I also failed to hear them, though right here in the same state. Too much strong opposition from all night stations, especially WJBK. On the 9th I received a letter from Mr. Olsen with some comments on that test. He was informed me that they received last minute orders to test 2:30-3:00 EWT, 30 minutes later then advertised sked. However Hank says he put WDBC on the sir at 2:15 EWT in an effort to reach the boys of the NRC. Hank says he received a few reports and is sending them to me for answering, since this was a must since he were to dedicate. I expect to receive 'these reports soon, so to the boys who reported WDBC that their "Veries" or "Regrets" will come from me. WDBC's test was strictly all swing music, according to Hank although he says several report band music and in particular "Stars & Stripes". He couldn't explain this. So it looks as if some are reporting without really identifying a station. If a verie is asked for under these conditions I believe it should be stopped at once. To all who heard "Stars & Stripes", that was from WIGM in Medford, Wisc who were testing from 2-2:30 AM EWT. Hank says he will advise as soon as possible the exact time and date of the Feb test. I know they were on at the right time though I must confess that I was busy myself in Kansas City at the time. I spoke to Leo Stafford, c.e. of KOAM here at Pittsburg, Kansas and he is going to apply to the FCC for permission to have a DX show for us. As things stand now KOAM must be off the air from sundown because of WGY. Right now its sked is 7:30 AM to 6:30 PM CWT daily. While I was here I picked up a verie card. They have lots of them and are very willing to put on a DX, it'll probably be some Sunday morning. The letters KOAM stand for, Kansas, Oklahoma-Arkansas-Missouri and the station calls itself "The 4 State Station" PFC FRAN GMEINER-85058285 Just a few lines to let you know my where-

HQ BATTERY-746th F A Bn APO 17665 % POSTMASTER NEW YORK CITY, N.Y. Just a few lines to let you know my wherebouts, Somewhere in England. I tried to locate Leo Herz thru Red Cross but they couldnt do it (He is in France now Fran) The bulletin of Dec 16th arrived last week all OK.

I checked the freq of all the TAs listed and they seem to be as listed. Also heard several more. DX on WAGM very poor, hardly audible, fading badly, static E-9 plus.

Found the band Lousy with Spicks and conditions really had static, cannot remember ever hearing it so bad, some bursts lasted solidly 6 minutes; Logged WHIZ s/off at 1915 for a new one, Tnx to Al Maley I also got HJAT, Barranquilla, Col, hrd Q 3-4 R 3-6, static big trouble, definitely on 1275 alright, WDSU sigs hrd now und then to the side of them and above. No luck on HJAK though as static increasing, although they are hrd but was not able to get positive identity, WAGM was hrd with difficulty, good job WWDC stood by as the latter was putting in Q5 E9 plus sig in here, wrote Chas Shaffer and Tnx WAGM best from 4:30-5, WENL testing 500 w cux xmtr on 910; Hit the hay right after completion of WAGM slept till LPM so I missed no sleep at all. 1/15 DXed again, not long out of bed anyways, logged WAOV as noted in Maley list, but they were only one hrd, could have used both Utah stations but they were not audible. Any info on this one, anyone? One verie of interest is from CFCY. This one means I have heard thus far this year, and verified every Canadian province, 40 states in US.DC. and them my foreign stuff. Sure glad to get that CFCY verie as I have been working on him for years. Reception here last night (Mon) was lousy. Seems that sun-spots are acting up again. Things had just about got back to normal when this had to happen. Could barely hear the big 50KW in NY-Chgo, but C.A. and S.A. were good. CKY also was good, cant figure it out as normally they are hard to hear. Also an unknown hrd on 1010 kcs at 8:55PM. Oklahoma City was mentioned, and sponsored programs were being carried. Could not get any call and have no idea who it was. Am positive it was not KLRA as they were on with an entirely different program. Is this a new illegal? Or just what did I have? Any help. Have plenty for a verie if I knew the station. This AM (TUES) at \$: 5:30-6:30 reception still dousy. Almost nothing coming in. Channels that are normally putting in very strong sigs, completely dead. However at 8:45 today things seemed to be picking up again and both N Y and Chicago again well heard. Maybe this sun-spot flare up is over in a hurry. Hope so. We sure owe a vote of thanks to WWDC for standing by during the WAGM-DX. Here it would have been absolutely impossible to get WAGM thru WWDC if they had stayed on the air. As it is I got a good report off to WAGM. RALPH JOHANNS-BUFFALO N.Y. Veries received since last report are letters from CJGX with weekly sked and calendar-WAGE who signed my report-WHBY-WLVA-KWLC-WGRC-WBML-KWO3-WFOY-WHAI-WMSL-WBRW-KICD. Cards from WDBO-WGY-WLS-WWL-KPO-WSB-WOL-WIBX, and from WKBW a card and letter, and from WHBQ a picture post card showing its antenna atop the studio bldg .. Has easy program to copy from 2:15-2:30, plenty of local ads. Not much DX this week, due to need of sleep, did stay up Monday AM but only got KTAR for a report. Oh yes also copied WOAI for a report. Total veries now stand at 842 different calls. Oh yes did get WFLA verie. No sign of CHUM on 1050 kcs as yet here, but there is some noise there.

Going to have a swell visit with Kenny Page tomorrow (Friday) as he is home on leave for a couple weeks, maybe he will get KORE so I better be up and listening. <u>NORM MAGUIRE-ALBUQUERQUE N MEX</u> A few added items and comment. On 660 kcs, the station here was hrd while tuning across to get 1YA. Porgot that I had hrd KFAR s/off until about 3AM here and then I listened to this station. There were no announcements or titles of the music played. The sign off rather amazed me. It was so weak that I could not copy the info but had to concentrate on the program and try to remember what was said. They gave the call which was lost in static and then the location as either the University of ... Station, or located on campus of University of .... They then signed off with the Star pangled Banner which further confused me. Thought it might be the Russian or Jerusalem station on this freq until they played our National Anthem. It might have been as far off as 662 kcs which lead me to think for a few monents. (Cont on Page 8)

Page 8 January 20\_1945 ----NORM MAGUIRE Cont There were quite a few stations coming thru from Down Under this AM 1/14. The Zedders came thru in force and were on at least 15 minutes before any Aussies came in. Most of them were at least a half hour later in making their appearance. However my unknown station on 1360 well before this. They were hrd about R 3-4 Q 2. The selections came thru quite well and the announcement periods could easily be recognized as was the fact that it was an English speaking station. Might have heen a British or American. 4PM in Port Morsby used to be on this freq before the Japs hit New Guinea but doubt if same station again operating. I wonder if it could be a replacement for old 4PM or one of our Armed Forces stations operating in some of the islands down that way? Hrd my first Jap of the season this AM. It cleared 1010 about a half hour after I first hrd the Orential announcements. At 5:30 AM EWT they put on a program in English. They announced the program was the American Was Soldiers Program. The music was fine string orchestra music such as "Thine Alone" played in the style of Norman Clottder and the "Longines" programs hrd in this country. The signals were actually registering K-8 from 3:30-3:45 AM on my indicators. Started to fade from R 6-7 an hour later. I hrd them till I turned in for bed this AM. Hrd this spick on 830 kcs the other AM, was surprised to hear one so late at night. Static was bad. I missed the call, its location was announced and it had no reference to either Havana, Cuba or Mexico. Was some place I was not familiar with. Tnx to Al and Joe Brauner for helping me on the station on 1140 kcs. I'm mad now as I cant find the data on reception. Veries very slow in coming in. Canadians back fine but not the US stations. Still havent heard from KXO-KVCV on our specials; CJGX wrote me a nice letter and disclosed that 2 of our members, Johanns and Stan Morss caught them same AM also. CHAB returned by IRC with the verie.
