I have tested my New Howard receiver now for a week and although reception conditions were not very favorable I found this receiver to be very reliable. I hrd all 6 continents the first week. It really pulled the stations in and the band spread is very good on the crowded channels. My tests showed that despite the size and price of the Howard receiver it really can show up some of the higher price receivers. The receiver covers from 540-12.000 kc and dial is very easy to read. It also has a logging scale and made up of four bands. It has a separate band spread dial, and condenser, AVC on and off switch, standby switch and also a beat oscillator with pitch control for the CW DXers. Also supplied with a head-phone jack and has connection for an R meter. Antenna connection is made for either a doublet or single wire connections. I am completely satisfied with my new receiver and even expect better results when I get up my Taco Beam in the spring. 'Tnx Leo OM for the VFB info. I seen the Howard in operation at the Minneapolis Radio Club Meeting last week and I was highly impressed with its results. (Editor)
