WISE-ASHEVILLE N C Well another month rolls around and our good friend Miss Betty Freeman is still dedicating the check programs of WISE to the N R C. The boys write in saying that she is still getting reports from the members, sometimes not so many and then again a good bunch. We can say that Betty deserves a lot of praise for her continued cooperation and also thanks to you who have continued to report. One thing is always certain, when you tune in to Betty you can be sure of a half hour of enjoyment. Thanks to you Betty Freeman from all of us NRCers.

WWSR-ST ALBINS VT This station will be on testing for NRC on both above dates. They will use 1000 watts. Mr. Winston L. Blake, Manager of WWSR wants to conduct some tests on how WWSR is radiating, so every one who can is urged to tune in and report on both programs. There will be some slight differences at transmitter on the two mornings. This will give many of you boys a chance to log and report a station in Vermont and it is believed that the 1420 kc channel will be clear from 5:30-6:45AM. At 6:45 AM Station WHK and WOC will come on, but that will be only for the last 10 minutes. Mr. Blake has assured that every correct report will be verified. So you west coast lads here is a chance to verify a Vermont Station. Thanks to Mr. Blake for his cooperation. Arr, by Dr John Kirk.

WGNC-GASTONIA N C In regard to verifying I am inclined to agree with Dave Thomas. I understand where a burst of static can knock out a call, but from Gastonia, I really would like for them to get the call, as my policy is the Call at least every 5 minutes (unless busy talking to the Freq Monitor station via Long Distance) in which case, we might run over by a minute or so, but in general I would say that in 90% of the time, if you can hear us for 10 minutes, you will have gotten our call at least three times and not less than 2 and if you can log the titles, you should also be able to log the call. I don't see how anyone can get a decent report, one that could be less than 10 minutes of listening. I think you should read not less than 30% preferable 50% and above from the first 10 minutes, or not less than 20% on 15 minutes listening, for a complete report, and report what you read. It does no good to read it 85% and report only 5% of what you read. If you can read 10% from 30 minutes listening, then I think you will have enough for positive identification of the station and program so you can report. I just thought I would give you the opinion of the idea of one Chief Engineer that was on the other end of the line when it comes to verifying reports and sending in of reports on reception. Our antenna is not as efficient as it should be. Our local daytime and Nighttime signal is only about 1/2 or 2/3 of what it should be. We have only a 150 ft tower, slightly less than 1/4 wave and is shunt fed.

Have managed to hear TIPG with R-8 signal at midnight on 2/3; TIBAS still good on 650. Did log a new Mexican this AM 2/5, the station was XE?on ?? kcs. Been listening on 1050 kc during the day for CHOM but apparently not on yet. Received some advertising from "Voice of Prophecy" a religious program. Notice that among others in the US these stations carry their programs. HP6J on 1360 kcs; HOK on 640 kc; WOAR on 950 kc. XELO on 800 kcs; and WVDI on 990 kcs; TO THOMAS; We here in Cleveland are wondering what is GOUSMP on 660 kcs???

HAROLD HOWARD-KONETA O Well I am finally getting in a report. On 1/14 sent an evening report to CFPL; 1/15 pulled in 2 that were very welcome, KGLU and KEUB; 1/17 reported to WHMA-WROX and KNOE (look gang).
