CMZ and COX-7 (4.29mc) and COX-4 (6.39mc) are very anxious to receive reports from every town in US and promises verify all reports received. IMPORTANT:-- As you know unused stamps are better for reports than IRC, and cheaper too. We are in a position to change stamps with all members of the NRC, unused stamps from your country for the same quantity of unused Cuban stamps.-- We accept any denomination (Lower than locts) and any quantity. This may be useful for many of you. (Charles Ramirez G.--Santo Tomas 362, Cerro Havana Cuba.)
