



#### **ON THE COVER**





Steven R. Ralston of Lyons, Colorado was a master restoration craftsman of vintage jukeboxes, radios, phonographs, light fixtures, stained glass & furniture. He and his wife owned one of the longest continually operating antiques shops in Colorado. 




