches to her roots for inspiration. A hot blooded African tune like "I Need You" strikes a responsive chord even though this is a pop version.)

Webster Lewis/TOUCH MY LOVE/Epic JE 35017 (Touch My Love, whatever that means, is a sensuous, jazzy, modern R&B disco album. While it is all of those things it is also a very creatively pulled together piece of business which demands respect.)

Eddie Rabbitt/VARIATIONS/Elektra 6E-127 (Blurring all musical distinctions Eddie's Lp touches country, rock, MOR and if you listen carefully, you'll hear a disco moment too. "Crossin' the Mississippi" and "Plain As The Pain.." are worth a try.)

Helen Schneider/LET IT BE NOW/Windsong BXL 1-2710 (Good pop.)

7th Wonder/WORDS DON'T SAY ENOUGH/Parachute RRLP 9004 (7th Wonder is a pop R&B band that might not even get mentioned in these columns under normal circumstances. However, a high level of writing requires some special notice. 7th Wonder will remind you of the grand days past of Motown.)

Jimmy Smith/UNFINISHED BUSINESS/Mercury SRM 1-3716 (Jimmy's funky barroom groove is pleasant but, it seems a long way away from his dynamic "... Virginia Woolf" adventure. The pace changing acoustic piano piece moves from saloon to super club.)

Red Steagall/HANG ON FEELIN'/ABC AB-1051 (Hang On Feelin' is a hot country album. Solid songs with big hooks dominate the set. Though it is a little too pop, it is too good not to consider seriously.)

Frank Strozier Sextet/REMEMBER ME/Inner City 2066 (Operating in a fairly mild rhythm field places Strozier's music in an earlier time frame. Yet, a listen to "For Our Elders" demonstrates a "Trane consciousness. The ensemble works very well together rising above the afternoon jam level.)

Various Artists/SOUNTRACK-CASEY'S SHADOW/Columbia PS 35344 (Though a significant portion of Stewart Levine's production is music to backdrop the film, some is forefront by nature. The two tunes by Dr. John and the watered down Cajun music deserve consideration.)

## SPECIAL PROGRAMMING

(Spoken, poetry - comedy and extraneous musics.)

Larry Coryell - Philip Catherine/TWIN-HOUSE/Elektra 6E-123 (Previously reviewed as an import. Why is it that so much of the music which is recorded for art's sake is recorded in Europe? Here is a case in point. These lovely guitar duos, between two enormous talents, needed to be done in spite of any commercial consideration. At times they attain the spiritual level of the better piano improvisation Lp's by Jarrett and Corea.)

Michael Hoenig/DEPARTURE FROM THE NORTHERN WASTELAND/Warner Bros. BSK 3152 (Hoenig's electronic music is simple and pleasant. It is not, at all, creative or inspired. It finds the common denominator which Tangerine Dream, Kraftwerk and Klaus Schulze are not even trying to find.)

Procter & Bergman/GIVE US A BREAK/Mercury SRM 1-3719 (The dedication of this Lp to Stan Freberg and to Bob and Ray is most appropriate. P&B's short media satires and spoofs are perfect media structures in themselves and funny too.)

Jeremy Steig & Eddie Gomez/OUTLAWS/Inner City 3015 (For the most part this duo spends its time spacing around each other like mating butterflies in an improvisational dance. The flute and bass create a mellow tone. "Arioso" on side one makes a notable statement as does Miles' "Nardis.")

The Albion Band/RISE UP LIKE SUN/Harvest SHSP 4092 (Bringing modern instruments, rock drums, electric bass and synthesizer, into the context of traditional music is a special ability of The Albion Band. The integration is so complete that you hardly know it has taken place. An aura of quality distinguishes the whole Lp. Merit Plus.)

Buzzcocks/ANOTHER MUSIC.../United Artists UAG 30159 (Raucous half-punkers. Buzzcocks is an anamotopoetic name for this band's music. They get by mostly on fuzz thrust. But, they are not all bad. Merit.)

Eela Craig/HATS OF GLASS/Vertigo 6360 638 (Mild spaciness pervades the Eela Craig soundscape. It is filled with notable playmanship and adequate material. The overall effect is pleasing but not overwhelming. Merit.)

Cherie Currie/BEAUTY'S ONLY SKIN DEEP/Mercury 6338 867 (A healthy batch of songs done to Kim Fowley's restrained, s-punky arrangements yields a rather credible album. Cherie runs away from The Runaways and finds a home as a soloist. Merit.)

## MERIT ALBUMS

- Amazing Rhythm Aces/BURNING THE BALLMAN DOWN/ABC AA-1063 (Tied to the rural South, the Amazing Rhythm Aces spin a delightful batch of low-key stories. Easygoing, the modus operandi is understatement.)
- Randy Bachman/SURVIVOR/Polydor PD 1-6141 (Throughout his record Randy's voice is mixed slightly behind the accompaniment. That practice leads to the under-delivery of his songs. On side two there is more of a loss because the tunes are so strong. The second side elevates the album, it leans toward Merit Plus.)
- Marcia Ball/CIRCUIT QUEEN/Capitol ST-11752 (Pastels. A singer with a warm voice, Marcia applies herself to quite a nice selection of songs. A countryness tints everything toward a comfortable rural sound.)
- Clarence "Gatemouth" Brown/BLACKJACK/Music Is Medicine MIM 9002 ("... red neck, bluegrass music from a ... blue collar black man..." is a statement defining the breath of Gatemouth's music. It is all of the folk musics of the South intertwined. Remarkable.)
- Kate Bush/THE KICK INSIDE/Harvest SW-11761 (Kate's voice will be an object of love and hate. Like a shrill Julie Andrews singing rock songs she slices through good original material. It's the vocal quality which raises her out of the crowd - not her writing or the accompaniment though both are O.K.)
- Stanley Clarke/MODERN MAN/Nemperor JZ 35303 (Stanley Clarke is a classy man. His new album reflects that. It is an exercise in diversity under control. When it adds a dose of melodic purity, Modern Man begins to reach your soul.)
- Mark Colby/SERPENTINE FIRE/Columbia-Tappan Zee JC 35298 (Mark fits nicely into the orchestrated jazz formula. He is used to being a section player, with Maynard Ferguson, and is essentially that here with the addition of more leads. Chataway and the N.Y. crew have it down pat.)
- Jerry Garcia Band/CATS UNDER THE STARS/Arista AB 4160 (The texture-print of Jerry Garcia is all over this album. However, the production quality and the level of the writing return to the period before the latest Dead reclamation.)
- Genesis/AND THEN THERE WERE THREE/Atlantic SD 19173 (Lots of arrangement activity and power play sometimes obscures a better-than-standard tune. Refusal to take a straight line traps them inside their own style.)
- The Good Brothers/PRETTY AIN'T GOOD ENUFF/RCA AFL 1-2755 (Gordon Lightfoot's liner notes emphasize the fun which The Good Brothers generate on stage. That loose, havin'-a-good-time quality is apparent on the band's first U.S. release. The album even sounds as though it had been recorded live instead of in the studio. Some production refinement is due the next time out.)
- Henry Gross/LOVE IS THE STUFF/Lifesong JZ 35280 (Henry finds the writing groove more than the average rocker. He is a master of the saving hook and he has developed a singular style using falsetto effectively. Side one rocks hard but, side two tends to have the better music.)
- Bryn Haworth/GRAND ARRIVAL/A&M SP 4682 (A soft sell by a natural songwriter, Haworth has some serious religious thoughts which show a spiritual life beyond the mundane. His style is pleasingly understated requiring the listener's concentration. Lots of good songs.)
- Hot Tuna/DOUBLE DOSE/Grunt LYL 2-2545 (The Hot Tuna set is marked by deliberateness. They take their time. From the in-one blues of side one to the slow guitar burns of side four the moderate pace is maintained. This approach suggests enormous confidence in the quality of what they are doing.)
- Kalapana/MANY CLASSIC MOMENTS/Abator KALA 0005 (A pleasant transformation improves the writing of Kalapana significantly. Their jazzy play now has a substantive basis upon which to operate. They do have a pop streak which attacks their opening tracks.)
- David LaFlamme/INSIDE OUT/Amberst AMH 1012 (Oddly, LaFlamme's albums lack fire. His writing and the performance flows on an even keel through two agreeable sides of music. But, rarely does the record take flight.)
- Mac McAnally/NO PROBLEM HERE/Ariola America SW 50029 (In every way Mac's music is pleasing. He is a good writer and singer in the folk rock idiom. However, it is up to his producers to give the music more individual style, some flair. Their work is articulate but, somewhat faceless.)
- Mandre/TWO/Motown M 7-900RI (Creative and melodious, Andre Lewis' Mandre albums both set a standard for space funk. It's sophistication could not manage to be jive, even if it were attempting to be.)
- National Health/Visa IMP 7002 (Jazzy and rocky, National Health operates with an instrumental consciousness though they include vocals. Longish pieces, interesting yet not melodically inspired, are the course of treatment.)

## MERIT ALBUMS CONTINUED

- Craig Nuttycombe/IT'S JUST A LIFETIME/A&M SP-4683 (He sings enough to get by while he writes simple ditties of a naturally pleasing nature. As Charles Schultz does, he seems to be writing children's songs for adults to enjoy.)
- Reilly & Maloney/ALIVE/Freckle RM 01899 (Harmonizing voices, acoustic guitars and nice tunes yield a bootenany aura. Folkies of the pure school, Reilly & Maloney are outdated in a very pleasant way. Write: Box 31319, San Francisco, Ca. 94131.)
- Ruby/ROCK & ROLL MADNESS/PBR International FBR 7004 (Uncomplicated Ruby rock provides a respite from the profusion of rock genres. Both the writing and the performance are direct and good. PBR is in dire need of an art director. Write: 7033 Sunset Blvd., Suite 322, Los Angeles, Ca. 90028.)
- Eddie Russ/TAKE A LOOK AT YOURSELF/Monument MG 7620 (The electrification of what is otherwise a funky, barroom jazz feel brings this Lp in from the fringes. Eddie's music isn't arty. It is just a hotter incarnation of a Jimmy McGriff sound.)
- Lonnie Liston Smith/LOVELAND/Columbia JC 35332 (When the rhythm starts steaming, Lonnie's darting, one-note-at-a-time style becomes a driving force. Half of the Lp qualifies while the other half splits between soft things and vocals.)
- Spyro Gyra/Amherst AMH 1014 (They may have a rock and roll name but, Spyro Gyra has a jazz heart. It even shows through their poppier arrangements. When things heat up, toward the back of each side, interest heightens. Resilient sound quality helps too.)
- Strawbs/DEADLINES.../Arista AB 4172 (Strawbs' intensity reaches the point of overkill. After a few tracks you can lose your appreciation for the quality writing. The record rarely lightens up. Aside from that textural problem the powerful effort works well.)
- Billy Swan/YOU'RE O.K. I'M O.K./A&M SP 4686 (Booker T. and Billy have kept the Southern flavorings while broadening the Swan appeal. The Lp is built on a good mixture of material and much less country than before.)
- 38 Special/SPECIAL DELIVERY/A&M SP-4684 (The attack in 38 Special's presentation is their most impressive quality. Their writing and playing is solid too, though it's somewhat predictable. Good second effort.)
- Tower of Power/WE CAME TO PLAY!/Columbia JC 34906 (The masters of precision funk do it once more. Their songs may not be made of everlasting quality but, their moves can't be beat. Good show.)
- Trigger/Casablanca NBLP 7092 (The whole Trigger approach, from their haircuts and dress to the sentiments expressed in their songs - "I think I'm ready for your sweet lovin'," tends to restate several years ago. Still, they do not push the excess button.)
- Stephen Whynott/FROM PHILLY TO TABLAS/Music Is Medicine MIM 9001 (Thoughtful, introspective, acoustic, and precise are words to describe Whynott's music. A latter day folksy, he has evolved a rather contemporary sound. Stephen is the kind of artist who gathers a vocally loyal clique of followers.)
- Wings/LONDON TOWN/Capitol SW 11777 (The new Wings' album doesn't boast explosive songs but, it is filled with a ton of mild enjoyment. Paul's ability to seat a lyric into the melody line is always a marvel.)
- Wondergap/A&M SP 4674 (Reviewed mistakenly in January, 1978. Wondergap is a new vehicle for Andy Goldmark. The production works at the best possible presentation for the given material. It's the material which averages things out. Whether lead by the male voice or the female voice, they have a way of making it sound hard to do. Other groups with more organic songs make music sound easy to do.)

## SATISFACTORY ALBUMS

(Albums of acceptable quality, which, of themselves, require only secondary progressive radio consideration.)

- Bad Boy/BACK TO BACK/United Artists UA-LA 869-M (Limited in too many ways, Bad Boy is in a wrestling match with its own music. The album feels like they are doing the best they can just to reach the first rung on the ladder.)
- Budgie/CATASTROPHE/A&M (A three man hard rock band with as many albums as Budgie has issued should have dented the Richter Scale by now. The secret to their lack of success is in their unmusical songwriting. They are all form and little content. It doesn't flow.)
- Cornell Dupree/SATURDAY NIGHT FEVER/Versatile MSG 6001 (Mario E. Sprouse, arranger-conductor, does not seem able to put heat into an arrangement. Most of the tunes limp along in an undernourished groove. Missing punch and a noisy pressing hurt the record too. Wisely, an orchestra was not brought in to save it. "Boogie Nights" finds the proper intensity level. Write: 39 W. 55th St., New York, N.Y. 10019.)

(We feel that these Lp's have an extra edge.)

Elvis Costello/THIS YEAR'S MODEL/  
Columbia JC 35331 (Wonderful. Song after song, side after side Elvis lives. This Year's Model even has better lines than last year's.)

### MERIT PLUS ALBUMS

(All Merit and Merit Plus Albums are recommended for serious progressive radio consideration, recognizing that not all of these recommendations are suitable for all stations. The Merit Plus Albums distinguish themselves with an extra vitality.)

Airwaves/A&M SP 4689 (A find. Fourteen years later Beatles influenced bands are still coming to the surface and they are still good. Harmonies bending through a light veil of electronic manipulation and a whole jar of notable songs distinguishes Airwaves.)

David Friesen/WATERFALL RAINBOW/  
Inner City 1027 (Virtuoso playing by the best and the brightest of the young intellectual jazzers highlights this album. Still, it comes down to the fact that Friesen has involved this intelligencia with superbly subtle melodies.)

Dirk Hamilton/MEET ME AT THE CRUX/  
Elektra 6E-125 (Flashes of Van Morrison along with a list of top drawer songs should put Dirk into the spotlight this time around. His slow, deliberate build up reaches a new plateau here.)

John Hall/Elektra 6E-117 (This Lp was mistakenly reviewed several issues ago. Crystal clear sound and broad dynamic range help to make John's solo album a pleasure to listen to. Even with Orleans, John & Johanna could be counted on to write one or two great songs among their other good ones. The same is true here. "Night" breaks through on a strong opening side.)

### MERIT PLUS ALBUMS CONTINUED

Garland Jeffreys/ONE EYED JACK/A&M SP-4681 (Garland's voice comes searing out of the tasty, Spinozza reflected accompaniment to grab the ear. When the songs are melodically right - the images are always strong - the album soars. The duo with Phoebe should be a blueprint for the future. "Been There And Back" is the truth.)

John Kay/ALL IN GOOD TIME/Mercury SRM 1-3715 (Several current \$1.98 rock stars imitate the throaty audacity of John Kay's voice. They miss the mark because they lack the musical rootedness which legitimizes John's sound. They also miss the uniform quality of his writing.)

Nick Lowe/PURE POP FOR NOW PEOPLE/  
Columbia JC 35329 (Nick Lowe represents the fresh breeze now blowing through the whole rock scene. His deceptively simple arrangements of obviously simple 4/4 tunes speak directly to the heart of rock 'n' roll just as his inspiration is drawn from its heart.)

R. E. O. Speedwagon/YOU CAN TUNE A PIANO/Epic JE 35082 (The distance, on the quality continuum, travelled by this band is notable. Their songwriting has taken the longest strides. It has given them the opportunity to change the pace on their rock. It's like a fast ball pitcher who also has a curve ball and a slider. Dangerous depth.)

Patti Smith Group/EASTER/Arista AB 4171 ("Because The Night," the song of the year to date, towers out of what is otherwise the most articulate production of Patti's music yet. Solid material fills out the album giving each side a couple strong tunes beyond the stunner. Will Patti Smith actually have a Top 40 hit?)

The Sutherland Brothers/DOWN TO EARTH/  
Columbia JC 35293 (Smooth. Sutherland Brothers' songs and their presentation move with fluid ease. The album doesn't have electrifying moments as much as it boasts uniform quality.)

Loudon Wainwright III/FINAL EXAM/Arista AB 4173 (Original songwriters are always in style. Still, Loudon has to fight passing time and the end the folk era. Final Exam hardens for the fight. It succeeds at moving forward without losing his essence.)

Frank Zappa/ZAPPA IN NEW YORK/  
Disc Reet 2D 2290 (Zappa is an original. He doesn't even play cliches on his own style which is always in a state of evolution. That he is a pop musician is astounding. Don't tell anyone that his music is very serious stuff, lest they reject the fun they have with it. A superior live set in all respects. Zapped again.)
