RADIO STATS

OUR RELATIVE CHARTING, AS SEEN BELOW, RESEMBLES BASEBALL'S BATTING AVERAGES. IT ESTABLISHES A RATIO BETWEEN THE IDEAL, (HEAVY AIRPLAY AT EVERY STATION WHICH REPORTED); AND THE WEIGHTED COUNT THAT A RECORDING HAS ACTUALLY EARNED. THIS MATHEMATICAL FORMULA IS APPLIED TO EACH RECORD—FIRST REGIONALLY, THEN NATIONALLY. A DUAL WEIGHTING SYSTEM IS USED TO DERIVE THE COUNT. IT ADJUSTS FOR MARKET SIZE AND FOR HEAVY OR MODERATE AIRPLAY. THESE CHARTS SHOW THE RELATIVE INTENSITY OF RADIO AIRPLAY FOR BOTH NEW AND ESTABLISHED RECORDINGS.

The older songs with completely new arrangements left no lasting impression other than the initial shock of trying to figure out what they were. This is not to say the arrangements were poor - they were excellent, but the semi-disco interpretation of "Maggie's Farm" didn't sound right, especially for Dylan's voice - he's not Donna Summer. The overall effect was ultimately satisfying and disconcerting. The enigma of Bob Dylan has returned once again to shatter all myths and in the process, create new ones.

The Angels prove again that the country's relative isolation has not helped it develop an individual strain of pop music. There is no way to tell that they are from the great below. A standard quality. Mainstream rock band. Merit.)
- Tim Blake/BLAZE'S NEW JERUSALEM/Egg 90.288 (It is obvious from the start that Tim is quite an accomplished electronician. As a melody writer he is only fair. The instrumental "Revelation" is best. Electronic but, not obscure. Merit.)
- Herman Brood & His Wild Romance/SHPRITSZ/Bubble 26122MOT (Herman Brood & His Wild Romance is as much rockin' fun as the name implies. The name also suggests that Brood is a man not at a loss for words. He's got a rye wit and whiskey voice. Merit Plus.)
- Dead Fingers Talk/STORM THE REALITY STUDIOS/Eye NSPH 24 (Using a vocal trick similar to Mick and Keith and Marty and Grace. D.F.T. employs a doubled lead vocal. It's effective. Especially because the songs they are singing are worth the accentuation. Strong lyrically and melodically these aren't punk tunes in spite of the band's name. Merit Plus.)
- Hawklords/25 YEARS ON/Charisma CDS 4014 (Rock from folk-classical school. Hawklords music is big in the manner in which it is mounted. It never gets pompous. The melodies are okay. Merit.)
- Magazine/REAL LIFE/Virgin 26190 XOT (Forceful performances make Real Life come alive. It is in the presentation that Magazine excels. Their style has a slightly bizarre twist to it. Merit.)
- Michel Magne/ELEMENTS/LA TERRE/Egg 90.187 (A rather serene blend of electronic and acoustic instruments helps to make this music interesting. Melodically Michel Magne shows taste, but not inspiration. Special Programming.)
- 999/SEPARATES/United Artists UAG 30209 (With vaguely Beatles harmonies 999 gets across. They are winners and it starts with a great name. Their punk derived rock profits from killer presentation. Merit Plus.)
- Conrad Schnitzler/CON/Egg 90.184 (Electronic music breeds technocrats; people who are able to deal with the transistors, who happen to be musicians too. Conrad sounds like he qualifies. His obscure musings are not whistle-able. Special Programming.)
- Segarini/GOTTA HAVE POP/Bomb 7027 (Established in Canada, Bob Segarini should have had a presence in the U.S. years ago. He's a top-rank rocker with a musical heritage stretching back to rock's formative years. Side two is best. Merit Plus.)
- Wire/CHAIRS MISSING/Harvest SHSP 4093 (Hot Wire burns. They seem purposely anti-musical with slashing fuzz guitar accents and a heavy thud droning on. It's all an attitude applied to fair songs. Merit.)

CONCEPTS

ALBUM RADIO'S RETREAT TO ITS CORE

Thinking beyond the narrow radio definitions of good music for a moment can lead to question why music has existed through all recorded cultures and, presumably, through pre-history too. Whether they were chants or primitive rhythms, the rites of society, either religious or social, seem always to have been surrounded by music. Music, truly, is the enigma of human-kind. The chemistry of our bodies requires no minimum daily requirement, but our psyches seem to have a roughly equivalent need.

Melody has always been the common denominator and it remains so today. Even down to the less than cosmic areas of album radio. From the free form days through the present the search for songs has been a constant.

Old line progressives applied their ears to a broad range of musics; folk, blues and jazz as well as rock. They approach their music policy with a broad stroke. Still, it was always a search for songs.

Today, tighter playlists and a research consciousness seem to have made significant changes in album radio. That is true on the surface but, in the larger sense, not much has really changed. The search for songs is more intense and the process more selective, that's all.

The change is that the narrowing process has filtered out the folk, blues and jazz leaving the album radio medium exclusively a rock n' roll medium. The pattern is as much a retreat to the core as it is a tightening.

MERIT ALBUMS CONTINUED

- Bob Ayala/WOOD BETWEEN THE WORLDS/Pyrhr MSB-6608 (Quite an accomplished singer/songwriter, Bob's songs are so good that you won't even realize that they are pumped full of the word of God. Top-notch production helps too. Write: Word Records, Waco, Texas.)
- The Blackbyrds/NIGHT GROOVES/Fantasy F-9570 (Once beyond the weakest tune on the album, the opening track, Blackbyrds pulls it together. They unify the song format, a funky rhythm and jazzy instincts successfully. Not little album with a couple tracks on each side.)
- Glen Campbell/BASIC/Capitol SN-11722 (Setting his name aside may be tough, but Glen has set MOR aside for Basic. The album is essentially a rock album. It's feeling is authentic and the songs good. One only has to wish that Campbell had gone all the way and unloaded his great, but submerged, guitar playing.)
- Cheech & Chong/SOUNDTRACK - UP IN SMOKE/Warner Brothers BSK 3249 (If their one-joke humor has worn thin, the music on this soundtrack certainly rescues them. It is basic stuff done with resilient assurance.)
- The Clash/GIVE 'EM ENOUGH ROPE/Epic JE 35543 (Virtually depanked, The Clash moves to the mainstream. While the sound is fuzzed and powerful, their songs are pretty good. They aren't drowned out either.)
- Crazy Horse/CRAZY MOON/RCA AFL 1-3054 (Crazy Moon is a solid album. Writing, presentation and production all work in harmony. A totally unique essence is the single missing element in the Crazy Horse sound.)
- Co's/LIGHT UPON LIGHT/Philo 1056 (A poor man's Oregon, Randy Armstrong and Ken LaRoche have a similar idea. Their execution, on all levels, is one step below their predecessors. Less than cosmic melodies bring Co's down to earth.)
- Emerson, Lake & Palmer/LOVE BEACH/Atlantic SD 19211 (Defanged, E. L. & P. seem to be searching for a new way to go. To their credit, they are now writing linear songs but they are not better than average yet. Still, their power wasn't a problem. So why has it been reduced? "Canario," the one chosen tune, is best.)
- Stan Getz/ANOTHER WORLD/Columbia CG 35513 (Too many jazz albums have little respect for the recording process. Essentially, they record a live album in the studio. Further, too many jazz players, especially older ones, cannot adjust to electronic instruments. Stan Getz moves well beyond those lesser thinkers. He understands and masters both the studio and the new gadgets. This album is very warm and contemporary, but misses only the great melody.)
- Grateful Dead/SHAKEDOWN STREET/Arista AB 4198 (Their last album was one of the rare finished Dead albums. Shakedown Street is more a reflection of the band as they are, but it is not as compelling an album. Lowell George's production is strong on rhythmic movement. Deadheads will feel at home.)
- Dan Hartman/INSTANT REPLAY/Blue Sky JZ 35641 (Given the resistance to disco music, the album radio response to Dan's disco-meets-rock album is going to be interesting. The rhythm never stops moving and when Dan is doing songs, instead of repeated disco couplets, the music works. In other words, the more the rock influence is felt, the better.)
- Japan/OBSCURE ALTERNATIVES/Ariola SW-50047 (Rooted in the 100 Reed - David Bowie axis, Japan is more than merely a new wave movement. Songs as good as "Deviation" make them very listenable and their arranging style keeps the listening interesting.)
- Idris Muhammad/YOU AIN'T NO FRIEND OF MINE/Fantasy F-9566 (Jazz meets disco, meets R&B, meets African, meets reggae, meets songs. Here's a case of a drummer who loses his musical equilibrium by finding the rhythmic God. "See Saw" is intriguing, "Tell Me" is a very appealing reggae tune and "Big Foot" is an interesting spaced-African thing. Pick and choose.)
- Willie Nelson & Family/LIVE/Columbia KC 255642 (Willie's music and Willie's caravan roll up into one unified whole. He's been used and abused and it all comes out the other end. He has worked the studio recording to perfection - Phases & Stages - but, he works the stage to perfection every night. Willie Live is the real Willie.)
- Rodney/ROLL IT TIGHT!/Cherry CA 4784 (Faced with a taut little aggregation your attention will be shifted onto the mismatch with songs that aren't quite ready. Energy carries them as the tunes get their best ride. Write: 1201 Antoine Dr., Houston, Tex. 77055.)
- Smokey Robinson/SKOKIN'/Tasla T9-363A2 (In several ways this album is awesome. Smokey's singing is transcendental. It is only rivaled by his writing. The lp's importance is its representation of a man who is The Source for so many of our most favored artists. There are distractions like the audience having to be disregarded. Smokey's "Ooo Baby Baby" is an alternative to Linda's - both versions are great.)

- Rockets/ON THE ROAD AGAIN/Tom N' JERRY TA 4704 (A cross between European electronic rock and disco. Rockets' propulsion is music not dogma. They will challenge rockers and dancers alike. Write: 240 Madison Ave., New York, N.Y. 10016.)
- Todd Rundgren/BACK TO THE BARE/Bearsville 2BRX 6986 (Through a performance which sounds a little sloppy, Todd's towering writing and his ability to get feeling out of his voice comes through. The arrangements are spare, but not tight. His unique talent is obvious.)
- Scorpions/TOKIO TAPES/RCA CPL 2-3039 (Scorpions rips through this live, two record set. Though they lack a really distinctive character they possess all of the other equipment. Even their ballads kick it.)
- Spirit/LIVE/Potato PR 2001 (It's a given that all Spirit albums are muffled and muddy. So a live album doesn't have a chance to have any presence. Still, the music is good. Distributed by First American, Seattle, Wash.)
- Jay Ungar & Lyn Hardy/CATSKILL MOUNTAIN./Philo 1040 (Their upbeat folk music is easy on the ear although the lp seems to jump around too much. Still, things stick out as special like the twin fiddle arrangement of Bob Willie "Maiden's Prayer.")
- Jerry Jeff Walker/Elektra 6E-161 (Parts of this album are more formal than is standard for Jerry Jeff. Still, that comfortable Texas barroom music comes through. Whether formal or informal, melancholy or rocker, Walker spins a natural sound.)

- Truth/DEPARTURE/Paragon PA 21057 (Using rock influenced metaphors Truth sings Jesus music. Saccharine voices don't work with some of the music and the writing is plainly rank amateur. An enthusiastic performance makes it even more ludicrous.)

FRINGE ALBUMS

(Good albums which are not progressive, yet hold some interest for progressive audiences.)

- Joni Dism/CHALK IT UP TO LOVE/Meridian MRL 219(Fop. The problem for Joni, pop or not, is that her album and her career have no focus. She's just trying to sing a hit song - that's not enough. Write: 10931 Westminister Ave., Garden Grove, Ca. 92643.)
- Hampton Hawes/A LITTLE COFFEEHOUR NIGHT MUSIC/Arista-Freedom AF 1043 (While the thrust of this lp is grooved be-bop a few tracks step out. Both lead off tracks, to be specific, wind into strong contemporary pieces. Dexter Gordon sits in too.)
- Melissa Manchester/DON'T CRY OUT LOUD/Arista AB 4184 (Leon Ware's production of Melissa is grand, but it never gets to the middle of the musical road. A strong non-rock record.)
- Mandrill/NEW WORLDS/Arista AB 4195 (More focused than Mandrill has been, yet there is a noticeable stylistic difference between side 1 and side 2. The front side is smooth while the back side is funky. Go to the bank.)
- Jackie McLean/NEW WINE IN OLD BOTTLES/Inner City IC 4003 (Backed by Hank Jones, Ron Carter and Tony Williams, Jackie starts this session one step ahead. McLean is a terrific player who has been under-recognized for too long. Be-bop to the extreme.)
- David "Fathead" Newman/KEEP THE DREAM ALIVE/Prestige P-10106 (Newman's music is exemplary of a whole school of lounge jazz which grew up in the sixties and seventies. His is the classiest. Nice melodies placed in a benign setting.)
- Clivia Newton-John/TOTALLY - HOT/MCA 3067 (Not quite totally hot but, Clivia makes a musical movement toward rock. There will always be a pop glow around what she does, but here it is less saccharin.)
- Ren Ddrich/BLACKSTICK/Classic Jazz 35 (Clarinet is not an "in" instrument at this time. Here is a very mild combo lp which features it. Pleasant throughout, it is doubtful that the blackstick will come back into vogue because of Ren.)
- Bonnie Pointer/Motown #7-FINE (Bonnie qualifies her album for a review here because of the last track on her album. "My Everything" drips with illusions to Billie Holiday. The rest of the album leans toward pop R&B.)
- Stylus/Prodigal P7-10030R1 (A smoothly pop rock sound from Australia gloves through their best material. Their funky change up isn't as affective while their songs get off best during solos. Get the point.)

The J. Geils Band/SANCTUARY/EMI SO-17006 (The J. Geils Band's instinct for the essential in rock music is remarkable. Lots of these Wolf/Justman songs have a special hook in them. Strong down to the last track.)

Robert Johnson/CLOSE PERSONAL FRIEND/Infinity INF-9000 (Going for the jugular, Robert Johnson projects a rock 'n' roll spirit throughout his album. He is a guitar force-field. Several special songs push their way through the radiated air.)

Mike Mainieri and Warren Bernhardt/FREE SMILES/Arista-Novus AN 3009 (Interesting, original and melodious throughout, Mainieri and Bernhardt spent some worthwhile time on the stage at Montreux. The harmonic compatibility of vibes and piano has been demonstrated many times before, but here a new twist is added. In a league with the Modern Jazz Quartet.)

MERIT PLUS ALBUMS CONTINUED

Bob Marley & The Wailers/BABYLON BY BUS/Island ISLD 11 (His concerts are joyous events. The other live album had religious qualities about it. This one is merely fine. Marley's energy translates from stage to vinyl with little of the usual loss.)

Johnny Paycheck/ARMED & CRAZY/Epic KE 35444 (We are all very accustomed to rocker friends who use country music licks. Well, Johnny Paycheck proves that you can arrive at the same place coming from the other direction. He applies real rock moves to his country. Humor and good music - country and country rock - find a way to win.)

Queen/JAZZ/Elektra 6E-166 (Perfect execution is the key to Queen's success. Half of their arrangements are artificially complex, usually on the lesser quality songs. Then Freddie Mercury sings a song like "Jealousy" and all resistance breaks down. Whistle the production if not the songs.)

Peter Tosh/BUSH DOCTOR/Rolling Stones COC 39109 (Bush Doctor never quite regains the electricity of "Don't Look Back." Mick and Peter are terrific together. Still, Peter has put together his best total collection of songs. The Lp moves gracefully.)

Jesse Colin Young/AMERICAN DREAMS/Elektra 6E-157 (Jesse has never been a giant star, but he has been an artist of enduring and consistent quality. He is dependably good. This album proves the point again. Even his "American Dreams Suite" holds together well.)

MERIT ALBUMS

AC-DC/IF YOU WANT BLOOD.../Atlantic SD 19212 (Knock your sox off rock. Live AC-DC doesn't let up. Their compact style leaves just enough room for nice moves.)

Greg Alper Band/FAT DOGGIE/Adelphi AD 5009 (Though various musical personalities one gets the notion that Greg isn't sure of what he wants to be. The second side's pure jazz moves to the edge regularly. Side one, however, is satisfying, but not especially to jazz people. It's better catagorized as R & Boogie.)
