AL BARTHOLOMEW-BRADFORD N Y New DX since last report, KFFA & 2nd report to KEYR on 19th and WKNY on Club special. Caught WmYA on test and WIAC who is good in evening. Only veries from WBYN-CKVD-WKNY and KFFA. Very prompt, sent full page letter verie telling about their set up, location etc. Signed by Ray Cummins who stated Jewell warren was c.e. Not some members have trouble getting a verie from them. Another verie from KFRE, nice letter. I hrd them on eqipt test. Thanked me for splendid report and stated "Outside of a man in Edmonton Alberta you have no rival to date. You are the farthest two to receive KFRE, signed Sheldon Anderson c.e. Huzza another scoop, being 1st in East to hear KFRE. KRJF tests on 1st and 3rd Tuesday from 3-4 EWT. KFFA on 3rd Thursday or 19th at 3:45-4 AM EWT. And KFUN informs me they test 4th Saturday or Mar 28th from 3:15-3:30 EWT. A.F. Schultz is c.e. Began reg sked Xmas day 1941.

JOE BECKER-HAMILTON O. WASK hrd this am 3/6 also WGBG on 3/5 who is in the clear at 5:58 with National Anthem. XERH and XEK also hrd. No sign of CFOS or WMIS. (CFOS not on Joe but WmIS was) Veries from WKRO-XEG. WKRO by Eugene Bulbis c.e. W9NGU. (Yes Joe the signer of XEG) I suggested to WOSH to play band music on their test.

CARROLL SETH-WELLSVILLE N Y QSL from KPJM in 3 months. Thats all, no reports, nothing of interest heard here. Sorry to hear RADEX is in trouble. A lot of us DXers learned the finer points of the game in that magazine. I see heavy sunspot activity is with us again. Wonder how the SA reception stands up under it. Bet it's better than usual. The way we're losing some of our better DXers to the Armed forces maybe the convention this summer can be held abroad. (See Verse on front page) Well Carroll we havent lost many yet but what the summer & fall will bring no one can tell. All we can hope is for the best-Ray.

FRED BORCHERT-MILWAUKEE WISC. A short turn across the band and we have latest QSLs from WKNY on special-KwJJ-WJMA-WCOU-WOLS-CKVD. The replies from WJMA and WCOU were on prepared QSL cards and I sure was glad to finally get WJMA's card which was from there Oct 6 1941 special. (How did you get that WJMA verie? No one else is that good-Ray) After listening for WKNY for 56 minutes I finally hrd station identification and logged the name of the last number on the program/ I've sent 3 reports to CHAB but still no reply, WHY? Latest reports to XEAW on both freq-XEJ follow up report-WTIC-WITH. The bulletins seem to get bigger and better every issue, thanks to Ray-Fred and the other officers and members while other clubs are folding up we are going up so lets always keep the N R C flying. CON BARNES-ST ONGE S DAKOTA. No DX to report at all this week, and only one verie, WKRO by Eugene Bullis. For those DXers who are having a hard time with some stations, I would suggest follow up reports, rather than reports of a second reception. The logic in this is likely that after each test, when a great many DXers report, it is quite likely that the batch of reports will be put aside to be answered if and when time is available; but if a time is picked when such congestion is unlikely, your follow up will have a better chance of being taken care of. I have tried both methods over a period of ten years, and find the follow up to be at least 75% better than repeated reports. WKRO is an example of this, and I could name many more. (I'll second your idea-Ray)

JIM WEDEMER-DYERSVILLE IA. Not much DX here lately due to sickness and noise; Latest QSLs CKFX-YNZFT on 3w-KBWD, also same letter from WKNY. I recommended the ARRL for info. J WARREN ROUTZAHN-YORK PA. Since last report I logged WKNY-WKRO-WHOP. received veries from CBY-WFCI-WKNY-CKVD. Summing up totals, my log stands at 1338 stations heard and 797 verified. This log started fall of 1933 I did not start to verify until fall of 1936 and then only half hearted ly for two seasons before waking up and going after veries, but too late then to make up all the ones lost forever; 2/19 KFJZ-R8 at 3am; KLS-R6 at 3:05, unidentified in Calif, s/o at 3:10 with interference from one testing; KGLO-R9 at 3:20; 2/21 WINX-R8 at 2:55; WKNY-R8 on DX program interference from WWSW-WJBK & WKRO. After about 3:25 WKNY opened up and over rode others on 1490. WKRO was not well enough to get veri material 2/26 Nothing but all-nighters; 2/27 Tried for KPOF but couldnt hear them think KLX was there; KFXJ-R8 at 3:15; WHOP-R9 at 3:30 to 4 and announced as reg freq test, probably each last Friday; 2/28 WTSP-R9 at 3:55; WMBG R7 at 4:05 test; WJHO-R7 at 4:45 and a west coast station gave correct time at 5:00 but no call letters on 740. (KQW) 3/1 KLO-R6 at 3:12 and just before daybreak weak signals from 1YA-4QN-5CK up to 7 am. KSKY on at 7:15 and clear until after 7:30 this each Sunday morning.

BOB BOTZUM-READING PA. DX has been rather good lately. Veries received since last report are WNAB-WGGA-KWBW-WLDS-KBUR-WMIS-KFUN-WSON-KTBI-KEVE-WBBB-WMRF-KSKY-KBWD-WOSH-WFIN-WRRN-WASK-CJVI-CKVD-XEF-TI4NRH-HJCU-HJDK for a grand total of 1309 veries. CKVD made no 101 from Canada. Recent new ones hrd WIAC (good most every evening) KGBS-WGBG-WRRF-WDBC. Incident ly WGBG failed to answer 3 reports since Feb 16th; WASK verified in 3½ days signed by Joe Spring (eng); also WKRO answered promptly by card, but darn the luck only mentioned time on air and their freq sked, but no mention of verie, or my report. (Eugene Ballis eng) KFUN tests 4th Sat 3:15-3:30 AM EWT. Long overdue are HJAR-HJCS-YV3RA-KTOH-CMAC-CMJL-KFKA-KPRO-YV6RE should also be in. Was pleased to see the attractive display of Evangelista's fine veries. Of course NRC was advertizes & Nick was kept busy explaining those veries were received on the BCB only. Just received letter from CKWS-960 kcs They will come on the air April 1st (evening) with a directional antenna to keep the signal away from Roanoke Va and other WS stations on 960 kcs according to Arthur L Davies, general manager. HAROLD AUCHSTETTER-MENLOTA ILL. Havent been going so much DXing lately. Did not wake up for CKVD, tried for CFOB but not hrd. (Not on) 2/23 WINN logged for 1st time, new one and WEDC went off for them, other new ones since last report are CHNC hrd 2/19 at 8PM EWT and CFCF-8:30PM and WAGE KSKY-WHCU-KSWO-WSAV-WHUB-WKMO-KEVE-KDRO-KEYS-WOLF; (Yes Harold those you listed test but different than listed in RADEX. A new list received from Man Nostrand will be published in the Mar 21st bulletin so all members will have it for the 1st WED-THUR-FRI of April) 2/25 hrd WJRD 2:30-2:45 CWT; WBOC test. (Look in questions and answers for other dope)

NORM MAGUIRE-ALBUQUERQUE N MEX. Veries in from WmBR-KFJM-WGBF-KFKA-KANS WINX with wonderful pamphlet showing entire station, same from KEVE on their station. Received verie from KINY after they refused to verify my first report due to incorrect selection. Am happy to have them now, since I have verified all states and territories now. Rec KADA to bring Okla up to one missing. KFRE is on until about 4 AM EWT on 1340 Kcs; KVOE on 1490 until 2:30 EWT. Be on the llokout for Mexico City stations on in the early morning hours. A large number of them have been transmitting during this period. Signer for WMEX is Wm M Smith, c.e. I finally logged ~~KARX~~ WTAD last week after trying for about 7 years.
