ERIE BRISTOW-CHICAGO ILL I will start on BCB DX soon now. I heard a station in Columbia saying this is for the N R C Radio Club and heard a little sigging but not enough to report. On Saturday the 18th I tried for YV5RI between 3&4. I heard a football game as I could hear him calling yards and other gains and losses and would like to know what station it could have been. (Sorry to say Erie but you passed up KGMB with that football game. A lot of the boys reported it) Hrd a station behind WEXL sigging off at 3 and others also, could it have been WEIM. (No WEIM went off at 2 AM EST but will again DX later)

DEAN LONDON-RINGLING OKLA KPOF tests every 4th Friday 4-4:30. XEAW now ann as Reynosa Tam. instead of Monterrey, N.L. and are on 1010 now as well as 1570 with separate programs on each freq, 10/17 KGNF hrd again so they must be on from 2-3 or 3:15, they signed off at 3:15 this Friday and at 2:57 last Fri. CKWX off about 4 min after KPWB signed at 2:58. Ann was blurred by shrill whistle from what sounded like WHAL on an equipt test. Who was on 1290 at 3:17 R8? HJAR R4 on peaks here, interference from unknown sta. 10/18 WMBI on 1-2 with reg weekly test. KMED for a prized one who were R5 broadcasting the Medford-Klamath Falls football game till 1:43. Another new one in XEFW who have recently increased their power. 10/19 WWDC seems to be 24 hrs early, hrd R5 under WNOE at 5:05; (No they came on for us on the 20th) After KGMB signed JOAK-1 R3-4 easily copied, 2 on 1490 before 6:30; WJBK R5-8 the other R1-4; some foreign station playing Rancho Grande at 6:38 on 730; At 6:40 on 920 R2-3 probably HJCS 50kw Bogota; WGES on in clear at 7 for a new one; Hearing WGES prevented me from identifying the Mex on 1350; TP's audible on 570-650-670. HJAR gave us a swell DX and they were R-6 almost completely in the clear but some was testing with whistles. HJAR signed at 3:31 instead of 4. WWDC put on swell program even 5 min of news. WKWK hrd same am with freq ck 4:55 to 5:15. WJLB seems to come on at 5:15 instead of 5. Am I crazy or did I hear 2 XEAW's at same time with different programs after 5 on 10/20? DICK COOPER-KITTANNING PENN Veries in from KEUB-WAIT, cards and letters from KFEB-WFAS-KWJB-KORN-WEIM and WADC. The program from WADC was received in 3 days, the verie I mean, the program was 100% and I think you'll all agreed it was a dandy. Did you hear Marvin Cooper, the engineer at WADC greet all us Coopers Hi. KDTH put on an equally as fine show and dedicated selections to officers, directors and CPC men. KSKY signs on at 6 AM EST and is an easy mark. WBBB have hill-billy program starting at 6:30 AM and can be heard thru WMMN here, but have not yet verified.
