We hope you will all listen in to this fine special and send in your reports out of appreciation for this broadcast which this station has presented in honor of our club and the other two clubs. Thanks to you, Mr. Hesterman for the fine work!!!

Earl Roberts, our Indianapolis, Ind. member and also a member of our Courtesy Programs Committee, who has done such fine work with the Mexican specials for our club this season, sends us a newspaper clipping from one of his home town's papers. Quoting from the article we give you the following information. "The familiar identification announcement, "Your station is WKBG, Indianapolis" passed into history." "Effective now, the station's call letters are WIRE. It's wave length of 1400 kycs. remains unchanged." "According to D. E. Kendrick, General Manager of this station, the FCC authorized the change in call letters to end the confusion caused by similarity of call letters between stations WKBF and WFBI." "We welcome this change which will mean easier identification of the two Indianapolis stations", said Mr. Kendrick "WIRE, which has been affiliated with NBC since September, 1933, holds the unique position of being the only optional basic broadcasting both 'red' and 'blue' network programs." "Radio men say the new call letters, WIRE, are most appropriate, since "Plug" Kendrick, who took over WKBF in August 1933, and gave it a prominent position, has been known as one of the "live wires" of the industry for ten years."

This past Sunday morning found static on the rampage here at club headquarters and we were unable to hear many of the programs that were scheduled for Sunday morning, however we were pleased to hear WATR come in so well, for no doubt many of our members welcomed this opportunity to add this station to their logs.
