NEWS OF THE IDA-NRC 2ND ANNUAL CONVENTION AT CLEVELAND, OHIO, JANUARY 18
AND 19 SPONSORED BY CLEVELAND RADIO CLUB

Twenty-nine persons attended the convention. They were: -- From the Cleveland area: J.E.Gardner, Mrs.J.E.Gardner, Mrs.C.Carey, Francis Gmeiner, Miss Alice Pender, Jack Siringer, Miss Jean Kelley, Fred Herke Jr, Miss Jean Doing, Charles Wolfe Jr., William Hahn, Steve Mann, Miss Patricia Conrad, R.X. Breymaier, Paul Dixon, Miss Mary McFadden, Harold Burstrom, and Ralph Berger. Out-of-towners were George Cryder, Deleware, Ohio; Mr.&. Mrs. Walter Butts, Columbus, Ohio; Ray Edge and Tom Carberry from Buffalo, N.Y.; and from Chicago: Leo Herz, Gail Beyer, Eric Bristow, Ed Schenk, Tommy Grey, and Charlie Trezise.
