LLOYD STAPLES-MIAMI FLA After a month from DXing I hope to get back into the swing as my S-20-R is on the way down here from Mass. Reception here is pretty good as the old home town stations come in good although the Cubans pretty well cover the band. Expect to be able to hear WGIL's DX special for the club on Jan 22. I will try to have all the info on WPDY by next issue. Hope my chance of winning the contest arnt lost-Hi. We go to P.A.A.s school here 8 hours a day but will be flying soon as a flight radio operator. (Bob hope those cards I sent you were OK) Say Llody are you in the Army? Give us the dope-kay.

JIM SHUPE-DAYTON OHIO Guess what XEAW did? I sent them a report of over 30 minutes of broadcasting and they came back with a card in 4 days. It was my 5th try. XEG is on 1050 kcs and is coming in very strong after 7:30PM and is Q5 R9, their QRA is San Antonio, Texas. My log shows 117 heard and 63 verified. Havent DXed for the past 2 weeks because of a snow storm taking down my sky wire. I also blew a 45 tube by hooking up a phono attachment wrong. XEAW's QRA is International Radio, Dallas, Texas. WWVA just upped its power to 50KW and asking for reports.

MARSHALL BLANCHARD-BROOKFIELD ILL I saw your card to Bob mentioning the fact that you had heard several good stations recently, KROY especially. Sure hope they answer you soon. Does WJR have a quiet morning? (Only from 5-5:30 AM each day) Been wanting to hear KGU for a long time. Veries in the past 3 weeks have been from WINN-KOIN-WISN-WBAA-K&W-KFRO-WJEJ-KDTH-KGMB-CKNX and WNAC. Several of these arent eligible for the contest. I have reports out to KFSD-CKAC-CBJ-CMCW-XEWO-XEBOY-XECZ-XEPW-CJOC-KATE-KYA KWLK. I have notes on LRL and OAX4A that I think I will send and hope they get thru as they would make 2 more multipliers. KFRO sent a KFRO-gram. 1/6 CMCW hrd on 1060 at 9:10 with a program of Argentine music. They announced after each selection. LRL and OAX4A were very good. A Cuban that sounded like CMK was hrd on 830. 1/8 KWJB-Globe Ari at 3:55-4:10 and I believe this is regular. WHEC 4:15-4:30 and KATE at 4:35-4:50 AM both regular. 1/9 KOCA 4:55-5:10 regular; 1/12 KELD 4:15-4:30; KGKL at 4:30-4:45; KTOK 4:45-5:00; 1/14 woke up at 2AM. There was a opick on 1025 that can be heard any nite or morning announces as XE--? but also mentions Cadena-Roja? Hrd KWLK about R6 while trying for Lyons France. CKNX sends an attractive card printed in Blue-hed. I sent TIPG a report written in Spanish. I wonder how they'll take on that.

GEORGE LUTHER-KERRVILLE TEX I am using a Delco 6 tube receiver and I do not verify often, but nearly log for my personal satisfaction and an elaborate set of statistics I carry regarding it. Such veries as I have, I have received in response to report requests by stations on tests and special programs, my only one asked for and received this year being from KICD and it was the first report they had from the great state of Texas. The one I prize the most is from 4YA. According to my rules (every DXer having his own) I do not log a station unless I hear his call unmistakably, regardless of how much of the program I may have heard. I have heard quite a number of stations, thus from which I could have had veries, which I have never logged because I didnt get the call. Of course I also have some good calls on which I could not have gotten veries. The only exception I have made is on 4 Japanese stations and then I logged them because I could hear them plainly and consistently for at least 15 minutes at one time and could easily have understood the program complete if it had been understandable to me. I also carry a special frequency change record consisting of stations I have in my log but have not heard on their present operating freq and I go after them about the same as I do an entirely new one. So out of my 870 logged stations 78 of them I am gunning for again. The majority of these, of course were the result of the general change of March 29 1940.

CHARLES E LIPPINCOTT-BALTIMORE MD Back in Philadelphia I had a log of better than 300 stations hrd and about 50 verified. Since moving here to Catonsville I have decided to start all over because of the new location. The receiver is a 1936 Silver-Marshall Model 58, its almost the exact duplicate of the Hallicrafters Sky Champion of the same year as far as the radio features are concerned. The sky hook is an inverted "L" strung up in the attic. Since starting the new log back in October I have hrd 74 stations on the BCB. So far all of my DXing has been done during the day or during the early evening hours, therefor the stations 74 of them come very nearly being the ones on the dial at any given time. The best ones hrd so far are KXEL-KOMA-WRDW-WSAN-WBCM-WHIS-WSPD-WPRA, spick on 980 kcs which announced COCO but understood this is a short wave outlet, can any one help me on this? (According to VRC its CMCK in Havana) WAAT-CBM-WNL-WGST-WHDH-WSBA-CKLW-CKAC-WAGE, that about completes the list of the ones not gotten too easily at this QRA. Since the sad demise of RADEX I have been looking and looking for some publication to take its place and at last I have found something that will do in a pinch. Its called White's Radio Log published quarterly and costs only 15¢ an issue and contains lists of bcb stations in US-Canada-Mexico-Cuba as well as Police & SW stations. As I have been out of touch with DXing until lately I dont know whether this publication is an old one and familiar to DXers or not. My immediate reaction was that if enough DXers wrote to the publisher with ideas for improving it that we might be able to mould it into a magazine like the old DXers Bible, RADEX. Is it familiar to you and what do you DXers think of the idea. The address is C Dewitt Co-Publishers-PO Box 142-Bronxville, N.Y. (It is worth trying so what say fellows?)

Dont know where WOL was as I couldnt get them after 3AM. Incidentally CBA verie was for daytime reception and CBC network and BBC programs, CBL wasnt on the hook-up.
