



AUSTRALIA NEW: 2CR (550kC), Cumnock, NSW, lokW, commenced broadcasting on April 29. It is being received with strong signals; 7CT (900), Queenstown, Tasmania, 100w, opened on June 1; <u>ASB</u>, Kingaroy, 2kW, should be on the air soon; <u>LRM</u> (1450kC), Roma, 100w, was scheduled to take the air in June; <u>5SE</u> (13LOkC), Mount Gembier, S. A., 100w, to share time with <u>LWK</u> and to relay <u>5AD</u>, is under construction; <u>6PM</u> (1390), 100w, owned by Broadcasters Ltd., St. George's House, St. George's Terrace, Perth, and located at Fremantle, W.A., came on the air Arril 22; 6GN (1370), Gereldton, W.A., 500w, now under construction, should be on air by October; 7HT (1090), 300w, owned by Metropolitan Broadcasters Pty.Ltd., h Elizabeth St., Hobert, Tasmania, is on the air. CHANGES: 3SH to 1330kC; 5MU to 1450kC; 4WK to 1340kC; 3AR now on 630kC; 3YB now on 1210kC; 2RG (1470), Griffith, to increase to 100w power; 5AD, 5DN and 5KA, all of Adelaide, have increased to 500w power each. (Niven, W.A.W.N., McCormick, Wignall, Breen, Cameron, Preece. Currie, Tune In, CDXR).

"DX'ING DOWN AND UNDER"

"DX is very slack here just now. Conditions have been very erratic during the past two months. The Aus tralians take possession of the dial from just before dark until midnight. Then the 'Easterners are heard' with China best; Japan fair and the Siemese and Indians good on clear nights. The best heard of the Chinese are: XGOA, LUHO, XHNG, XMHA, XMHD, FFZ, XQHC, XHNX and XMHB. Recent loggings include: JOLG, JOAK -1, JFAK, JOSK, JOXK, JODG, JFBK, Poznan Rome, Kuldiga, Juan-les-Pins, Trondelag, Brussells 1, Milan 1, Radio Cite

XQHC and XEAW". (G.Currle, N.Z.)
"The IDA program from 4BC was well heard here. The new 2ZB in Wel lington, puts an RR signal in here. Conditions are erratic however, as some nights LBC has complete charge of this channel. A Dunedin dx'er has received a veri from RW52, Tchite, USSR, which broadcasts on 556kC, with 20kW. This is the mystery station reported by many near 7em EST last November and Dec ember. 2CR and 6WA, the new 10kW Aussies are being well heard here to (Alan I. Breen, Dunedin, N. Z.)

"Latest loggings are VUD, VUC, 2CR 7QT, 3WV, 6GF and an unidentified Jap on 790kC. Another JO thought to be JOQK was heard on 960kC. KZRM is beginning to come in now. 3AR was heard on, and announcing its frequency as 620kC, although the FMG's Dept. says it is on 630kC now. 7ZL also seems to be roving about".
