SPECIAL TESTS ON THIS WEEK.

WERA-1590. This station maintains a "once-every-three-months" sked on frequency tests and this is the next one. Mr. Robert Balfour, C.E., will be happy to have us listen for his check on Friday AM, 12/16, which will get underway shortly after midnight and run to about 12:45. He will use tone & make frequent IDs interrupting the tone signal to do so. Our thanks to Mr. Balfour for letting us know about this ~~program~~ frequency check. 500w., directional. E.COOPER

KALF-1510. This 10 kilowatt er os going to run a lengthy test program starting right after midnight MST on Monday 12/19, using tones, music, IDs, etc. and may be on much of the early morning, on what should be a clear channel. Mr. James E. Groll, C.E., will be happy to hear from DXers picking up his test, & he will verify correct reports. This station ought to be heard from Coast to Coast, so here's a real fine chance to hear Arizona, in KALF. JERRY STARR.

- +610 PANAMA. HCHM, Circuito R.P.C., Panama. Quite good on loop w/actualidades 11/28 2305. ID as "Circuito R.P.C." at 2315. (Wood, Ind.)
- 629 TUNISIA. Tunis I heard on 11/15, 1820-1838 s/off. This is the Arabic program and kinda hard to get much detail for a report, but the verie is already back. About 60% readable through local FMAL on 630. Only one announcement, just before sign off, with National Anthem. (Alan Merriman, Box 6, Fairfax, Va. 22030)
- 630 COLOMBIA. HJPD, R. Manizales, Manizales, now noted AN with Todelar program. (Michael A. Silvera, 5 Grosvenor Heights, Kingston, 8, Jamaica)

- +770 URUGUAY. CX12, R. Oriental, Montevideo. Another one with election rundown seems to have interviews at 0124 11/28. Strongest of three CX's heard, but still not enough for report. Carrier noted past 0340. (Silvera)
- UNID. Oriental here, sounded Mandarin; 11/28 at 0619. Not NHK. (Randy J. Seaver, 2119 30th St., San Diego, Calif. 92104)
- +773 INTL. WATERS (England). R. 390 is off the air, according to a news report in the Washington Post of Sunday, 11/27. Closed down by court order, but it has been appealed. This is one of the stations located on the abandoned forts off England. I think R. City and R. Essex are also on forts, so maybe they'll be ordered off, too. I never did verie 390, HI. - 825 COSTA RICA. TIOS, R. Titania, San Jose. Heard well 11/29 at 0058. (Seaver, Calif.)
- 830 MEXICO. XENSM, Navolota, Sinaloa. John, I got XENSM call ID at s/on some months ago. (Seaver, Calif.) With those specific call letters heard, I'll clean my ears and accept them. (Ed.)

Nothing on channel after WHAS s/off 12/5, but something there 0510-0515 12/5, mentioning "Guatemantecas" ... but even a deeply-nulled WHAS was too much. (Callarman, Texas)
- 845 INTL. WATERS (England). Britain Radio logged on 11/27, 1832 to 1903 s/off. Carrier left the air at 1903. Very weak and fading badly. Plays mostly slow inst. music, no rock. Apparently, Rome has moved up to 846 as they were completely separable from Britain Radio. This on an evening of excellent European reception. (Merriman, Va.) Unid. station 1 kHz below RAI with light music and English (I think) announcements. Carrier is distinguishable from RAI's, but heavy heterodyne and RAI are by far stronger. Only heard occasionally, but fairly good on 11/26. Faded before ID could be caught, but is almost certainly Britain Radio. Not reported, as will wait for ID. Time was 1830-1906. (Calkin, N.B.)
- 850 CUBA. CFKC, Santiago de Cuba, heard 0350 dominant 12/5 with LV de Cuba programming. I stayed on channel through 0400, hoping to get a CX16 log, but no dice. Next spring, maybe. (Callarman, Texas)
- NICARAGUA. YNAV, R. Continental, anagua. Finally logged over KOA on loop 11/26 with 14DB/S9 signals. Frequent ID's and nice programming. (Conrad, Ky.) Note correct call. Station told DX'er who visited several years ago it was YNAV, not YNMV. Most lists have not yet caught up. (Ed.)
- NORTH KOREA. Pyongyang outlet dominated KICY and Spanish-speaker 11/28 at 0450-0500. (Seaver, Calif.)
- 854 W. BERLIN. RIAS logged on 11/27 2320-2400. Mostly music, news at 2330, and another short talk at 2345. Announcements in German. I did not hear a definite ID, but I am quite sure this was the station. Detailed report sent, so will know for sure if I get a verie. (Merriman, Va.)
- 885 NICARAGUA. YNKW, R. Libertad, Managua. Finally took a log on him at good strength 12/4 2301-2333 for report. (Callarman, Texas)
- 900 COSTA RICA. TICS, R. Atenea, San Jose, now obviously using this slogan, ex-LV de America. Not parallel with 975 kHz. (Silvera, Jamaica) Logged using this slogan at 0358 12/5 s/on, with musica nortena and long-winded Christmas greetings by "countrified" announcer, in SS. Probably this early only through Christmas. Well atop the channel through 0415 tuneout. (Callarman, Texas)
- 910 HONDURAS. HRVS, R. Catolica, LV Suyapa, Tegucigalpa, is a regular here at MM s/on. After running at least 5 minutes of religious music, s/on anncts. heard 0456 and stayed atop for remainder of stay through 0510 tuneout. (Callarman, Texas)
- VENEZUELA. YVRC, R. Aeropuerto, Caracas. Completely dominant MM's with LA music and female announcer. Frequent IDs and ads. 15DB/S9 11/28. (Conrad, Ky.) Note correct call. Changed from YVPF a couple of years ago. Some lists have not yet caught up. (Ed.) Noted at weak to fair level 12/5 as early as 0321 and through HRVS s/on. Usual programming. May report them some day. (Callarman, Texas)
- 922 COLOMBIA. HJAF, Emisora Fuentes, Cartagena, Noted with ads for "Jabon" 1935 11/29. Light and band music. (Wood, Ind.)
- 925 COSTA RICA. TIR, Cadena Musical, San Jose. This is strictly R&R music, no longer parallel with 575 and 675. (Silvera, Jamaica)
- 960 GUATEMALA. TGAX, R. Continental, Guatemala. Should have read back here from 955 kHz (re 10/29 IDXD) Sorry! (Silvera, Jamaica)
- 989 UNID. Station with light music around 1720 11/25. RIAS? No anncts. caught! Heavy het from 990. (Calkin, NE)
- +1010 URUGUAY. CX24, La Voz del Aire, Montevideo, very weak with similar programs as 650-770. Heard at 0152 11/28. (Silvera, Jamaica)
- 1025 COLOMBIA. HJER, R. Pacifico, Cali. Good level with "Radio Pacifico de Cali" ID's 11/28 at 2345. (Seaver)
- 1030 BRASIL. Cutting up XEER at 0308 11/28 but quick fade and gone by 0321. Unable to tell whether Rio de Janeiro or Pernambuco outlet. (Silvera, Jamaica)
- 1034 PORTUGAL. R. Clube Portugues at 1755 with musical programme and clear Portuguese ID and other announcements. They completely smash any chances here for Radio City! Do they ever go off the air??? (Calkin, N.B.)
- 1050 EL SALVADOR. YSU, R. 1050, San Salvador. 2330 11/30, various ID's, e.g. "Cadena YSU, Radio y Television YSU, Cadena Radial YSU," or simply "YSU". Ads for headache remedies, which would have been helpful after separating this one from CJIC and other CRM. (Wood, Ind.)
- 1055 NICARAGUA. YNLL, R. Masaya, Masaya. Also advertising pill which "alivia el dolor, 4 por 10 centavos." ID 11/30 2130, "Radio Masaya, la primera de Oriente." Bailables followed. (Wood, Ind.)

- 1060 COLOMBIA. HJFJ, Transmisoras Caldas, Manizales, under CMBU with ranchero type music ID at 0206 11/28. Weak. HJ logged #150. (Silvera, Jamaica)
- 1098.6 EL SALVADOR. YSM, R. Feminina, San Salvador. Features many U.S. records, e.g. "I Think of Love," 2008 11/29. Was announcing time 4 minutes fast ... to help housewives? (Wood, Ind.) Richard, did you hear these call letters? YSM has been listed as proposed call for 1100, but late government list reportedly shows YSRF. I'll accept YSM if announced, hill (Ed.)
- 1100 COLOMBIA. HJAT, Barranquilla/HJCN, Bogota. Two Radio Reloj's weaving in and out between 0255 and 0300 12/5, dead on channel with similar programming. HJAT dominant. Did not get specific Bogota ID. Nothing on 1103. (Callarman, Texas)
- 1115 INTL. WATERS (England). Radio 270 logged at good level on 11/27. 1730 to 1800. Plays pop music, but very little rock. Frequent ID, between every record. Also lots of commercials. Many commercials were for items being offered for sale by the station. Gave address on the air as Radio 270, Scarborough. Seems to be slightly off 1115 as slight Het noted. Het off at 1800, and I assume that it was the Italian Common Wave stations signoff. Modulation good, but distorted by the het. Quite pleased with this one and wonder if anyone knows power? (Merriman, Va.)
- PANAMA. R. Minutera, was in and out from 0125 on 11/28. Thankfully, KRLA had a talk program, and their usual splatter for 15 kcs either side with records was absent. Enough for a report. (Freeman, Calif.)
- 1125 COSTA RICA. R. Popular, San Jose, was in all evening 11/27 with baseball til 2315, then songs until 2400 s/off. Amid the songs were many IDs by slogan above, as well as another whose first noun I was unable to pin down for some reason: "... Radiofonica HE." Judging from the listed call TISRHD, it should be "Sistema ... etc." but I couldn't confirm it. (Freeman, Calif.)
- 1126 PANAMA. HJGJ, R. Provincias, Chitre. 11/29 ID: "Ocho, 40 minutos en R. Provincias," and at 2044, "Sintonizate con R. Provincias desde Chitre, Republica de Panama." Ads for refrigeradores. Separable from TISRHE-1125. (Wood, Ind.)
- 1137 INTL. WATERS (England). R. London at 1840 on 11/25, with Beatle music. Identifying as "Radio London - first with the Beatles ..." Clearly readable and best ever received despite audio splash from locals on 1150 and 1110 kHz. (Calkin, N.B.)
- 1145 UNID. S.S. Heard 11/28 at 0604. Who? (Seaver, Calif.)
- 1175 UNID. S.S. Heard 11/28 at 0610, with "hail, Mary," etc. Similar to early AM programming heard often on TICA-1195. (Seaver, Calif.) Reportedly, TICA has moved back to assigned 1175. (Ed.)
- 1187 INTL. WATERS (England). R. Caroline South with "Countdown Show" from 1730 on. Very good with hit music, ads and announcements. (Calkin, N.B.)
- 1200 BRAZIL. PRB6, Emis. Piratanga, Sao Paulo with ID and time check at 0235 11/28, strong, but under stronger Reloj Nacional. (Silvera, Jamaica)
- 1205 UNID. S.S. Noted several evenings during November around 2200. Very weak and impossible to copy. I heard this one last year, but was never able to ID. Any ideas? (Merriman, Va.)
- 1210 UNID. Two stations in Japanese noted here on 12/1. Only one heard on 11/28. Both days from 0300-0600. Most likely KZ00 and JOCR. I listened at 0400 12/1 for ID of dominant station, but nothing heard. Will keep trying. (Kaskey, Calif.)
- 1214 ALBANIA. R. Tirana now s/on 2230 with the strongest TA signal on the band. French at 2300-2330 and Greek 2330-0000. What is it after that? I can't tell here. (Conrad, Ky.)
- 1220 U.F.O. Here on 11/28, but never better than S-1 0400-0600. Didn't spend much time trying to copy, but there all a.m. (Kaskey, Calif.)
- 1232 CZECHOSLOVAKIA. Bratislava, very weak at 1717 with music program on 11/26. Not enough for a report. (Calkin)
- 1223 SWEDEN. Falun logged on 11/14 0010 to 0035. Fairly good signal and very little fade. RNE signed on at 0030 this date, but I was still able to copy Falun even after their s/on. (Merriman, Va.) Out of order, SRI. JAC
- 1277 FRANCE. Strasbourg heard momentarily at 1800 s/off 11/25 with "La Marseillaise." Good signals. (Calkin, NB)
- 1286 CZECHOSLOVAKIA. Prague is one of the most consistent and strongest TA's here. Very good at 1705 with English news and "This is Prague, Czechoslovakia," ID. English hit music from 1730-1800, and then into a Spanish transmission after inerval signal and Spanish ID. (Calkin, N.B.)
- 1295 ENGLAND. BBC European Service with tremendous signals 11/25 here with English news 1730 EST. (Calkin, N.B.)
- 1322 U.S.S.R./INTL. WATERS (England). Russian transmitter relaying Moscow European Service in English from 1716-1730. 730 saw full announcement of shortwave parallel frequencies and "Good night all from Radio Moscow." Anthem and IS heard. Either signed off on this freq. or changed direction, because from 1730 on, R. England dominated this channel with her regular diet of hit music, ads, etc. Prior to 1730, was heard only faintly under the Moscow station. British news reports say that Moscow has placed a formal protest with London re the Pirate's use of here freq. Anyone know the Russian transmitter location? (Calkin, N.B.) The Leipzig, E. Germany transmitter at one time used to carry R. Moscow foreign service, and may still do. There is a Kharkove, Ukraine station listed, but no indication via EBU that it is actually on the air. (Ed.)

- 1325 COSTA RICA. TIJG, Columbia Canal Tres, Liberia. Non-stop news noted 2045 11/29. Net rk programming. Se-
arable on loop from Caribbean-area station, probably Haiti. (Wood, Ind.)
- 1375 ST. PIERRE & MIQUELON. "Ici St. Pierre" heard from ORTF tx here at 1830 after talk in French, on local
fishing news. Daily! (Calkin, N.E.)
- 1376 AS. RUSSIA. Vladivostok broke thru about 0557, heard easily til bed at 0630, much better than stations on
1380. (Kaskey, Calif.)
- 1380 UNID. Two Oreintals here. Both topping domestics after 0545. Dominant station definitely Japanese, but at
0603, one gave forth with a time sig consisting of 5 lo pips (only). (RM very heavy though. (Kaskey, Calif)
JAPAN. JOUF, Osaka, was nicely atop all else most of the time from 0442 to 0502 11/28. Report sent. (Freeman)
- 1450 MEXICO. XEPY, Merida, Yuc. must be the XE station fading in and out with two U.S. Graveyarders at 0030 11/28.
(Silvera, Jamaica)
- 1460 JAPAN. JOUO, Nagasaki, most likely one here. S-4 signal after 0550, domestics way in the background. Man was
talking most of the time. Apparently a commercial station. Finally played some music about 0555. (Kaskey)
- 1474A DOM. REP. HIAG, R. Azul, Santiago, noted on this frequency, first on 11/15, but also heard on several other
evenings. Frequent ID as Radio Azul. Plays some US music. Fair signal but fading badly. (Merriman, Va.)
- 1475 AS. RUSSIA. Station here with time signal, a series of ascending organ notes, at 0400 11/28. Heard well
for a report, finally. Havenot bothered to take notes before. (Freeman, Calif.) Taped for a report 11/28
at 0440-0500 Kremlin chimes. (Seaver, Calif.) Caught this one at 0525 at S-3, got better later. Classical
music to 0535, then went into Chinese programming. Much better than 1470-1480 signals. (Kaskey, Calif.)
- 1484 UNID. Station here with Arabic music and anncts. (language not caught) between 0112-0130 on 11/27. Quite a
mystery here. Benghazi, Libya, perhaps? or Paris with Arabic service? Help!!! (Calkin, N.E.)
- 1502 PANAMA. HON, R. Aeropuerto, Colon. Settled here, at least for the time being. (Silvera, Jamaica)
- 1520 GUATEMALA. TGDY, R. Centro Americana, Guatemala. Noted briefly 0517-0520 12/5; just long enough to recognize
I can knock hem off some MM. (Callarman, Texas)
- 1550 AS. RUSSIA. new and very powerful transmitter was heard on this channel completely covering CBE and con-
siderably stronger than even the 1475 channel. Heard 11/28 0517-0602 and at tune out was still the best
single signal on the freq. although the mass of eastern s/ons was cutting it up. A long drama in Russian
lasted until nearly 0600. Time signal was six short pips. (Freeman, Calif.)
UNID. F.O. Heard here 11/28 at 0510-0540, likely Chinese, bothered by TT the whole period, and an ABC ID at
0530 wa heard. (Seaver, Calif.) Six short pips? Could it be another Peking transmitter to Asiatic Russia,
per 1120? (Ed.)
- 1586 W. GERMANY. WDR, Langenburg, very good signals at 0105 11/28. Male announcer. Taped for report. Best TA
so far. (Silvera, Jamaica) Noted almost every evening with very good signals. This one should be a clinch
for anyone needing W. Germany. Logged on 11/27 2140-2215, 100% readable with very little fade. (Merriman)
U.F.O., presumably. Could get only het here 11/25 at 0501. Maybe the USSR station heard in past seasons.
(Seaver, Calif.)
- 1602 W. GERMANY. Bayerischer Rundfunk synchronized netwrok heard here around 2300. Clear signals and ID in German
with light music programme. What is the situati n here? They are not listed for transmissions at this time.
Particularly on a Sunday morning on which it was heard? (11/24) (alkin, N.E.) 11/27? (Ed.)
