F C C News
A construction permit has been granted to the Butler Broadcasting Co.,
Butler Penn for a new station on 680 kcs with 250 watts power.
The F C C has denied the renewal of station WBAX in Wilkes Barre Penn.
They must be off the air by 3AM E.S.T. July 1 1941.

The F C C has also vacated the revocation of 5 Texas stations, they are KGKB-Tyler, KRBA-Lufkin, KSAM-Huntsville, KTBC-Austin, KNET-Palestine, and KGFI-Brownsville. KRBA-KSAM-KTBC-KNET & KGFI are licensed on a 90 day basis. Station KGKB is continued to operate but is warned that this is not to be construed as approving Dr. Ulmer's past activities.. WJZM Clarksville, Tenn, These call letters have just been assigned.

J. McDonough an operator at WARD write saying that after May 1 1941 WARD is leaving the air and will be known from then on as WBYN and will operate on 1430 kcs full time and will shortly receive an increase in power. So you fellows better get busy and get the others now on 1490kc.
