FRANK ILL-WILDWOOD N J A very interesting article by Dave Thomas on the Beverage waves. Thanks to him. How about those WJMA varies Dick? Only report out is CKVD on for club, a fine program, lots of interference from WJBW-WHBC and WITH. CKVD were on until 5:25am. 2/10 Tuned in Tripoli on 1104 kcs, my first catch in Africa. Announcer gave news reports from all over the world at 1:30 AM EST. They put in an R5 signal. TA reception is still coming in but signal strength on most of them has fallen off. Some cannot be heard. One correction in list last week, station listed on 533 kc as Germany was in Grenoble France, this is occupied by Germany. The list as appeared in the bulletin can be depended upon as I have re-checked over and over again. The above correction excepted. See Bob Brown is getting his share of TAs also, not to try and outdo Bob, but one eve I logged 42 TAs. Hrd all Bob listed and others. I use a 23 tube Scott the same as Bob's and it sure brings them in. Have been assigned as an Air Raid warden in our town and then also took up bowling for 1st time. Been bowling 3 months and high score is 247 (Page Herz) Guess I was lucky as my average to date is about 148. (Good going anyway Frank-Ray) To Dick Cooper. Will answer your letter shortly-Frank.

ED WYMAN-HORWELL N.Y. Dxing hasnt been so hot here lately so havent hrd many new ones. Reports sent to KGLD R9 on 2/3, also same date to WSBT teston 960; 2/4 KAO on reg sked. 2/6 reception so poor I couldnt get Chicago so got LAA and reported WGR; 2/7 WIP on reg sked; 2/11 WTAW freq check; 2/12 KFJZ reg sked & KGCU on freq check; 2/13 WHDH test on 850 and WKBB freq ck; Varies in from KOA-WJPR-WGR-KGLD. Bob Maguire I see is wondering how KOB is getting out, sometimes they are covering WJZ at 6PM here, have a varie from them for a report copied thru WJZ. Nothing doing here on YSS-KOH-KAYK, also hrd WKBV on freq ck but not enuf to report. Your sta s/off on 1340-2/13-1340 is WDMJ; on 2/16-1340 is WJPF.

Latest veries are dandy cards from WJDX & KFJR (out 3 mos) - WNEL-WIBC and letters from WOSH-CHAB-WRR-WTJS. WOSH would like listeners to drop them a card on daytime reception especially, and have reports from 7 states so far, and on March 14th from 2-2:30 to 3 EWT will again test. Note this all who need them; WTJS says they are out of verie cards. I sent reports out to HI9B-CXAS-YNDG-ZPA2-WJAG-KSLM-KGER-LTBS-KWKH-WJHP. I couldnt hear XEFC at all but did hear a few TPs and could have copied reports if the sub-station here would have been quiet. 1YA was good and 3BZ also on 1430. Carriers were audible all over the band and I wish I would have had a bigger radio.

LEN KRUSE-DUBOQUE IA. Another week going by without much DXing done. Weather conditions were not too favorable. 2/12 Hrd WSPB with test 3:05 AM EWT CRMed by WNOE, new station in log. Nothing hrd from XEFC's special for club, as WEXL poured in with R9 signal. WIOD can be hrd behind WIP all night; Finally sent report to KHQ. Is WHAL on air yet? They had construction permit for a year, no one reported on same. Gilbert Andrew c.e. of KR08 informed me of monthly freq ck on last Friday 2:30-3am EWT and will verify all correct reports. AL BARTHOLOMEW-BRADFORD N.Y. Not much new DX of late, hrd HJ CZ in early evening and CKVD on with special for the club last Tuesday morning. CKVD hrd here 4.20-5AM, interfered with somewhat by WJEW until 4:40 then WHBC came on with test and about snowed them under. CKVD only used 100 watts, gave the Club a nice hand and all announcements in English, quite remarkable for a French Canadian station. Played an American recorded program mostly. Cuts my active Canadians unverified down to 7. Thanks a lot for this program special, Lefty. Only veries in from KPOW and KEVR, both nice letter head veries, week before last and last week a very attractive letter verie from KMYR who also enclosed their dandy card verie in Red-White and Blue. Thus far no veries back this week. Still have 18 reports out, mostly delinquent. One Aussie and one Zedder. Sincerely hope our Friends Down-Under are not invaded by the Japs. The 12th of Feb brought to a close my tenth year of DX and veries at 1279. 232 of them are 2000 miles or more distant. Have 105 foreign BCB veries, 51 Mexicans 36 Cubans and 105 Canadians with one out and one deleted long ago that I never wrote to-CNRO. Should easily reach the 1300 mark by end of this season if I can get ambition enuf to arise to DX. Since I began verifying ten years ago only three active stations in USA remain unverified & unheard that have been on for that period, KVOB-KBPS and KCFX. Did hear the last one but no verie. In Canada only CKMC and CHWK are unverified that have been active 10 years or more. I gave up a long time ago in trying to completely verify the USA. At end of one season I did manage to cut my active USA stations needed down to an even seven. (Now the count is around sixty) Most of the ~~states~~ states have been completely verified at some time or other with the exception of Calif-Wash-Oregon and S Dakota. Think I completed Texas at least 4 times and Arizona 3. Now need 3 stations in Arizona Hi. California will be completed at last if only KPRO-KVCV and KFRE will only send me veries soon. All are becoming delinquent. A DXer must have plenty of patience. Many of my catches took years to finally snag them, for instance KOAC. I recently sent post cards to several stations and here are some of their replies, KEVE tests after MDT PST indefinite but are on daily until 2 AM EWT and on Sunday morning until 3 AM EWT and on Monday morning until 1 AM EWT. KWKW expect action from FCC in about 3 weeks. They will use 1430 kcs. KIL0 have no reg test period but test once a month, on daily till 1 AM EWT. Also wrote KFFA-KVOB-KFBC but havent replied as yet. Some signers are KRJF-Royal E Nelson ce KWKW-Marshall S Neal KWRC by KIL0-H Kees. c.e. WKRO-Merrill C Currier, Mgr. Paul E Waldon c.e. (To Al- The others with specified times will be listed in DX Calander when they are about to come on so the members will remember and listen)
