W D C J Jones College acquired WDCJ (then WQTY) in October, 1963, and changed the call letters at that time. Formerly located in Arlington, Fla., WDCJ is now in Riverton Tower in Jacksonville. They do not have an early-morning frequency check or test period, so are not often heard at any distance. Some DXers did hear WDCJ when they served the public interest, convenience and necessity by remaining on the air around the clock due to hurricane danger. The test will consist of pleasant instrumentals with station breaks and test information after each selection. Send your reports to Mr. Don Ritter, General Manager, to whom we offer our thanks for notifying Len Kruse of this special TEST.

Y N S WYNS began regular operations in April of 1962, on the 12th to be exact, and since then, not very many DXers have been able to hear this station, in Eastern Pennsylvania. This golden opportunity to do so will come as they make an equipment test on 11/9 as WYNS, "Serving the Tri-Valley Area at 1150" will be on the air. There will be music on this test from an album entitled "Encore" featuring the Bernie Lowe Orchestra. There will be frequent pauses for station breaks and test data. Reports should be sent to Mr. Michael L. Seitleman Chief Engineer, whom we thank for notifying Len Kruse of this test period. Be sure to tune for this test from a rarely heard radio station.

A reminder - these two programs are on Monday morning, November 9, 1964. The IRCA tests from WAGM-950 and WDOV-1410 are the same AM. We do not have their v/s here.

Rugg, Johnson, Warner (NRCers) and CDXCers Noon & Woodley were present during the performance of CDXC Hamband Editor Garry Hammond and we can relate differently. CDXC Conventions are always noted for an abundance of liquid refreshment and this tradition carried over to the MM festivities in Room 100. Garry was definitely not on his best behavior. So be it. KUIL was a real shocker! KLIV-1590 is only 28 miles away, but KUIL really smeared KLIV just after SSS. All the others for 10/23 were at sunrise or after. Veries from KWIN-KTLW-KJDY-CBJ-KMRE-WHUT.
