I haven't felt much like DXing this week, but after a stimulating meeting with New Jersey members Ronnie Schiller, Bob Foxworth and Jim Ernst, I got up Monday for our DXes from KEMA-1390 (unsuccessful, WFBL-ET and bad buzz which suddenly quit at 4:02). WKTQ 1450 in fine, on at 3:55, until about 4:17 when they faded down considerably. Until then they topped 1450 nicely with a wonderful program with their whole staff there. After DXing 26 years, it is seldom you can log two new ones simultaneously, but I did this AM on 1500 when WHBT-1600, ex-1230, Harriman, Tenn. was logged with a fine signal 3:55-4:40 and after 4:15 or so, WBLY, Springfield, Ohio heard behind them, seemed RS.

MUSINGS OF THE MEMBERSHal Williams - 50 Third Avenue - Seymour, Connecticut

The most important happening here DX-wise was the DX gab-fest at Bernie Duffy's home in Staten Island on Sunday 12/7. It was a real pleasure to again meet Lefty Cooper, Bernie Duffy and his brother John, and Peter Clarius, also from Staten Island. Lefty brought Anthony Lagatutta along and later it was a real pleasure to meet two of our fairly new members from New Jersey, Jim Ernst and Bob Foxworth. We all brought our veries along and "swapped" DX experiences. On the whole it was a very enjoyable trip and my sincere thanks to Bernie and John Duffy for a very pleasant afternoon and evening. I got home at 11 p.m. and expected to log some of the DX programs listed for 12/8 but alas, the only one heard was ZEM-1 1355 and they were not needed. WOXO-1460, Albany, N.Y. again testing as they did on 12/7 but off at 1:49. They seem to test almost every AM, hi. CFCF-600 was heard on RS 2:40-3:00 with WICC silent but not needed (WICC has been reported sold for \$1,700,000 pending F.C.C. approval). WGR-550 Buffalo N.Y. testing at 3:00 so no chance for needed CKPG. Tuned 1150 at 3:02 and found some tester there with very strong OC and of course CKSA was not heard. WMAQ-670 noted s/off at 3:35. Back to 1150 after 3:35 but no CKSA, then I tried 550 again and WGR was stronger than earlier. WERE-1300 Cleveland, O. banging away on AN sked at 3:45. Strong carrier and TT on 1490 killed all chances for FNDU so in disgust I tuned for the CHEX-980 DX and they were a poor second to CEPL but not needed. The entire AM was a real bust, DX-wise. 12/9- WWIL-1580 heard after 3:30. Not heard here for a long time so they must be AN again. With 16 veries received last week to bring my total to exactly 2,000 this week was a let down with but four received. V/1 WMRB-1490 for NRC DX. v/1 KREI-800 and Bob Rapp, Manager states "I'm sorry to learn of your former unanswered report but you can assure any of your fellow DXers any report now received will be answered." (This was when they were on 1350). The last of the eight PP cards I sent out in November was returned by KLUE-1300 (now KANB) for the NNRC DX 2/14/58 to bring my verie total to 2,004. KLUE was PP card verie #69. I do not like them but they are far better than no verie. Merry Christmas to all.

WDIX 1150 s/on at 5:00 and while trying for WHNY, WFTU-1250 on an ET. 12/2- On 12/1 I heard two stations in English under WCBS. Today WRED was IDed and on 12/5 WRRZ was found to be the other one. 12/6- WOLF 1490, WMME 1340 and WELC 1590 were all logged on RS, also heard were WFUR 1570, WELI 1240, WWXL 1580 and WGHM 1370 on r/c.
