CKWS-Kingston, Ont Another "first" of the N R C. This will be the first DX program ever from CKWS and we hope no one will miss it. Bill Stone continues his fine work with this program and Mr Charles Miller, program director agreed to DX for us. CKRN-Rouyn, Que Another friend of long standing is CKRN and their Mr Geo Pope, Chief Engineer. This program will have WHBQ to buck for they refused to sign off for CKRN, but CKRN gets out very well and should ride through for most of us. It is possible CKVD will be on at the same hour as this one, but with a different show, as this was the way it was originally planned, but we suggested Nov 28 for CKVD to give them better coverage, without WITH QRM. Bill Stone is also responsible for this program.

Had a tuff time with KORN, the first 1/2 hour till WJLB signed off. KORN stayed on till 3AM and NRC DX list read twice more. KWBU hrd on DX but no reply as yet, sent an airmail to them. Had to really listen to WSLB to get a 15 minute report on them. Sent KLRA 2 reports & no answer, none from WRVA either. Received a nice big Night Owl membership card from WCCO, per Ed Vichman. *JBK-WHLD are slow for reply and have reports out to KXEL-CFRB-WNBF-WBCN-WNEW-WOL. Got a letter and card from WTOP and cards from WBEN-WCKY-WPBR-WMMN-WDSU and nice letters from WJJD-WSLB-WEXL-WSAI-(WLOU). I sure will be glad when they substitute busses for the street cars again.

GRANT BATSON-WESTFIELD N Y I hopped onto the dials at last and got a few and also some new ones heard. 11/5 CKEY in daytime; 11/6 KLBW testing 4-4:15 and who signs off at 4:07 AM EWT concluding with news period????? Is it KSAN or KORE, will some west coaster please let me know. Who ever it is, it will be a new one for me. 11/6 KWBU on club DX and hrd R-9 for a new one; WSLB for us was Q4 *-9 here; 11/9 KASA testing 5:27-5:40 and static was heavy. 11/10 KORN on Club "special R 6-7 fairly well hrd in spite of other stations on. Added a couple new ones with it already. HELP GANG-who was testing on 1240 kcs Sunday AM the 12th of Nov from 5-6:15 AM at irregular times. Q5 R9 here so had to be one in the USA and not too far away. Only identification recorded here was this- WIT FIVE SIXTY (WIT 560) This call was clear and easily heard. A close check on 560 kcs, thinking maybe a harmonic, failed to show any station there with a test program, even the station easy to hear on 1240 kcs. WCOL and WITH were both heard on 1230 kc at same time. WIT 560 played as one selection "They Go Wild Over Me". TPs were fine this AM (11/12) with 3 new ones logged. On 1110 kcs KPAS now on with special AM program known as Midnight Caravan, if any needs him. I need his verie. Does not answer reports for me anyway. Wbbb easy to log 7:55 AM Sundays, only has KARK to bother him. KWBU and KORN OK and reports sent both on NRC DX's.

Still have done no DXing and cant seem to get started at this fascinating hobby. On WMOH's DX for us I will be there and will try to have them play band selections. (If they do Joe, dont forget the titles-Ray)

RAY (POP) EDGE-BUFFALO N Y Was up for KORN and WCBI. Sent report to KORN but did not request a verie. As to WCBI, couldnt get a whisper out of em here even tho I heard them each time during the past season. Dont know what station covers them, but it is one on 1340 kcs, maybe WHAT. Heard KWBU swell. Did not get up for KXO or WISE this AM 11/14) account of static being very heavy here. Thought it would be a waste of sleep. Was WCOL off at all? Hope they were, but then with the noise I doubt if they could have been hrd here. KFI & KNX were a mere R-1. No new veries.

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JOE ENZ-BROOKLYN N.Y. KWBU was R-9 here on NRC Special, on 11/8 hrd WHLD WFCI-WTMA-WMVA-WSNY all when I got up to go to work at 5:15 AM, also hrd WTOP. Verie came in from CBK, less than a week. WDSU hrd SUN AM very good. Would like to know if Ted Saling or Larry Yearns could give me any help on these 2 stations, one on 1290 kc or 1300 and same program on 1450 kcs. This was hrd at 3 AM EWT with religious programs (mentioned some network) signed off at 12:15 AM PWT with selection "America The Beautiful". This was heard MON Nov 13 at 3 AM EWT. ZNS hrd for 1st time on 640 kcs signing off at 10 PM on 11/12. Will try for KXO and KVMU on their DXes.

RALPH JOHANNES-BUFFALO NY Just a little more dope. WGAR hrd on 1220 kcs and KFAB now on 1110, they gave a single test signal at 4:17-KFAB testing and again at 5:01, and went on the air at 6:01. WCOL was on till 3:30AM drowning KXO, then at 3:30 WMFR came in with a test and signed off 4:10. WISE just about faintly hrd, could not get a report. Will send KXO Tnx Card.

JOE BRAUNER-WILLIAMSVILLE NY Nothing new added to the log, but received veries from WMRF on club special, a card, also nice letter verie from KEVR one thats been badly wanted here for a long time. Replies coming in rather slow, overdue are WIND-KWRC-KWIL and WELO, the first 3 were attempts to get better veries. Regarding WDEL last week, should have said WDEL can be heard in the clear UNTIL 8AM Sundays, not at 8AM. WKPA signs on at 8 and the QRM is rather bad. Have another letter from Chief Engineer, or Operator Parley Rasmussen, KOVO correcting the time given to me for their frequency check, it should be 3rd MON 3:30-3:45 AM EWT, not 2nd MON.
