EDITOR'S COMMENTS

The frost is on the pumpkin here in New England. and indoor activities like auctions and restoration projects have begun to take precedence over outdoor flea markets and other such events. In this issue, we report on a major Estes auction and no fewer than

three restoration projects.

The first of these projects is unusual in that it is not a radio or electronic restoration but an audio project in which recorded sounds are recovered from an antique and obsolete medium. Even more unusual is the fact that Nick Gent's grandfather made the recordings on a wire recorder that he built himself. Nothing about the original project was standard, even the home-brew wire spools on which family voices were recorded.

Nick took painstaking steps to recover those recordings with a combination of equipment: a vintage wire recorder, modern sound processing equipment, computers, and software. No matter what your restoration interests, you will admire Nick's ingenuity in recovering a piece of his family history.

What at first appeared to be a bad packing/shipping disaster proved to be a doable restoration project for Richard Arnold. His 5-tube, AC/DC, GE Model GD-60 makes an unusual addition to his collection.

In the name of preservation, not monetary value, Claude Chafin restored his super sensitive Hallicrafters Model S-72L radio. His fellow Ham collectors should be pleased with the results — "a pretty cool radio."

And there's always room in these pages for "pretty

cool" finds that are radio-related. Kent Houck shares his discovery of a Crosley Temperator — a heater fan contained in a radio loudspeaker case. The ever-inventive Powel Crosley seemed able to find a use for any surplus parts.

Not much at the Estes Auction featuring the Dexter Deeley Collection would be labeled "surplus." The depth and quality of the offerings were such that I couldn't resist making the trip to Ohio. It was worth the effort to see so many sets from early manufacturers lined up waiting for new owners. Most impressive were the 19 Grebe sets accounting for over one-quarter of the proceeds, as well as the nearly 50 crystal sets offered.

Mark Stein adds the first of a new series of radio guides to his long list of very useful aids to the radiocollecting community. This one concentrates on plastic radios, and reviewer Geoff Shearer likes it for its presentation of the material and its handy size.

RESTORATION TOPICS

Wire Recorder Project Recovering Family Steel Wire Recordings

Perusing radio/phono discussion groups online can yield rewards. A chance look at http://groups.google.com/group/rec.antiques.radio+phono led us to the following article. We appreciate Nick Gent's granting us permission to reprint the article. Nick himself had gone to this site to solicit help on his project — another example of the importance of the Internet as a research tool in the preservation of radio history. (Editor)

My grandfather was a remarkable man who was fascinated by technology and built all kinds of electronic and mechanical gadgetry during his lifetime. He started working on electronic home projects in an era when components were only just becoming available to hobbyists. Among other things, he built electronic musical instruments, radi-

os, and even a TV, around which all the neighbors gathered to watch some of the first BBC broadcasts from the Crystal Palace in London where he lived.

In the late 1940s, he built an electronic wire

recorder. Tape recording had not yet been introduced commercially and steel wire, thinner than a human hair, was the only medium available for making audio recordings. Although by this time wire recorders were being introduced to the domestic market in America, in Britain they were still a rarity, confined mainly to the military and to offices where they were used as dictaphones.

My grandfather was able to use his wire recorder, along with a homemade microphone, to make recordings of my family, including my great grandparents and my mother as a little girl. He also recorded all his favorite music from the radio and even copied a couple of old 78 rpm discs. His recorder is long gone, but about 20 spools of wire have survived and have remained tantalizingly silent — until now! The stacked spools are shown in Figure 1.

My grandfather made his own spools, one of which is shown in Figure 2. Needless to say, they don't fit any commercially available recorders!

WEBSTER-CHICAGO WIRE RECORDERS

To play these wires I needed to get hold of a vintage wire recorder. These old recorders are very rare in Britain, but by an extraordinary coincidence the only ones I could find for sale in the

whole of the UK were from a dealer just a few kilometres from my home in Edinburgh, Scotland. He had two "Webster-Chicago" (or "Webcor") recorders in unknown condition and let me have them both for a reasonable price.

The two recorders are a Webster-Chicago Model 180, shown in use in Figure 3, and a Model 288, shown in Figure 4. The Model 180 is a popular domestic model from about 1948. The one I bought had been modified for the UK market by the addition of a 240V-120V step-down transformer.

The Model 288, ca 1950, is a slightly updated version of the Model 180. It has a somewhat bigger cabinet than the Model 180 cabinet with an improved audio response and an improved antispill mechanism. The set that I bought has an ominous smell of wood smoke, and I haven't had time to open it up yet, let alone restore it!

A spool for a Webster-Chicago wire recorder is shown in Figure 5. Several of these came with the wire recorders that I bought.

There are some excellent resources on the web describing the history of Webster-Chicago (well, it used to be located there!), and just about everything you need to know if you own a wire recorder. I'm very grateful to the authors of these sites. Among the sites are http://members.aol.com/webcorinfo/webcor and http://www.soundsaver.com/webcor.com/webster-chicago,etc.htm.

THE RECOVERY PROCESS

Using information gathered from these sites, I now knew what I had to do in order to play back the wires. I chose to work on the Model 180 as it seemed to be the cleanest, and, as it turned out,

was adapted for UK mains voltage. The steps were as follows:

1. Restore the mechanical operation of the Model 180. First, clean and lubricate all mechanical parts, especially the "bailer" mechanism which ensures the wire is correctly bailed onto the spools. The failure of this mechanism results in disastrous tangles!

Finally, replace the felt pads and adjust the mechanism that is used to "brake" the rotating spools. Applying just the right pressure to the spools ensures that they are packed tightly after play or rewind. Figure 6 shows the pressure pad (Continued on following page)

Now that the contents of the wires are safely captured, the next project is to fully restore at least one of the Webster recorders. With some

carefully placed bits of connector block inside the Model 180, it will still be easy to isolate the old electronics and take a feed directly from the playback head for any future audio recovery projects. Feel free to contact me if you have any wire spools that I may be able to help with.

General Electric Model GD-60

Richard Arnold describes a set in poor condition that appears to have had additional damage as a result of bad packing. But he did what every avid collector would do and restores it to good condition. (Editor)

Here is a somewhat unusual looking radio with a slant-front and no dial scale. I found it on eBay a while back, and even though the cabinet looked as if it was in bad condition, the chassis looked pretty good in the pictures. I decided to bid on it because of the unusual look, and I thought it would be a good restoration project.

When the radio arrived, the cabinet had completely fallen apart in the box. Nothing was actually broken — it just had fallen apart at the seams. Luckily,

the chassis was still attached to the bottom part of the cabinet, and it was not harmed. In fact, the chassis was in very good condition, considering, and it even worked. The speaker had some holes in it and some of the grille cloth was missing in places, but that was easily replaced. What was

amazing was that the tubes were not all broken up. I knew the cabinet needed work, but I didn't expect this disaster.

THE MODEL GD60

The General Electric Model GD-60, shown

in Figure 1, is a compact, 5-tube, AC-DC superhet receiver. It is rather small, measuring only about 13" wide x 7½" tall x 6 ½" deep at the base. The tube types used in this radio are the following: a 6A8G converter and oscillator; a 6K7 IF amplifier; a 6Q7 detector, AVC, and amplifier; a 25L6G power amplifier; a 25Z5 rectifier; and finally, a 49-A ballast tube. No dial light is used in the radio, and the IF is 455 Kc.

Some of the set's other features include an IF wave trap, an automatic volume control and an improved dust-proof speaker. The set incorporates a trimmer-tuned, "Touch-Tuner," push-button system, allowing the set-up of five stations for automatic tuning. The trimmers for the Touch-Tuner are attached to a framework that lies across the workings of the chassis and is fastened to the underside of the chassis by four screws.

I have a few push-button radios in my collection, but this is the first one that I have seen with this configuration. I have, however, talked to another collector who has a number of push-button radios in his collection, and he said that this configuration is rather common.

Looking at the front of the radio, you will notice the absence of the usual slide-rule dial. What there is though are two thumbwheels, similar to those that you might find on early battery sets of the 1920s, like a Radiola 20, or on early cathedral sets, like maybe an Echophone S-2. The thumbwheel on the left side of the grille cloth is the on/off and volume control, while the thumbwheel on the right of the grille cloth is the dial scale. The grille cloth is not original.

There are six push buttons, five of which you can preset by tuning the antenna and oscillator trimmers that are attached to a metal framework covering the center part of the underside of the chassis. The push button on the far right is the button that changes the

tuning from manual to automatic.

The cabinet has just been recondifioned. I didn't have to restore it. After I got it put back together, all it needed was just a good cleaning and some touchup work. What appears to be inlaid wood on the ends of the wood cabinet is painted on.

According to a copy of a General Electric pricing schedule, shown in Figure 2, dated January 3, 1939, the Model GD-60 sold for \$22.95. I kept track of a few of these sets as they came up on eBay. The ones that I have seen there have all been pretty rough looking, including mine, and they went for around \$18 to \$35.

I was lucky as this one cleaned up pretty well, and when I was all done fixing it up, it made an interesting looking addition to the collection. I have it sitting on top of one of my few console radios and I play it once in a while. I like it, as it sounds good and has good selectivity.

AUCTION REPORT

Estes Auctions — Deeley Collection Burbank, Ohio — April 22, 2006


REPORTED BY RAY AND EDITH CHASE

Ray and Edith Chase report on a very significant auction of early broadcast and wireless items — the Dexter Deeley collection. Since Dexter's collection paralleled my own interest, the event was a "must attend" for me. I have augmented Ray and Edith's photos with some I took at the event. And, yes, I did acquire a set or two for my collection. (Editor)

The April 2006 Estes auction dealt primarily with the collection of Dexter Deeley from Lake Lure, North Carolina. It had been much anticipated by the radio collecting fraternity who were familiar with its depth and quality. Dexter was a long time officer of the AWA and had spent 50 years amassing an outstanding

radio collection. He felt that it was time to share his collection with others; hence, this well publicized auction

The collection of Grebe receivers was truly outstanding, and this was reflected in the prices realized. The entire auction brought in over \$200,000, and the 19 Grebe sets accounted for a little over \$58,000 of that total. An early Grebe

CR-6 sold for \$25,000 while an early CR-5 yielded a sale price of \$10,000. One reason for the excitement was the excellent condition of the sets, as well as the fact that these particular Grebes were early versions with front panel rheostats. Most other Deeley radios in the auction were exceptionally clean and in fine condition, and most of the Ham gear included operating manuals.

Adding to the excitement were nearly 50 crystal sets, some of which fell into the rare category. Also included were quite a few really nice console radios, many excellent Ham sets, lots of nice 1930s wood radios, and other early radios by Atwater Kent, DeForest, Kennedy, Western Electric and others. Truly a high-end sale, and if you had a yen to add significant pieces to your collection, this was the place to be.

Even the test equipment collectors were accommodated, as there were many Jewell test sets that are seldom seen. A very early German glass enclosed lab instrument was another rare item. There was a fine collection of books and ephemera as well, but that was sold by "choice" and I could not track the prices realized. A side auction of nice advertising signs and posters was held about mid-morning. Unfortunately I could not record the results.

There was a minimum of box lots and low value items this time, but the tubes offered for sale were plentiful and interesting. A single wing spherical

Audion received a great deal of detailed inspection, and although it was reported to be original, most experts were dubious as to its origin, and it was sold as questionable for \$200. For the phonograph collectors there was a goodly number of cylinder phonographs and parts. A very special Capital disc phonograph built into a table lamp complete with frilled shade sold for \$1,600.

The weather on Friday was threatening and a

violent cloudburst occurred during the evening viewing. This area of Ohio had experienced a severe week of rain with some flooding, so pessimism was the operative word regarding the weather. Some additions to the auction were still being received on Friday evening, but none came in Saturday morning. Saturday began cloudy and threatening, but soon the sun came out, and the day turned out to be excellent.

I tabulated 643 lots but could not cover any side auctions of advertising items or box lots, as well as the books and ephemera sold by choice. I stopped recording at 5:30 P.M., while the auction continued on until about 6:10 P.M.

The total sale price of my listing is \$193,662, but that does not include the sales that I missed or the 5 percent buyers (Continued on following page)

premium charged at this location. This is also true of all the tabulated prices and any prices quoted above.


There was a good crowd of buyers in attendance as would be expected at such an important sale and many went home with new prized possessions. Even if you did not get to take anything home, it was a pleasure to see and touch this fine collection of radio history. Such is the unique draw and experience of these Estes auctions.















The Antique Radio Collector's Source Book — Plastic Radios By Mark V. Stein


The new guide book, The Antique Radio Collector's Source Book -Plastic Radios by Mark Stein is the first of a new series in a totally different size from his earlier books - a smaller 6" x 9" format. This makes it easier to transport to swap meets and on road trips to antique shops and auctions. However, it is similar to the earlier books on consoles and tabletops in that it is devoted exclusively to one subject.

What I like most about Mark's guides are the explanations he presents in the front dealing with pricing, condition, and history. Unlike many other "price guide" authors, he doesn't jump right into pictures and prices but rather starts with a disclaimer about prices. He then moves into an

overview of plastics, followed by an evaluation of the condition of the radio, as well as items to avoid.

I'm not up much on plastic history but I did learn that "horn" was molded into consumer products, that the smell from my knob boxes is years old tenite re-enforced with butyric acid, and that "gutta percha" is natural latex.

The discussion on Catalin describes the demise of this substance for cabinets, but I would add one reason — that the lead molds were scarce after World War II because many had been turned into bullets during the war. Every Catalin cabinet had to be given human attention before it was ready for a chassis, and manpower for that process became too expensive after the war. In the "General Considerations" section (dealing with what to look for in a radio), I might also add that ballast tubes



were in glass enclosures as well.

The radios featured in this guide are representative across the board of plastic radios from the early 1930s to the more common sets of the late 1950s. There are a few transistor sets listed, but, by and large, this source book is for plastic table radios up to and including 1960 sets.

The prices reflect going rates, although I don't know that the collector is yet ready to spend \$25 on some of the early 1960s radios. The high end and medium priced sets have been well researched on value and accurately reflect what they would sell for at a swap meet or auction. I believe better information is available today because of online auctions

and auction reviews reported in Antique Radio Classified.

Once again, Mark Stein has produced a fine addition to our hobby library, and this source guide should see plenty of wear and tear in the next several years. Remember, though, when you're out there buying radios, make sure you like what you're buying because you may have to live with it for a long time.
