Thus is no use to have Austrian and Mexican stations mixed together. It will be no heavier job for you if you just ask all reporters to report in that way. This system is commonly used in Europe and works well. (Thanks for your comments, but because of the way I set things up, it would take more time. However, I'll be glad to hear comments from others-FV)
