KXEL-WATERLOO IOWA. The following is a letter received from Mr. L.D. Barnhart, program director. "As you know we ran the first of what we expected to be a series of DX tip programs last Friday night 12MDT-12:15 AM our time. In going over this matter carefully with our station manager since that first broadcast, I find that he feels the purpose served by the program does not warrant the extending of our broadcast time under present conditions which involve a rigid curtailment of broadcast hours in order to conserve tubes and equipment. Mr DuMond feels also that the audience served by the information included in the program is not large enough to warrant a program outside of our regularly scheduled time. We are, therefore going to discontinue this particular format and substitute for it a program 11:45-12 MDT which can be used by DXers for a check on our coverage. I am exceedingly sorry to have to give you this information since I realize your keen interest in the idea. Mr. L.D. Barnhart.

Your Editor is sorry to have to relate this information to you members but we must all realize that KXEL is a 50,000 watts station and all their staff had to remain on duty later than usual. In this time when all the stations must conserve materials I know that all of you will bear with station KXEL. I am sure that all of you really appreciated that first DX-TIP program which was a real honey. How ever something at the new time will be on hand. It might be suggested that KXEL take out a few minutes and just broadcast the tips for the coming week during 11:45-12MDT.

I have been very busy and working hours have been so I have had no time to DX except early evenings.
