GRANT BATSON-WESTFIELD N.Y. I missed one week in reporting but got a few reports out. 12/16 WSON test behind CFRB's carrier Q4 R7; Whats the matter Pop on KFNF? I logged them 3-3:28 Q4 R6-9. (Didnt get home until 3:40 AM that morning Grant-Ray) Also on 12/19 KQW on 740 kc 3:40-4 AM Q3 R6; 12/26 KILO on 1440 kc testing 3:12-3:30 Q4 R9; 12/20 WCED 4:48-5 PM on 1230 Q3-4 R7; Verie states a daily DX program 2:30-3 PM on Monday thru Friday; 12/27 WINX on 1340 kc 24 hour station. 12/27 WJHO testing on 1400 kc 4:33-5 AM and requesting reports. Veries received, cards from KFNF-WCED-WISR for NRC special-HP5H 9 months and letters from WSON and WHLN. CKTB being on 1550 kc gives me a chance for some daytime reports on 1230 kcs; WAJR good in AM and WCED in the PM. Carriers left on after programs end are on 790 kc WTAR-1380 kc WMBG and on 1140 kc WRVA with clock ticking.
