JOE BRAUNER-WMSVILLE N Y DX has been slow here, oversleeping and listening at the wrong times I guess; Missed HJAR & WEIM by too much sleeping no sign of YV5RI on their specials, but YV5RY came in 4 4 R 7 on the 29. YV4RA Q3 R5 most of time, no sign of HJAI or PRE9 here. Other club specials all hrd with good signals and reported except WKWK. The WJMA and WWDC specials were really tops in any way you consider them. New stations, WMRP-4AM-9/24; reg check: WWSR 6AM 9/27 signing on: KTNM testing 10/3: WOCB on club special hrd well during final 15 min, too much WEDC eariler. WJMA-YV4RA-WWDC & CFOS on specials and WAIT logged with fairly good signal on Sunday mornings as late as 9:30. CFOS Q5 R8 on special. Veries, letters, WWDC-WOCB-KTNM-WING-WWSR-WMRP & WERC. Cards KHMO-KROS-WISR. WISR shows remarkable signals here, as strong as WPIC and much better than WKST and WHJB. Average midday strength Q5 R6. WERC is also an easy catch on Sundays until 9AM when WBTA comes on. WWNY is a local here around 7 AM on weekdays. Often with interesting news from the Army camp near Watertown. Have written to 7 stations on CPC, only one reply so far.
