CMBX is now using 1050 kc heard them on 26th from 11:30 to 12 Midnite signoff. Heard the following on Nov 27th WTSP at 2:05 on 1370 R9. WLTH at 2:10 on 1400 R9. WOKO at 2:15 on 1430 R9. WSPA at 2:10 on 920 on Nov. 28. WTSP at 2:15 on 1370. WCLS at 2:49 on 1310 R8. WFTL at 3:05 on 1370 R8. CFCH at 3:15 on 930 R9. WMRO at 3:45 on 1250 R5 all hrd on Nov. 28th.

DICK COOPER-Kittanning Penna. Not much doing the past week. Latest veries are letters from KWFT WPRO WMOB and typed cards from WMGA and WTSP. WTSP heard on 26th and several mornings thereafter. Again on the Radex question Ernie would like to warn DX'ers not to go by this list. He says that most of the stations aren't listed, and others are on the wrong frequencies. Those listed on 2770 are actually on 2662 by their own announcements.

To those of you have not tried this band. Come on, give it a try when BCB DX'ing has netted you all the stations that there are to find.
