



I have seen an ad by Nytec Electronics offering a reproduction cathedral radio, complete with an AM/FM radio, in a real wooden cabinet, not like the plastic one's on the market over the past years. The price is \$149.95, a little high, but one must consider it's not a volume production item.

I have been soliciting articles for publication in A.R.C. from other collectors, but am facing the same problem other club publications experience - little or no response. Is there anyone out there in "radio land" who can share some aspect of the hobby with his fellow readers of A.R.C.! I would like to make A.R.C. the largest classified ad publication, but at the same time articles are needed to make A.R.C. a little more interesting. Load your camera with B&W film, shoot some photos, and then write a 1 or 2 page article describing what you have just photographed. It may be a radio, group of radios, or even your whole collection. In your October 84 issue, the Collector's Corner featured a write up on a British radio called ECKO A-22. I was so interested in that set I immediately called my cousin in London and by her efforts I now own an ECKO A-22, perhaps the only one in California.

Cousin Hilary told me these radios, which are 40 years old, are quite plentiful. The one I received is flawless and is a unique collectable I must say looking very Art Deco-ish. It receives vast amounts of radio stations despite being only 4 tubes (including rectifier). Since the set operates from 240 volts, rather than alter the set in any way, i.e. replacing the power transformer, I simply installed a 240 volt outlet for it to use. Most homes have 120/240 power so this is no big task.

I'd like your readers to know of my availability to these sets and if people are interested in this one of a kind collectable, possibly I can get them one. Those interested send a S.A.S.E. and when I get enough inquiries I'll check it out.


In 1930 one of the first nationally distributed brands to jump on the midget set bandwagon was the Gloritone made by the United States Radio and Television Corporation with offices in Chicago and a factory on 3301 South Adams Street in Marion, Indiana. They introduced the Model 27 in July, 1930. It was a five tube set employing an unusual chassis worthy of note. From the side it is an "L" shaped affair fastened to the upper rear of the cabinet. The tubes hang upside down from the horizontal part of the cabinet. Although a rather plain looking set, it was a great seller and is quite commonly still found.

They did the midget sets one better and came out with the 27S Spinet Console using the same chassis as the 27 mantel radio but turned it upside down. Now at least the tubes were right side up!

This particular 27S is a "Radiotrope"; one of many private brands made by U.S. Radio. It is housed in a dark walnut veneer cabinet 29" high, 14" wide, 11-1/2" deep, the entire set weighing less than 35 lbs. A tuned radio frequency circuit is used using two 24's in the RF stages, a 27 detector, a 45 output tube, and an 80 rectifier. An 8" Utah speaker is used.

The Model 27 is a well built set but some components are prone to failure. The "Canohm" shunt resistor is best replaced and frequently the audio transformer and speaker field are open. Many times these can be repaired by disconnecting the offending part and hooking a neon sign transformer of 4000 to 10,000 volts and turning it on for 10-20 seconds. It may be necessary to repeat a few times. I've had tremendous success this way.

Also, if troubled by poor reception (squealing) or no reception; but everything looks okay, try cleaning the grounding contacts between the tuner rotors and ground. All bypass and filter capacitors are best replaced. Use 400 volt or better for bypass, 450 or better for filters.



RADIOTROPE 27

The 27 is a fine sounding set although lacking in selectivity. The little consolette is a popular piece and quite hard to find. The cabinet legs are rather flimsy, and I imagine easily broken, probably resulting in many being discarded. Also made was the 27P which was a consolette radio phonograph.

Next month the 1931 Brunswick 11A mantel radio will be featured. Happy Collecting!...Frank and Diana Heathcote.



CROSLEY REVIEW



Of all the radio manufacturers, one of the most popular with collectors is the Crosley Radio Corporation. AUDION DETECTOR • The Audion Detector was available for only \$6 in 1923 and was primarily for use with the Model 1. Its binding post and cabinet were planned to hook up with a crystal receiver on the left side... and RFTA or 2-Stage Amplifier on the right side.

CROSLEY



MODEL 51-Crosley's old Model V with an added stage of amplification became this new 2-tube Model 51 (Model V plus 1 V1 or 51). The cabinet was the same size as the models V, 2-step amplifier and "Ace" one-tubers. This early version 51 has the tap switch top-center on the panel above the transformer to make room for the added socket. Antenna and ground post are grouped upper left due to extreme low-left position of the tuner. The model 51 was one of Crosley's most successful sales items.



MODEL 51-The 2-tube Model 51 was altered later in 1924, and the panel again resembled the earlier Model V. The C- post was moved to the extreme right in order to align with the amplifier's binding post configuration. The companion one-tube 51-A amplifier, shown attached to the right, gave the 51 the same receiving characteristics as Crosley's Model 52. Note the on/off switch in line with the binding post on the amplifier's right side.



MODEL 51. Late in 1924, Crosley produced this wood-paneled Model 51... which was not mentioned in advertising and appeared for only a brief period. Best guess has it that it was the forerunner of the wood-paneled sets to come, and was meant to test the publics reaction. Maybe Crosley simply ran out of Model 51 bakelite panels.

PENNA. WIRELESS MFG. CO.

One of the more obscure radio companies in the early days of radio was the Pennsylvania Wireless Mfg. Company. Collector Jerry Finamore of New Castle, PA has made a specialty of collecting this equipment, as this is the city where the equipment was manufactured. As very little is known of the company, Jerry has endeavored to trace the history of the company as well as collecting the radios made. He welcomes additional information from other collectors concerning Penna. Wireless Mfg. Co. and is always in search of additional models to add to his collection. The accompanying photos of his collection show the results of Jerry's search. The story which follows is a brief glimpse of what information he was able to acquire. (GBS)

About 1910 a man named Rex Patch was working as a telegraph operator for the railroad, and was experimenting with wireless radio on the side. Sometime in 1914 he started the Pennsylvania Wireless Manufacturing Company. In the early years of the company he was manufacturing audion control boxes, loose couplers, tuners, and crystal detectors which were sold mainly in the Western Pennsylvania area. He continued to manufacture these components until about 1919-20, at which time he began to manufacture one tube regenerative sets. After the one tube regenerative sets came three and four tube regenerative sets along with various circuit designs he was experimenting with in order to get around patents. Then in 1925 he came out with a three dial TRF set that was semi-largely advertised.

The early sets were made of a fine quality oak that was usually a blond finish. The later sets were made of walnut and had access to the tubes and circuitry from a door in the back. The quality and workmanship of the sets before 1920 was excellent, but as competition increased in the 20's, the quality of the sets had to be made compatible with the market, especially since it was a small company without large sales volume. The company managed to stay in business until 1929. At this time he had a large amount of inventory out on credit and the creditors were going out of business. (It is unknown if the company ever got into the manufacturing of electric sets... J.F.)






FIG. 4—THIS IS SIMILAR TO FIG. 3 EXCEPT THAT IT HAS TWO TAP SWITCHES. AS FAR AS I KNOW THIS SET IS THE FIRST TO HAVE THE ARMSTRONG LICENSE ON THE NAME PLATE. PROBABLY MADE ABOUT 1919-20. ALL OF THE REGENERATIVE SETS MADE AFTER THIS HAD THE ARMSTRONG LICENSE.



FIG. 5—DETECTOR AND TWO STAGE AMPLIFIER. THIS SET HAS AN EXTERNAL POTENTIOMETER ON THE DETECTOR TUBE. ALL OF THE REGENERATIVE SETS MADE AFTER THIS ONE HAD THIS TYPE OF CONTROL.



FIG. 6—THIS SET CONSIST OF TWO VARIOMETERS AND AN VARIOCOUPLER WITH A DETECTOR TUBE. THE KNOBS ON THIS SET ARE OF HIS OWN MANUFACTURE. THEY ARE UNIQUE IN THAT THE CENTER (WHERE YOU GRAB IT) IS 12 FLAT SIDES, RATHER THAN THE GROVED ROUND TYPE. THE TUBE IN THIS SET IS ACESSED FROM A DOOR WHICH PULLS DOWN IN THE BACK OF THE CABINET. MADE ABOUT 1921-22.



FIG. 7—A ONE TUBE REGENERATIVE SET USING A TUNING CONDENSER AND A TAPPED COIL. THIS SET WAS TYPICAL OF HIS STYLE, WITH THE DOOR OPENING IN THE REAR AND THE EXTERNAL POTENTIOMETER.




FIG. 8—THIS IS THE SAME CIRCUIT AS FIGURE 7, EXCEPT IT HAS TWO STAGES OF AUDIO AMPLIFICATION. THE CABINET IS LONGER TO INCLUDE THE EXTRA CIRCUITRY.



FIG. 9—THIS SET IS DESIGNED FOR USE WITH DRY CELL BATTERIES AND IS INTENDED TO USE THREE 199 TUBES. THE CIRCUIT AND CABINET IS BASICALLY THE SAME AS FIGURE 8.



FIG. 10—I KNOW VERY LITTLE ABOUT THIS SET. I FOUND IT IN THE ATTIC OF THE BUILDING WHERE THEY WERE MANUFACTURED. IT IS A FIVE TUBE SET AND IS INTENDED FOR USE WITH A LOOP ANTENNA. IT HAS ONE TUNING DIAL, A STABILIZER CONTROL, AND THREE TUBE RHEOSTATS.




FIG. 11—THE "DELUXE FIVE", A FIVE TUBE TRF SET. THE TOP OF THE CABINET LIFTS UP TO ACCESS THE TUBES AND CIRCUITRY. HE BEGAN TO USE THE NAME "PENN C" ON THE FRONT OF HIS RADIOS, WHILE THE LABEL INSIDE STILL READS "PENNA. WIRELESS MFG. CO.". I HAVE ONE AD FOR THIS SET FROM APRIL 1925.




