I'm not usually the kind of guy who gets enthusiastic enough about anything to write rave notices about it, but I must offer a few "gee whizzes" after reading the DX NEWS of December 6. To receive two such excellent features as Len Kruse's "Condition of Frequencies" list and Hal Wagner's splitting frequencies list in one issue is further proof, if such is needed, that ours has to be the best broadcast band DX publication in the hemisphere. I also am very impressed with the willingness of Ponca City's Hank Ward and Ken Borden to do the mimeographing of the Weyrich Log, this performing a notable service to the members. Since joining the Club in 1952, I have attempted to keep up with the condition of frequencies by means of a chart, which shows a square for each frequency, each day of the week. I shade in the squares when there is an all nighter on the channel (excluding the very weak ones) and leave the other squares light. Using Kruse's latest condition of frequencies list as a guide, I've just revised the chart, and it sure proves that the all-nighters are closing in fast. Since my last revision, openings between 3 and 5 EST have fallen off each day except Monday, which has remained at 51. Others: Tuesday from 24 to 18; Wednesday 21 to 17; Thursday, 20 to 16; Friday, 22 to 15; Saturday, 20 to 15, Sunday 23 to 17. Convinced? 73s.

The half-dozen DX Specials slated for Monday, December 2nd, for the NRC, did not all come into this den. The four following ones were heard: WEAG (1470) Alcoa, Tenn.; KDUZ (1260) Hutchinson, Kans.; KIYI (1150) Shelby, Mont.; and WATP (1430) Marion, S.C. And two of these four were new to my DX Log, namely KIYI and WATP. As for KNLR, I'm certain they have failed for the second attempt to DX for us this season, and awaiting word as to what has happened this time. My much-sought QJKL, on the air since 1934, could not be heard, as AN WEBC controlled that frequency, with a slight trace of AN WQAM. Were they on the air as planned? On 12/5 I was happy to log Station WNDU (1490) South Bend, Ind. with its late RS, and on till 2:35 a.m. weekdays. Then on 12/6 I was much surprised to find Station WWED (790) well in the clear at this den, and a fairly good signal, with their RS at 5:30 a.m. and heard for 15 minutes. Some station signed on with "The National Anthem" at 5:35 a.m., but still WWED was in charge of 790 at this location. The morning of 12/7 was profitable to my DX Log, for three additions were made. Station KACT (1360) Andrews, Texas was heard with its r/cpTT from 1:45-2 a.m., but with QRM from WFLW's ETs on this, their new frequency, but KACT cut through fairly well. Then at 2:06-2:30 a.m. ETs were heard from Station KDET (1220) Livingston, Texas, and my third logging was Station WKTF (1420) Warrenton, Va. a new 5,000 watt day-timer, on with ETs 2:19-2:30 a.m. I'm anxiously looking forward to the fine DXes slated on 12/8 and 12/9; a total of nine Specials for the NRC those two days. My hat goes off to Fran Nittler, PC Chairman, for one beautiful array of DX Specials. Don't you agree they are Tops? Only two varies, both letters this week, coming from WCLC and WAMP.

Varies continued coming in good though with these in: WKBX-f/up, KGYN-f/up, WNRV WPDQ KBEM KWMT (ex-KEOK) WRAJ KIOA and CKMI. CKMI is Canadian #18 with 100% verified from Canada. I mean every one reported to has verified. I now have 444 varies. Hope everyone tunes in the KSPI DX on 12/18. Would like to make a favorable impression on the personnel there. We definitely will verify all correct reports. Good DX to all. 73s.

Does anyone have the signer for WCGC-1270? My report of 10/5 is still out. Notice: It is not necessary to send return postage to WKYR-1270. Letter arrived with 5/ stamp (#1,190) and said, "It is a pleasure to confirm your reception and extend thanks for the nice report. Also, in keeping with company policy, we are returning your postage." Like Hal Williams, I got no answer from WEAM-1390, for about four reports around 1949 to 1953. Occasionally, I have heard stations testing before midnight. One was WASA-1330, testing in the afternoon. I received three bulletins in six days here recently - all in one week. 73s.

 Since my last report, the following stations have been reported, all of which were logged from Ocean Station Victor. 11/21, KGO-810, KAHU-920, both on RS, and KOBY-1550 ETing at 5:00. Times, E.S.T. 11/25-4AY-960 RS, KENI-550, RS, both between 3:45-4:45. 11/26- KFJI-1150, KDON-1460, RS, and KING-1090. 11/28, KDAN-790, 10:15 a.m., KBOI-950 and a real surprise in the clear, HJKC-840 from 12-12:30 a.m., (29th, EST). 11/29, KSFO-560 and VOA on 1180 and 1140. These latter two are really jammed and unreadable in the Pacific area. 11/30, KFSD-600, KATT-990, KMVI-550, KGW-620, KILA-850 and KRUX-1340 AN for a surprise.
