RADIO STATS

OUR RELATIVE CHARTING, AS SEEN BELOW, RESEMBLES BASEBALL'S BATTING AVERAGES. IT ESTABLISHES A RATIO BETWEEN THE IDEAL, (HEAVY AIRPLAY AT EVERY STATION WHICH REPORTED), AND THE WEIGHTED COUNT THAT A RECORDING HAS ACTUALLY EARNED. THIS MATHEMATICAL FORMULA IS APPLIED TO EACH RECORD—FIRST REGIONALLY, THEN NATIONALLY. A DUAL WEIGHTING SYSTEM IS USED TO DERIVE THE COUNT. IT ADJUSTS FOR MARKET SIZE AND FOR HEAVY OR MODERATE AIRPLAY. THESE CHARTS SHOW THE RELATIVE INTENSITY OF RADIO AIRPLAY FOR BOTH NEW AND ESTABLISHED RECORDINGS.

Anti-abortion sit-ins at clinics seem likely to continue in Cincinnati. That's what protestors say, anyway. Ten more were arrested in the second such incident in two months. But like the earlier case, trail on criminal trespass charges was aborted when clinic operators declined to press the case. The judge in the first case had indicated he would admit medical testimony on the question of when life begins, and Pro-Choice Clinic operators say they fear defense attorneys will turn court into a propaganda forum in efforts to prove their clients were trying to save lives by sitting-in. As elsewhere, the issue is an emotional one in conservative Cincinnati.

On the eye of the repeal of mandatory motorcycle helmet laws in Ohio, WEBN News reviewed the three-year effort by bikers and a Cincinnati state representative to force the change. Opponents of helmetless riding will be watching the fatality statistics closely.

Did you catch former President Ford interviewed at the All-Star Game by an ABC-TV sportscaster? Praised for his baseball knowledge, Ford said, "Well, I watch a lot of games on the radio."

Two of the finer new rock and roll bands visited Detroit as opening acts for AOP powerhouse, Journey. In their too brief set, the David Johansen Group demonstrated that they can present thrilling rock and roll in an arena environment, despite being unknown to the great majority of tonight's concertgoers due to lack of local airplay of their phenomenal debut LP. Live, the band was sizzling hot and this listener hopes that ex-N.Y. Doll, Sylvain, who also leads his own band, will be able to continue to play with the Johansen Group as well. Tom Petty and The Heartbreakers also played a superior set and were very well received. Petty has captured the essence of a variety of pop styles (Byrds, Mid-Sixties Brit. Pop, etc.) and has put them together in a most engaging fashion. Tunes familiar from recordings, such as "Break-down" and "American Girl" sounded real good performed live. Most revealing and promising, however, was the pentcostal intensity that Petty achieved during his encore performance of "Shout". This tune which was the Isley Bros. first hit was also covered nicely by Joey Dee and The Starlighters. Petty's version, which acknowledged both antecedents, managed to make the song his own and also genuinely excited the audience.

LETTERS TO THE EDITOR

Dear George: July 14, 1978

There were some comments made in issue #240 of Walrus, dated July 10, 1978, which merit some further investigation and consideration. Chris Kovarik of KZEL-FM, Eugene, Oregon, submitted some ideas in her "comments" section referring to certain stodgy tendencies on the part of many radio programmers. Chris used the words "bland" and "boring"...suggested that radio programmers take more chances...and even went as far to wonder if "the masses were really that stupid?"

Well, Chris' remarks do have a lot of pertinence to current trends in AOR radio (may I suggest a change in terminology to "AHOR", or - "Album Hits Oriented Rock"...pronounced "A Whore?") Many FM stations seem overly concerned with paddling toward the mainstream. In many markets, a profound lack of risk-taking appears to be the order of the day. How many times has each of us heard: "Oh my God, I just came back from L.A., and there's nothing happening down there. Everything sounds the same?" Except that it's not always L.A. as the place of aural boredom. It can be Seattle, San Francisco, New York, or even Eugene, Oregon. Why are there so many fears about doing something distinctive, different, and what you as a programmer feel is right? Why is it so fashionable to follow trends, or to follow stagnating traditions, rather than to aim to set trends, and ambitiously attempt to provide your audience with the best listening experience possible?

Making lots of money is important. It's also important to have good ratings. Cliches, right? What about high quality radio, though? If an album sounds "good" and "right" (admittedly relativistic terms), why be slow in adding it? Does Gerry Rafferty have to have "Baker Street" be an "AM smash!!!" before you feel comfortable about adding the album City To City? Do you have to play Andy Gibb or Saturday Night Fever just because

somewhere it's selling? What if it makes your station sound cheap? What if you determine what's right and what's wrong for your sound and your audience, and then you still feel impelled to play "what sells" because it sells? Have integrity, excitement, and a desire to give the people (we are serving the masses, no?) the best, most, and greatest variety of music and entertainment become meaningless cliches as making lots of money and playing "follow the leader" have become meaningful, if rueful, cliches (other questions arise, such as: how do you play "follow the leader" if the act of being the leader is so frightening for so many?)

I hope we can continue to ask questions about the state of radio, and try together to arrive at some answers and realizations. Somehow, we at KFLY-FM cling to the belief that there can be a very happy marriage between art and the almighty buck; between aesthetics and commercialism. We have heard many of the horror tales about major market paranoia, and we have listened to the stodginess, the rampant sameness, and the lack of ambition in radio, major market and elsewhere (Corvallis, Oregon is the home of KFLY-FM.) We view FM radio as an intelligent alternative: we try to go on what we consider to be the best music immediately. Being slow on product is a disservice to the people who keep all of us alive, and all of us are here to serve the people. Hello?

So, give some thought to Chris Kovarik's remarks of Walrus issue #240. And while you're pondering what she suggests, glance at her playlist report. Look closely at her asterisked new adds. Think some more about her comments, and consider how old much of the product listed by her as "new" is. Hrrum. Hello?

WHO'S MANIPULATING WHO?

A short while back an article appeared in the Wall Street Journal about the record business. It was fascinated with the millions of dollars generated by a recent overnight success. The writer went to the record company people and management people for their assessment of what had happened and how it had happened.

What was interesting about the statements of these people was the confidence with which they talked about how they had manipulated the audience, how they had sold the group, how they had contrived to milk every last unit sale out of the public.

There was an awful lot of presumption in their statements. For if they were truly able to manipulate public taste how come the overwhelming majority of the records which are released never make their money back. How come so many of the records issued end up in the distinguished cut out bins of the world?

Nothing was mentioned of the difficulties in getting this overnight success signed or the fact that it took off so fast that the pressing plants were behind from day one.

The point is that the manipulation is only possible if the public is willing to be manipulated. That following a hit is much more the fact, than the making of a hit.

ic a player as we have in Holland, he still has
made an album which has a subterranean quality
to it. Whether picked or bowed the bass is lim-
ited as a solo instrument, by its narrow range.)
- Oliver Lake/LIFE DANCE OF IS/Novus AN 3003
(Although Oliver Lake is an abstract player he
works from a familiar combo type configuration.
His music, though difficult, remains cogent and
cohesive to a greater extent than Braxton and
others. "Shu-ful" is easy while "Change One" is
bent reggae-jazz which shouldn't be missed.)
- Shel Silverstein/SONGS & STORIES/Parachute
RRLP 9007 (That we have not been treated to a
series of Silverstein's audio madness is our
loss. This multi-talented, totally bent artist
deserves a hearing and we need his view of the
world.)

bands Octopus' playing is solid but their songs
are merely passable. With the material a limit-
ing factor the guitar can scream all it likes,
the response will be the same, limited. Their
one instrumental is best. Merit.)

often sounds like they are getting ready to do
something important. But you wait and rarely

MERIT ALBUMS CONTINUED

- Laura Allan/Elektra 6E-131 (Laura's album is a textbook example of how folk music can be enhanced and made to be more contemporary. Good songs and an inherent sweetness helps Laura Allan find a warm spot. A spark of individuality ignites it.)
- Walt Barry/FIRST VISIT/Muse MR 5172 (For a first visit Walt makes himself at home. His jazz is in the fusion style but it has a light rock side. His tunes drive yet are not tangled in the electronics. A tune like his "Free Flight" really does take off. Side two cools off.)
- Stephen Bishop & John Belushi/ANIMAL HOUSE/MCA 133-1981 (Side one is a short inconclusive interview with a fractured Belushi. Side 2 is the radio place as it contains 2 tunes by each artist, Belushi and Bishop. All four have a distinct '50s quality to them and all four are quite good.)
- Elkie Brooks/SHOOTING STAR/A&M SP-4695 (In her whole career Elkie has reached her real potential only a few times. Here again, we have a good album but, one which too infrequently demonstrates the extraordinary singing Ms. Brooks is capable of delivering.)
- Bill Connors/OF MIST & MELTING/ECM 1-1120 (Though this is Bill's album, it is Jan Gargarek's saxophone which seems in control. The Connor's guitar is ever present but not forceful. With Gary Peacock and Jack DeJohnette providing the support, the album's pace is permitted to wander without fear of it getting off the track.)
- Creed/Asylum 6E-146 (Though competent at all relevant check points, Creed does not bring anything fresh to the rock medium. Their tunes get by but, their lyrics could get them into trouble if listened to carefully. Passable.)
- Crimson Tide/Capitol SW 11806 (Outstanding songs are the missing element most missed. The Crimson Tide performance is forceful and carries the ball by itself.)
- The Dictators/BLOODBROTHERS/Asylum 6E-147 (Through a somewhat muddy recording and through The Dictators audacious intensity several good songs shine. This band contrasts musical tunes with an anti-musical context. That technique puts them among the new wave winners.)
- Marvel Felts/INSIDE LOVE/ABC AY-1080 (Discovering Marvel Felts is like the joy of a new archaeological dig. He is the old days incarnate without being out of date. He is our rockabilly roots.)
- Gabriel/Epic JE 35454 (Those vocal harmonies never lose their appeal. It must be fun to sing them - the ultimate team fouling. Gabriel songs are good and so is their production. Down the groove.)
- David Gates/GOODBYE GIRL/Elektra 6E-148 (Something new, something old. Half of David's album is new and half reissued. The Gates lunemaking reputation holds up with a few good tunes among the new ones. Happily he rocks them at higher percentage than in his past.)
- Egberto Gismonti/SOL DO MEIO DIA/ECM 1-1116 (When his South American heritage takes over the strict European type training Gismonti excels. Mostly he plays in a very pensive and overly serious style which sounds like false emotion. Skill abounds.)
- Sammy Hagar/LEVE ALL NIGHT LONG/Capitol SMAS 11812 (Sammy's songs sound like better songs with live power driving them. He is a midwest act who happens to come from the west. This LP could help establish him generally. Sound quality is fair.)
- John Hammond/FOOTWORK/Vanguard VSD-79400 (True devotees so rarely get recorded that seeing and hearing John Hammond, the younger, is a refreshing reminder of what is at the root of our popular forms. Hammond does Mose Allison as well as he does Robert Johnson.)
- Steve Harley/HOBO WITH A GRIN/Capitol SW-11770 (Steve Harley leaves Cockney Rebel behind him and, although he was the soul of the group, he leaves some of his essence too. Here he filters into the ranks of the many singer/songwriters. He is good but not special in this context.)
- Baird Hershey & The Year of the Ear/LOOKIN' FOR THAT CROON/Novus AN 3004 (No album title this year has been as appropriate. Baird's music flows inside, outside, funky, fusion, intellectual, musical, spacial, ensemble and combo. It's a whole career stuffed into one album. Good but too diffuse.)

MERIT ALBUMS CONTINUED

- Eric Kloss/NOW/Muse MR 5147 (Eric gets some grit into his horn and begins to fulfill the promise he has shown through many years. Some nasty Kloss licks and the forceful drumming of Jimmy Madison brings this LP into a contemporary frame of reference.)
- Jimmy Madison/UMPS ON A SMOOTH SURFACE/Adelphi AD 5007 (It is very impressive that a drummer-lead band can hold together so well on a stylistic level. Especially since the various players have not worked as a unit before and since the tunes were gathered from each of them. Good show.)
- Pat Metheny Group/ECM 1114 (Previously reviewed as an import. Cool and eloquent. Pat Metheny's music provides the kind of jazzy counterpoint that maintains a contemporary feel yet still relieves the intensity tension of rock music. Flowful.)
- Ohio Players/JASS-AY-LAY-OFF/Mercury SEM 1-1720 (To their everlasting credit the Ohio Players play to the beat of a creative drum. They are a funky band unlike any other. They stress quality both in performance and material. Two or three tracks stand out here.)
- Trooper/THICK AS THIEVES/MCA 2377 (Something happens between pen and pressing. Trooper takes pretty good tunes and in their presentation makes them average out. Their presentation has no style, it needs creative arranging. The real potential of Trooper hasn't been felt yet.)
- UFO/OBSESSION/Chrysalis CHR 1182 (UFO's obsession with power rock is no secret. They are quite secure in the style. Smartly, they enhance their work with little musical delicacies which makes the rock that much more powerful.)
- Various Artists/HOTELS, MOTELS & ROAD SHOWS/Capricorn CPN 2-0208 (The rock and roll which comes out of the south has a feel all its own. This album collects some of its strongest forces to prove the point. Chip-kicking at its most developed level.)
- Various Artists - Soundtrack/SGT. PEPPER'S LONELY HEARTS CLUB BAND/RSO RS-2-4100 (The songs are still great but, after a dozen years of advancement they are not improved upon. As with all soundtracks, their success is inextricably tied to the success of the film with which they are associated. (Who's going to bet against Robert Stigwood this year?) There is irony in that the Bee Gees were thought to be a guest group of the Beatles when they first surfaced.)
- War - Soundtrack/YOUNGLOOD/United Artists UA 1A 904-W (That Afro-Cuban jazz groove is positively infectious and their song format does pretty well too - "Sing A Waddy Song." Here lots of dialogue and functional music reduces the real music tune but, when its for real there is nothing watered down.)
- Eberhard Weber - Colours/SILENT FEET/ECM 1-1107 (Previously reviewed as an import. The general mood of Weber's music is cerebral, though it has its moments. As soloists, both Charlie Mariano (sax) and Rainer Bruninghaus (piano) show their melodic wares helping the title track to rise above the mundane.)
- Mason Williams & The Santa Fe Recital/FRESH FISH/Flying Fish FF059 (Mason and Santa Fe Recital create a mini-folk orchestra. When throbbing together, they make an endearing spectacle of themselves. String band fun. Where has Mason Williams been?)

FRINGE ALBUMS

(Good albums which are not progressive, yet hold some interest for progressive audiences.)

- Eddie Daniels/STREET WIND/Marlin 2214 (Versatile Eddie Daniels blows his way into a variety of pop jazz spaces. With flutes, saxophones, and clarinets and an array of styles he is hard to pin down. The third track on each reaches the kind of intensity which creates interest here.)
- Groove Holmes/SHIPPIN' OUT/Muse MR 5134 (Back in the darkened corner of a quiet cabaret there is always a Groove Holmes style trio working out their 20-20's. Holmes would be among the best of them. Easy.)
- Willis Jackson/BAR WARS/Muse MR 5162 (W.A. Brower has written liner notes which applaud the black, working class bar jazz scene, which Willis Jackson epitomizes. It's a rocking kind of R&B mixture with jazz. Willis, joined by Charles Earland, Pat Martino and Idris Muhammad, becomes probably the best of those kinds of bar bands. The title track really cooks.)

Warren Bernhardt/SOLO PIANO/Novus AN 3001 (In a league with Jarrett Warren plays a melodious string of tunes which seem heartfelt. The electronics added to "Tales of a 39 Man" rise a whole new area of experimentation and force us to discard the Jarrett comparison. Cleverly, the quality of the original melody is retained through the electronic manipulations.)

Bim/THISTLES/Elektra 6E-132 (In Bim we obviously have one of those rare unique talents. His voice takes some getting use to but, his sense of melody takes no effort. It is sure and consistent. Emmitt Rhodes surfaces as the producer to do a very creditable job.)

Burton Cummings/DREAM OF A CHILD/Portrait JR 35481 (Cummings does very little wrong on this album. His own writing is outstanding, his choice of the songs of others excels and his voice is its usual terrific. The arrangements, too, are supportive rather than destructive. Strong.)

Keith Jarrett/MY SONG/ECM 1-1115 (Previously reviewed as an import. Jarrett and Garbarek together are an imposing duo. Each injects his melodious tones with a piece of himself. That is why they are more than just excellent players, more than just sidemen. They reach into your imagination to stir images.)

MERIT PLUS ALBUMS CONTINUED

Moon Martin/SHOTS FROM A COLD NIGHTMARE/Capitol SW 11787 (Moon shots like these command attention. Martin has created some fine songs and they have been given yet another creative turn in the arranging. Lots of respect for the past works to Moon Martin's credit.)

Genya Ravan/URBAN DESIRE/20TH Century T-562 (Genya Ravan has come into her own as an artist after years of second ratedness. She's a knock-out rocker, responsible for some terrific songs. Urban Desire represents the largest artistic giant step of the year.)

Chris Rea/WHATEVER HAPPENED TO BENNY SANTINI?/United Artists UA LA879-H (The combined talents of Chris Rea and Gus Dudgeon give us a potent new album. A few terrific songs stick out of the very good just as Chris' album stands out of the pile it was in.)

Doc & Merle Watson/LOOK AWAY!/United Artists UA LA 887-H (Folk music may or may not be in style but, excellent performances never cease to please. Doc & Merle are probably the cream of the folk music crop. They never sing a bad song and they never sing badly. They never play badly either.)

Johnny Winter/WHITE, HOT & BLUE/Blue Sky JZ 35475 (Let's hope Johnny Winter never grows up, never stops going to the musical well. As one of our few links to our heritage, he still cannot be called old-fashioned. His blues rock.)

MERIT ALBUMS

John Abercrombie/CHARACTERS/ECM 1-1117 (Characters is a very special album, the tunes are impressionistic. Meanwhile, John's career plays both ends against the middle, he maintains his credentials among jazzers with Lp's like this one while he plays to fusionists on other albums. Tracks like "Backward Chance" and "Paramour" reach a high point.)

John Abercrombie - Dave Holland - Jack DeJohnette/GATEWAY 2/ECM 1-1105 (Previously reviewed as an import. If the triangle produces the firmest support, then the triangulation of these three talents should translate into great musical strength. It does when the melodies are superior. For example, the middle of "Opening" and Dave Holland's "Nexus.")
