CONTEST NEWS

This contest is purely a VIS affair and only one (1) verie from any one (1) state or province or any other way a country is divided will be accepted. Only veries from stations heard from October 1 1940 to May 31st . 1941 inclusive, will be counted. At end of contest winner must produce their verifications to the Judges. Jack piringer will be Contest Manager and all reports regarding this contest must be sent to him at 1451 Lincoln Ave., Lakewood Ohio. Points will count as follows; I one point will be allowed for each U.S. state and the distric of Columbia making a possibility of 49 points in this country. Two (2) points for any state province ect in Canada-Guba or Mexico. Three (3) points for any in Alaska-Puerto Rico-Newfoundland-St. Pierre or any state or province in the West Indies or Contral America. Four (4) points will be given for each state or province in South Amertica. Hawaii will also fall in this classification. Five (5) points will be given for each division of Asia-Oceania-Africa. and Europe.
