First off, to Bill Stone - no DX or what? November is the month for the annual CDXC BCB Contest, but so far DX has been mediocre most of the time except for some Aurora catches from LA. Continuing from last report: 10/20- Little heard WKVA-920 mixed with WMMN @ 7pm. 10/21- As usual at this time of year, KCMO-810 murdering WGY around 6:30 am; WMAJ-1450 on top briefly at 6:47am. At 5:30pm, surprised to find WHCU-870 with strong signal & little bothered by CJBC; WOAP-1080 s/off 5:59 way under WTIC; hetro on 1375 at 6:05pm - any chance of this being St. Pierre? 10/22- Finally got around to logging Radio Belize-834 between 8:20-8:35pm - no answer yet; probably have got so many reports they're not bothering to verify any more. This evening some rather fantastic DX on my 11 transistor Japanese, which at times is effective in nulling locals, not possible on the Graetz. WKRC-550 through WGR; WCHS-580 under CKEY; WAVE-970 through WEBR; WKMH (or maybe their new calls WKNR)-1310 under CFGM; WIRE-1430 under CKFH; & the most miraculous of all, caught five minutes of programming from WINS through previously invincible CFRB. SS under WLS @ 9:20pm, probably HJCE, Bogota. 10/26- WFGH-960 s/on 4am; sounded like WHUN on 1150 @ 4:10 - are they on this early Saturdays? At 6am, WQAM-560 & KLCN-910 dominating their frequencies.
