When I couldnt pick them up I thought they had either failed to come on or my letter had not reached them in time. However on Friday the 19th I received the letter which follows;- Dear Mr. Geary; We will be very glad to broadcast one special Good Will Program on Monday morning March 15th 1943 from 1 to 2 AM Mexican Central Time (12 to 1AM Pacific Coast Time, night between Sunday and Monday) as stated in your letter February 10 1943. Already have arranged to have the program broadcast from a night club in Los Mochis. There is going to be a dance and vaudeville. The American Colony in Los Mochis is fully cooperating with us so the program will be half English and half Spanish. According to your wishes the program will be dedicated to The National Radio Club and to you. We have been very busy as we bought another station in Culiacan State capital about 100 miles from Los Mochis and just finished up the instalation of another one in the City of Obregon about 135 miles North of Los Mochis. This is the reason I did not answer your letter before. Hoping that our program will be broadcast under good conditions and wishing to hear from you after the 15th we remain, Yours truly R Perez XECF.

This cold snap to-day should bring in a few more good ones to just about wind up a very successful DX season. Also I cant understand why XECF couldnt be heard if they were on as they covered KFAC easily when I heard them. I am writing them again to get the dope. I'M looking over my old logs back to 1925 and compiling an all-time list of stations heard with full information on those deleted so maybe some day I'll come up with some reminiscences.
