Thats one reason why some verifications are slow in coming also And with the war on, it is difficult to plan for the future. We plan to contact more stations for programs and hope to arrange at least a few more programs for the remainder of the season. Two dandies to look forward to are CKVD and WKNY arranged by Ernie Cooper and we have word that station CMKM through Joseph Sierra VOLUNTEERING to put on a show. So despite handicaps we may get a few new ones. A lete bit of swell news comes from Frank Lee who has just been informed by station FQN that they will DX for the N R C on January 27 1942. Our hats off to Frank.

FQN St Pierre, Miquelon Frank Lee has lined up this much publicized station for a special DX program to be dedicated to NRC on Tuesday Morn ing January 27th from 4 to 6 AM EST. Their reply was by Western Union and reads, "Program will be arranged at date and time requested. Out frequency on 588 kilocycles. Will inform in due time of any alteration" It is signed "Administrateur" and was headed "Free French Government". Need less to urge you fellows to listen in, we all will try for this station. Previous DX programs have been received well towards the midwestern USA and if good conditions prevail, you western boys should hear this station It might be a good idea to tune up and down the band in case of a shift in frequency. CKVD Val D'or Quebec will repeat a previous DX program on February 17th from 3 to 4 AM EST for the National Radio Club. They will be on March 3rd at same hour should anything such as an all-nighter situation arise. Program arranged by Ernie Cooper

WKNY Kingston N.Y., is needed by a majority of our members. They will DX for the National Radio Club on February 21st from 3 to 4 AM EST and the alternate date is March 7th. This is a corker of a DX so lets all be on hand and flood Marvin Seimes, WKNY's chief engineer with reports. WKNY has agreed to use band music, this will help overcoming other signals if necessary. So this will explain why the program was all in Spanish this time, not both languages as on Dec 6th. Well received on 4855 kc. WGN too much for HJCU on 720 kcs here tonight. Please send HJCU report to show appreciation for these good-will programs.

KROW-960 with swell organ program 2:39-3 AM. YV6RE battled so hard with KNJJ I couldn't get anything, could tell that Spanish was spoken but no dope on music, sent tnx letter. This was all I gleaned from the DX calendar of Jan 10th. Verie from WINK and followed by a nice magazine of station and staff. Card verie from WKAR signed U.E. Grovo. Letter veries from KNET and WNYC signed M.S. Novic, director. If any one need WNYC, they are in the clear on 830 kc on Sunday AM at 7. ??? at 5:30 AM Sunday. Who is the Spick in the clear? XEAD? Most of the other split freq mystery stations will probably turn out to be Mexicans also, the one on 1315 sounds like a Mex. I hope TA reception is as good after we clean up the mess the World seems to have gotten in as it was a few days ago. I really would like to have some TA veries. Lyons on 648 was R4-5 at 12:51 on 1/8. That morning Hilversum on 995 nearly knocked the cans off my ears from 12:59-1:20. They were R9 exactly the same as KJR. Lille on 1213 was Q5 R6 at 1:23 and Hilversum on 722 was R4-5 at 1:40. Other carriers hrd on the 8th were on 601-658-1040-731-1222. 1/11 Radio Lyons on 1393 was R4 with Church services at 1:30 and on 18th Berlin on 841 was R6-8 from 1:05-1:17. Other carriers were hrd on 832-1040-1077-1095-1204-1213-1222. Yes and a station on 1384 was R4 at 1:30 and still hrd at 1:47. I bet many you eastern fellows cussed WGR for interfering with KOAC. They had a nice program and came in here Q4 R7. I used a directional antenna and cut WGR out. (Yes Eldon now they shut off WGR all night and are using WKBW again) New call letters for the Iowa station is KICD and they have their antenna already 150 ft vertical. KVCV has a clear channel almost every tuesday when WITH is silent. They broadcast 24 hours daily and have been since Dec 15th. Veries from WHAM-WLAC-KTNM-KVFD. (Came Thur AM)

Evening DX, all well hrd TIX-605 TIPG-625; HOK-640; TIBAS-655; HJCU-720; LR5-830; OAX4A-854; HJCC-870; HJCS-920; HJ CZ-1040; HJCO-1160; HJAN-1190; HJCR-1200. All these have been hrd, yet no night yet has been very good for latins. VONF is a snap every evening. VOCM on 1005 has been hrd poorly around 6:30. KSL R9 on meter (which is skimpy) at 7:30 when WJJD signs. KOA R7 at 7 when WROL signs. CBK loggable as early as 5:30. Daytime DX between 1:30 and 3pm the following have been hrd, none under R5; WOSU-WHO-WBT-WTAM-WWL-WENR-WMAQ-WHAS-CBY-CHML-WJR-WRVA. Short wave reception is stupendous too.
