We have a note here from a John T. Artnur, Endwell, N.Y., of the NASA which says KDEM -800 was not on on 2/4 but was re-sked for 3/4, and he gives the time as 1:00-1:30 a.m. EST, but this would be Sunday night at 11:00 p.m. there, so must be an error. Perhaps it is 3:00-3:30 E.S.T., 1:00-1:30 MST. He also says KDEM received several "reception reports" for Feb. 4 which he believes is disgraceful. And so do we.

W_B_O_L

This is, of course, a new station, having begun operations last October, with 250 watt daytime. They have their regular frequency check at 2:30 a.m. on the first Wednesday of each month, and they tell us that following their March 6th check, they will remain on the air for about a half hour testing. After 3:02 a.m. E.S.T. (when WDXR signs off) 1560 should be completely clear. WBOL's check has been heard throughout the East, but they have not been heard to the West at all, and perhaps some of our Western members will be able to hear this test on Wednesday morning. A clipping from Hank Tyndall says WDAX-620 in his city (Burlington, Vt.) has been sold to the Vermont Radio Co., who propose changing the call letters from WCAX to WVMT.

Another clipping we've had on hand a while says that President Kennedy called executives of the ~~eight~~ BCB and ~~two~~ SW stations which carried the VOA programs to Cuba for about three weeks during the night hours at the time of the Cuba emergency last October. They were WWL-870 WCKY-1530 WKWF-1600 WCKR-610 WGBS-710 WMIE-1140 KAAV-1090, and SW WRUL & KGEL. None of these stations asked for or received any compensation! This certainly points out what fine people run our American radio stations, that they so willingly sacrificed commercial time and subsequent revenue to answer the President's emergency call, pending the completion of the two VOA Keys stations on 1040 & 1180.

Well, if they are then WEK is off frequency, hi! PRH9 sent a king-size v/q in several languages including EE, plus a big pennant with many flags of other countries, U.S.A. not included. DX continues merrily on with CX excellent all week. 2/22- Unk SS-750 @ 12:41am. TT on 1590 turned out to be f/c from WELE, about even with WAKR & over WSMN, with a WALG test-call @ 12:50. WELE f/c must be 12:45-1am. Unn KUTT-1550 r/c heard 1-1:30, & ET/M from WYCL-1530 asking for DX reports. TT on 1500, never heard an ID; on most all AM.
