A bunch of questions to be answered this issue. Mike Northam: "What is the NRC's position on studio vs. XR location?" ANSWER: No official position, but studio locations count for the Contests. "Do you have a preferred method for reporting to Contest #4?" ANSWER: No. "Is it necessary to send a complete list each time?" ANSWER: no, just the additions. "I suppose the additional three points per Special goes only for NRC Specials & not IRCA, NNRC, or others." ANSWER: Yes, as I've said before, ONLY NRC Specials count for bonus points. From Geoff Trower: "Will stations heard on r/cs count an extra three points if the transmission is NOT specifically for the NRC? I think the answer is NO, hi. ANSWER: You're right, hi. Randy Kane asks: "Can I count the correct number of points for a Special I do not report? For instance, I heard & logged KEEN-DX but couldn't get copy for a report. Can I count it as my second Cal. without the extra points for a Special? ANSWER: Yes, but KEEN wasn't an NRC DX, hi. "Can I count WWVI-TEST for its correct points until the verie arrives & then add the extra points when it does? ANSWER: Yes. Joe Kureth asks: "Are stations logged before 10/1 good for points? ANSWER: If you mean can they be relogged, yes. But they can be relogged or logged on.y after 10/1. Wayne Coombs: On the requirement for updating each month, do you go by the postmark date or date you receive it? ANSWER: I haven't stuck to Rule #8 so far but after 1/1 I will. I'll inform a contestant if a month by w/no entries. Then if nothing in two weeks, I'll put notice in Contest News. If nothing for another week, he'll be dropped. Even if there is no change in your totals tell me anyway. This rule was put in to preclude a contestant waiting until the last week of the Contests to send in his first entry of 300 points or so. -Steve Weinstein

The only new catch since has been XERW-810 Tampico 6:30pm 12/18. Other veries are Barbados, KXOW & KEEN for TESTs, KAWA KGBS WIRC. DXers, as we were happy Houston was to be the future HQ at almost equal, fair distances from the EC, WC, & Mo., Houston being nearer the middle of the country than Pa. but no doubt many members will be happy w/the Boston location as quite a few seem to be concentrated in the upper EC section. Almost all DX NEWS issues have been arriving here on Monday from Kittanning via third class, the 12/17 issue got here Wed. Correspondence is welcome here, even though I have enough pen pals to lose track of whether I owe them letters or had written them last, hi. DX conditions have continued to be generally poor here in the Northeast during the past week. While some of the high-powered North Africans have been good at times, there has been a consistent pattern of signal deterioration with increasing path latitudes: Iberia, fairly good; England & Germany, poor; Scandinavia & deep Asia, nonexistent. LA reception was outstanding on 12/29. We would suggest concentrating on stations in the Caribbean, and on those Africans usually blocked by the common Europeans.

A rather intriguing little problem has been raised by the recent PAL listing for KMSA, 15 watts, at the McMurdo Sound Base in ANTARCTIA. Would you believe that no one has VAC? Or, ...?

"Recent letter and large brown envelope of info from R. 390 (mailed before they lost their appeal) tells that there is (or was) also a Radio 390 NORTH operating from a ship off the NW coast of England. Very little info given except that it is off the Wirral Peninsula and has added 17,000,000 listeners to those of R. 390 south operating from the fort in Red Sands. Does any one know for certain if this NORTH station was ever on the air? I don't think that it ever was, otherwise the prosecution of the fort station (that was all that entered into the case) would have not shut down the station altogether, and it did as I have read in the clippings from the London papers. This was probably put together in the hope of an impending expansion just before the trial. If so, this may mean that Radio 390 will be back on the air again from the ship."

Beacon stations on the MW band are a little known breed. While this class of stns is not within the purview of IDX, strictly speaking, they are nevertheless of sufficiently general interest to deserve listing. These stations exist for purposes of navigation and fall into two distinct groups: (a) those stns which transmit only in CW and serve only beacon function, and (b) those few ordinary European and Russian broadcast stations which serve as navigational aids by transmitting CW when not carrying regular programming. These stns transmit their identifying letters over and over in very slow morse code continuously. The following list of beacon stns of interest to BCB DX'ers is a small segment of the much larger list (covering 510-1795 kcs) which appeared in the July, 1966 issue of S9 Magazine. Your editor once attempted to compile such a list and can testify how difficult this info is to obtain; we applaud the DX scholarship of the unknown S9 author!

- 1035 Haiti. 4VEC, Cap Haitien weak at 1800 but signal improved on 12/17. (LaRoche)
- 1060 Colombia. HJAZ, R. Vegia, Monteria slogan change from Emiss. Sinu to conform w/ HJAC-1249 in Barranquilla and HJAD-1329 in Cartagena, same network. (Silvera, Jamaica.)
- 1080 Venezuela. YVQJ, Barcelona, mx and Coca Cola ads 1930 on 12/17. (LaRoche, Pa.)
- 1097.120 Spain. EFE14, L.V. Madrid was apparently the Madrid stn w/ OC at 2200 on 1/1 while demonstrating equipment to JAC. Last EBU freq check had this one on 1097.133 so they're coming slowly back into line. (Ed)
- 1115 Panama. HOM21, Panama, R. Minutera is the info here per latest official lists. 1000 watts. (Gleason, Ecuador, IRCA)
- 1145 Panama. HOE49, Panama, R. Universal was noted here from 1140 on 11/13 at 2000 w/ mx. Said // 880 in Colon (HOB51). ID'ed as R. Universal instead of Cadena Universal. These two, as well as 720 and 1330 are part of the Cadena Republicana. (Gleason, Ecuador, IRCA)
- 1187 International Waters. R. Caroline South excellent at 2000 w/ ID and news. Also Xmas and hit parade mx. By far the best pirate yet and announces as 259 meters but this is not correct. In point of fact, 259 is now being used for tests by Caroline North who is contemplating a move from 1520. (Calkin, NB)
- 1210 Japan. JOOR, Osaka gave clear JOOR call at 0300 on 12/5 over KZ00. The rest of the ID was unclear. (Scrimgeour, Calif.)
- Cuba. CMHK, Reloj Nacional S7 signal 0245 on 12/12; alone but quick fades. (Hoogerheide, Ore.)
- 1214 Albania. Very strong at s/on 2230 on 1/1 at a time when most other TA's were quite inaudible. Must be some xmitter. (Ed)
- 1220 Cuba. Understand the SS hrd on the WC during the KZYM-DX was a Cuban; who & what's the call? (Hoogerheide, Ore.) All I can find is a low powered relay at Perico, no call given. (Ed)
- \*\*\*1322 International Waters. R. Dolfijn is now operating here. Hrd very good daily at about 0130. Good even past 0200. This stn is the former R. England, now gone Dutch probably due to impending Marine Radio Bill in Britain. Gives address in Amsterdam and signals do not seem to be quite as good as R. England's used to be. Probably shifted xmitting direction to give better coverage of Holland. Plans call for a move of the ship to be anchored off Holland. Britain Radio/845 still in EE. Reported. Stn name means Dolphin. (Calkin, N.B.)
- 1330 Chile. C7133, Temuco is a new one, R. Imperial. QTH is Casilla 730 and v/s is Luis E. Rodriguez. (Godwin, Calif. IRCA)
- 1358 E. Germany. Berliner Welle w/ classical mx pgm here at 0100 on 12/26. Fair signal, and separable from 1360 w/ only slight difficulty. (Calkin, N.B.)
- 1376 France. Lille I clear w/ nx in FF followed by talk from 0100-0125 on 12/24. Strong and clear. (Calkin, N.B.)
- 1380 Venezuela. R. Horizonté, location unknown, new stn testing since 12/12. Believe in N.E. section of Venezuela. (Silvera, Jamaica)
- 1403 France. Synchro network here very strong for such a net on 12/24 w/ FF nx at 0100. Any of these gained power lately? Corsica perhaps? Hi hi. (Calkin, NB) Latest EBU still shows the strongest stn to be 20 kw on this channel. But the total power on 1403 totals 114 kw; always good here. (Ed)
- 1421 W. Germany. Saarländischer Rundfunk, also known as R. Saarbrücken just barely separable from 1420 collection of US stns 12/23 0000-0100 w/ GG pgm of light music. News at 0100. Very welcome here and reported. (Calkin, N.B.)



- 1439 Luxembourg. Separable and strong 0000 - 0050 with musical pgm, but severe het from 1440. Hrd daily. (Calkin, N.B.)
- 1475 Austria. Wein I w/ carrier at 2315, IS at 2325 and ID in GG and s/on at 2330 daily. Good signal here in New Brunswick. (Calkin, N.B.)
- 1515 Colombia. HJLQ, whopping signal 0430 on 12/12. (Hoogerheide, Oro.) Music & commercials on 12/17 at 1845. (LaRoche, Pa.)
- 1550 Australia. 4QD, Emerald, Qsld good signal on 12/5 at 0413 during usual ABC news. (Scrimgeour, Calif.)
- 1560 Dominican Republic. R. El Mundo was testing some days ago (as of Dec. 11) but is not being hrd now. (Objio, Dominican Republic)
- 1580 Japan. FEN, Iwakuni. Network ID hrd at end of news 0415 on 12/5, through fairly heavy noise. Decent signal strength, though. (Scrimgeour, Calif.)

- ENGLAND. BBC Light Pgm confirmed w/ card and personal letter from H.R. Hatch, assistant to the CE. (Calkin, N.B.)
- 1322 USSR?. Moscow sent a QSL card, post card, and pgm sked for all daily pgms, including SWEC. Did not tell the location of the xmtr on 1322 which I hrd, so have written again asking. Perhaps Leipzig? This same stn was very strong when I was in E. Germany last summer. Anyone know for sure? Lists EE xmission to England 1700-1730. Perhaps xmmitter in Ukraine? Help. (Calkin, N.B.) Latest EBU shows 150 kw Leipzig-Wiederau on 1322 as carrying only USSR relays. EBU also lists 100 kw Kharkov, Ukraine but it hasn't been hrd for some time. FBIS lists the Leipzig stn w/ USSR relays operated by the Soviet military; also an unidentified USSR stn. It would seem that what you've hrd is Leipzig. (Ed)
