Notes: WHAG-1410 was originally sked for 1/13, 4-4:30, but has been asked to change to 4:30-5:00 to avoid a conflict with a test from WSNE on the same channel. (P.14) WKBI-1400, St. Marys, Pa. This was listed a couple of issues back in error as being on 1340 kc/s. Note that 1400 is correct; reports to Cary H. Simpson, CE "Radio Trinidad"-730, Port of Spain, Trinidad, put on a special DX program for NRC on New Year's Day, 3:00-3:30 a.m. EST. Word of this test was sent to Ray Edge, who got it into last week's issue in time, but it didn't get here to Brooklyn in time, We hope you all heard this program, and reported reception to Dr. E. R. McDowell, 11-B Maraval Road - Port of Spain, Trinidad.

TO ALL CPC-MEN

We would like to remind you that to get full publicity in DX NEWS for your TESTS and DXes, we MUST know about the program at least two weeks before its broadcast date! For example, a program for January 13 would have to be in the January 4th issue to reach all members in time. Deadline for this issue was on December 30th. So, if this two weeks (absolute MINIMUM) is NOT allowed your Editor, your programs will be going on WITHOUT any advance notice to the members, and hence, with no publicity, and the probability of scant few reports for the station, which could result in the loss of a friend at a given station. We suggest asking for programs at least TWO MONTHS ahead!

- 1286 Prague, CZECHOSLOVAKIA. Sunday 1800-1830 w/light operatic mx & arias, to Spain in SS. Uses same trumpet on SW(JP); note someone hrd what sounded like Portuguese 1800 & figured Lisbon. May well be, but Prague has SS at this time & is usually dominant (BD); in SS around 1810-1830 s/off with complete ID & IS. Sigs as good as any TA 12/24, -25 (HM)
- CSB3 Lisbon, PORTUGAL. Portuguese Catholic station verified my report of 11/24. Sked is 0700-0200 GMT (0200-2100 EST); 3kw, one of my best TA's (RB)
