DX NEWS NOVEMBER 28, 1934.

This week we have a lot of news for you regarding our "Canadian Nights" which Ray Lewis and C.G. Huber have been working on so faithfully during the past several weeks.

However first of all we want to thank Alec Kinghorn for the excellent program that he presented for the members of our club this past Friday morning over station CMCA. We hope you all sent in your reports on this broadcast. In a recent letter to our Vice-President, Alec told him that he was very much discouraged with the response he had been getting on all of his Cuban DXes, on several of them he didn't even receive ONE report. This certainly is downheartening to anyone who is putting forth such splendid efforts as Alec is for all of the DXers down there in Cuba. Let's all resolve to send him a report on each of his broadcasts so that he will know that the N.R.C. is 100% in back of him on these fine broadcasts. Don't let it ever be said that the NRC fell down on the job.

Alec also informed Joe Becker in the same letter that COK are now installing a new transmitter and will operate on 610 kycs in the future. Also that CMOY is now operating on 1375 kycs. Many thanks for all of this fine information, Alec, it surely is greatly appreciated.

We also received a letter from Mr. R. R. Hayes, Chief Operator of KMAC San Antonio, Texas in which he informs us that he has been ordered to cancel all scheduled DX programs for all radio clubs. We are indeed very sorry to learn that this is the case as KMAC surely did give us a splendid broadcast earlier in the season.

Now for the information on our big Canadian Party! This party will take place on Saturday morning, December 8 and Sunday morning, December 9, we shall take them on each day separately.

On Saturday morning, December 8 we find that CHRC 580 kycs. will be one of the first Canadians to take the air for us from 3:00 to 4:00 A.M., E.S.T. CHRC operates from Quebec, Quebec. We want to thank Mr. Huber for having arranged this broadcast.

Also from 3:00 to 4:00 A.M., E.S.T. on the same morning we find that CKCK 1010 kycs. Regina, Sask. will be on the air for the members of our club and the CDXR. We want to thank Ray Lewis for having made arrangements for this broadcast.

At 4:00 A.M., E.S.T. we find that 10BP that splendid 25 watter that operates on 1200 kycs. and is located in Wingham, Ontario will take the air to present a half hour broadcast for the members of our club. To Mr. Huber goes the credit for having arranged this broadcast.

Following the 10BP broadcast at 4:30 A.M., E.S.T. and continuing for a period of one hour we find that CKBI 1210 kycs. Prince Albert, Sask. will transmit a DX program for the members of our club. Ray Lewis deserves the credit for having made the arrangements of this broadcast.

Then at 10 PM E.S.T. CHNS 930 kycs. Halifax, Nova Scotia will broadcast a half hour program dedicated to the members of our club. We want to thank our Advisory Chairman, Mr. Huber for having arranged this broadcast.

Also for Saturday morning, December 8 we find that CMW 930 kycs. Havana, Cuba will present a DX program in honor of the members of our club. Our good friend Alec Kinghorn will be at the mike, let's prove to Alec that we are really going to support his broadcasts in the future and have him send us a report the next time he writes that will be similar to the one we received from KMAC on their broadcast for our club, in which they said that they received the best response they had ever gotten on any DX on their program for our club. You know it's that kind of reports that we are urging you to have the stations send us by virtue of the fact that they get such fine response from all of you.

For Sunday morning December 9 we find that CHAB 1200 kycs. Moose Jaw, Sask. will be the first Canadian on the air for us that morning. They will be on from 2:00 to 3:30 A.M., E.S.T. Mr. Huber gets our thanks for this dedication.

Following CHAB we find that CFCT 1450 kycs. Victoria, B. C. will transmit a DX program dedicated to the members of our club from 3:00 to 4:00 A.M., E.S.T. We also want to thank Mr. Huber for this broadcast.

At the same hour, 3:00 to 4:00 A.M., E.S.T. we shall also have the privilege of hearing another of the British Columbia stations on the air for the members of our club, this station will be CKWX located in Vancouver who operate on 1010 kycs. Mr. Huber gets our thanks for having arranged this broadcast.

CJAT 910 kycs. Trail, B. C. will also transmit a DX program for the members of our club on the same morning from 3:00 to 4:30 A.M., E.S.T. Please remember in connection with this station that they demand prompt and accurate reports before they will verify for you. Ray Lewis gets credit for having arranged this broadcast.

The next broadcast we want to particularly call your attention to for we have had a very interesting letter from the station regarding it. The station referred to is CJLS 1310 kycs. Yarmouth, Nova Scotia, who will transmit one of the most unique programs for the members of our club on Sunday morning, Dec. 9 that any of you have ever heard. They will take the air from 4:00 to 5:00 A.M., E.S.T. and they have informed us that this broadcast will take the form of an early morning breakfast party. From what we have already heard from the station in regards to this broadcast we feel sure that it will be a very novel broadcast. We want to thank Ray Lewis for having arranged this broadcast. The last station that has thus far signified it's intention of taking part in our Canadian Party is CRCK 1050 kycs. Quebec, Quebec who will take the air at 5:00 A.M., E.S.T. on Sunday morning and broadcast a program dedicated to the members of our club lasting for one hour. Thanks to Ray Lewis for having arranged this broadcast also.

We hope to have news on several additional Canadian stations by next week for you. However we certainly feel that it is entirely fitting and proper that we should hereby extend a hearty vote of thanks to Messrs. Lewis and Huber for the fine work they have accomplished.

Above all don't forget to send in your response to these Canadian stations that have so kindly offered to take part in our series of broadcasts. Even if you have some of them already verified, a card of thanks will be greatly appreciated by the stations. You can in this way do your part to boost your club along, for lots of reports means more dedication in the future. Let's keep the NRC up near the top by sending in your reports on these broadcasts.

We have just received a very splendid letter from Mr. Lester W. Zellmer, Ass't. Engineer of station W T R C, Elkhart, Ind. in which he informs us that it is with great pleasure that he adds our club to his DX Club period which is broadcast every night at 8:30 P.M., E.S.T. We certainly appreciate Mr. Zellmer's giving us this publicity outlet and we hope that our tips may be of some assistance to him in this DX period.

We regret to inform our members that we have just received word that both C.G. Huber and Ray Lewis are on the sick list. Ray we understand is headfast while C.G.H. has had some sort of an accident which we certainly hope is not of a serious nature. We certainly extend to both of these fine workers our sincerest wishes for a very speedy recovery.

Joe Becker, Sr. sends us word that he received a letter from CMBC Havana, Cuba telling him that their program on the 20th of this month was dedicated to the members of our club, however this letter was not received until after the broadcast, we regret that we were unable to notify you of this broadcast.

We want to thank Howard Schlobohm for having secured a frequency check dedication from KFPW 1210 kycs. Ft. Smith, Ark. for Saturday morning, December 1 from 3:10 to 3:30 A.M., E.S.T. for the members of our club.

We also want to thank John J. Barlow for having arranged for a frequency check dedication over station WBTM 1370 kycs. Danville, Va. on Monday morning, December 3 from 2:30 to 2:50 A.M., E.S.T. for the members of our club.

Joe Becker has also secured a frequency check dedication for the members of our club over station WMBR 1370 kycs. Jacksonville, Fla. for Thursday morning, December 6 from 3:00 to 3:20 A.M., E.S.T.

Charles Hesterman sends us the good news that CFQC 840 kycs. Saskatoon, Sask. will take part in our Canadian Nights programs on Tuesday morning, December 11 from 12:00 to 12:30 A.M., E.S.T. - WHBF, Rock Island, Ill. to increase day power to 250 watts.
- WHBY, Green Bay, Wisconsin to increase day power to 250 watts.
- WJBO, Baton Rouge, La. completion date extended from 12/1/34 to 2/1/35.
- KOL, Seattle, Wash. completion date extended to Dec. 25, 1934.
- WTAR, Norfolk, Va. to increase day power to 1000 watts.
- KVOA, Tucson, Ariz. to change hours of operation from specified to unlt'd
- KECA, Los Angeles, Calif. to increase day power to 5000 watts.
- KRKD, Los Angeles, Calif. to increase power to 2500 watts.
- KPRC, Houston, Texas to increase day power to 5000 watts.
