None of the prizes are high but there are enough of them and so it should create plenty of interest. So come on your BCB DXers who have entered the contest and to those new members who are still eligible. It wont take much to get into the top seven, lets see how many of them can be knocked down a couple notches. Dick Cooper started off with a bang and now we have Norm Maguire leading and pushing Dick to 2nd place, then Frank Wheeler and Joe Lippincott kicked your Editor down a couple notches, come on lots of fun.

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NEWTON MC LEOD-DIXFIELD, ME I am only a beginner in the BCB DX and have logged about 260 stations in 37 states and 8 foreign countries. I use a 1940 Silvertone # 721 with 12 tubes and a 60 foot doublet strung NW-SE. I am bothered by the mountains around here but this last weeks the QRN has been the stumbling block. A terrific buzzing since Sunday has prevented me from hearing a 5KW (WCSH) in Portland-85 miles away. It seems to be worse in the daytime-easing up some by MDT and conditions are fair in the early morning. It is similar to Northern Lights but I never knew them to carry on for so long. I tried for KPOW and WASK but got exactly nothing. The 24th I couldnt even get WITH and the 25th I couldnt get to the 5KW signals in Ohio-Indiana. I hope it clears up soon as I'd like a shot at some of those DX Broadcasts. I like especially the list of Freq Frolics and checks and the DX Calendar as I have logged about all the regular broadcasts that could be heard here.

FRED VAN VOORHEES-WHITESTONE N.Y. Not so much to report this week. Veries in from CHPS-WENY-KCCU-WHIT-WBBR. Reports out to WOOD-WEED-KICD-WHUB-WASK-WSUN. No sign of CJRL here. Were they on? (Yes Fred) No KPOW here either but that might have been the location. 11/22 WOOD logged on test 3:30-3:50 with music, then just a carrier till 4:30; 11/23 KICD on reg test; WBIR the same and ditto for WEED. KLRA hrd s-off at 3:04AM. 11/25 WASK with all night DX. Swell program but not good here. Poor sig with good bit of WNOE behind it when I listened at 2:30-3:15; Plenty of NRC publicity. WIBU on reg test at 3:35 and WHUB testing 3:30-4AM. Also finally logged WSUN on reg program. By the way I found a WJZ harmonic on 1540 the other morning. Disgusting isnt it?

GENE ALLEN-BERKELEY CALIF Had a very good luck Sunday AM and tuned in WEGO-heard them for 15 minutes till 1:30AM PWT. I sent them a report and am inquiring as to their power (1KW I believe) signal was R-6 here. Was a signal on 1220 kc this AM 11/22 but I do not believe it was CJRL altho I heard the number "Stardust" at 3:46 AM. Only other DX hrd here has been a Jap on 1000 kcs and LYA on 650 kcs and 2YA on 720 kcs. The New Zealand stations are consistent most any morning after 5 AM EWT.

JOE BRAUNER-WILLIAMSVILLE N.Y. Logged a couple new ones, thanks to the bulletin and the CPC, they are WEGO-CJRL-CMKV and CMJN, did not report to last 2. As expected WEGO came in first rate all the way, clearer then the locals usually are on reg programs. CJRL was so-so here, sometimes 100% readable, sometime 100% behind the noise level, fading badly at times, best at start and close of program. Both had nice program, specially WEGO. Mr. Nelson is an old hand at this and operated stations in the days when DXers were much more important to broadcasters then they are today. Missed out on KWRC by sleeping too soundly, wanted to hear them again (you didnt miss anything Joe as the noise was too much-Ray) as I never heard him in the clear before. WASK was hrd much of the time between 3 and 5:30AM, came in swell, no sign of WNOE or other QRM here at that time. Also sent reports to 3 who did not verify last season, WPDQ who bests WXYZ here sometimes, WSAP on freq check and WING hrd last Sunday at 8:30AM. WSAP has already verified by nice letter, error in address caused my March verie to be returned to them, now I have that original letter and envelope, with its P.O. rubber stamps, and a PS from the C.E.. Three receptions verified on one letter. Another verie is a letter from WENY. For LEFTY COOPER-KPFA still tests at that time, hrd 3 call announcements here around 3:40-3:45 but it would be hard to verify them thru the QRM. KPOW no go here, not a sign, must have been poor DX for they have been R-6 here on some tests, on same date hrd WBIR test at 5AM, first time over hrd them in the clear, very good here.

CHRISTMAS is very close and it would be swell if all of us would send a XMAS GREETING to our Members who are in our Armed Services. Do it NOW.

The past weeks activities at DX has been to the tune of 10 reports sent, 11/25 WASK on NRC special 3-3:30AM, too sleepy to get more, (Yea but not too sleepy to miss KWRC) also WHUB test 3:32-4AM; CJBC from 8:30-8:47PM; 11/26 CBK 7:15-7:45PM the earliest that I have ever logged them; 11/27 WJHO test 4:35-5; WWSR at 7:01-7:27 for daytime report; 11/28 WTBO from 10:30-10:45 AM for another daytime report, also CBA-2:29-3:10PM believe it or not; 11/29 KWRC for NRC special 3-4:15 static rather bad but hrd them Q-3-4 & R4-7, also KGO 4:30-5AM. Veries rec are cards from KHJ-CBJ and letters from CJKL a real honey of a verie from one of the announcers and my best one yet-KANS in 4 days-KLX-KWAL Yum-Yum. Hrd KROY s-off just before KWRC came on and I need this one. (Yes Grant I also hrd KROY s-off but from then on it was just NOISE-Ray) KHJ is silent Monday AM from 3AM EST on, the only time they are still during the week. JIM SHUPE-WING verified promptly for me, as for distance I verified WERC only 30 miles and by return mail had their CSL. Not a sign of KPOW on their DX, so sent tnx card. 11/29 ZNS pounded in here R9 at 7PM, plenty good for a report. I dont believe anyone has gotten a verie from XEW. Veries in from WJBO 3rd-WLOK 3 1/2 days-11/23 Hrd WEED test 3:25-3:40; 11/24 No go on KPOW-not a peep, only our dead friend WITH; 11/25 Caught WLOK and WSAP on s-offs, and took log on WJW's new station. WASK had swell show and gave us lots of publicity, plugged a town called Kittanning, Pa at 4:35 (Wonder where that is?) and read our tips, and story on KWRC program. WNOE was a strong second. From 3-3:30 there seemed to be a third station on-who was it? WSOO? WIBU & WHUB tests hrd on sked. 11/29 Listened on 1240 for half hour to no avail, then suddenly the curtain lifted and in came KWRC with fine signal, but no Army Air Force Band. On 11/17 hrd KVOR from 1:16-1:32AM s-off; WEGO on their swell special for the club; KYA on the 21st on R9 from 2:46-3AM s-off; 11/22 WINN with check 3-3:15; CJRL with their vfb special for 1 hour and 15 min; KFBK on 49; WASK special from 3:20-3:45 during which time they were badly CRMed by WERC which was testing on 11/25; WIBU with check from 3:51-4AM and WSPA on reg sked on 28th from 7:07-7:30; In the veries received dept I did a little better, they are from WTSP-WJMC-KGKL-WRRF-WBTM-KOCY-KGER-VKAT a cute card with a Cat speaking into a Mike-WFLA-WDAY-KVOR-WISE. Veries in from WTOP-WRDW-KELD-WCMI-WEST-WISE-WMRC. WMRC tests the 3rd FRI 3:50-4AM on 1490 and can be hrd behind WJBK & WWSW. My 10 year old Zenith outdid itself by bringing in WHIT on their reg sked for about 5 min. Guess its not ready for the scrap heap yet. But I'll stick to the S-20-R for good reception. Zenith hasnt any selectivity and the locals come in all over the band.
