REPORTEDLY IN OPERATION...

CYPRUS. The BBC East Mediterranean Relay on Cyprus was recently logged and definitely identified in Europe on a previously unreported channel of 1232 kHz. **Noted under Tangier at 2300 GMT one night and in the clear at 2100 another; in Arabic.** Any more information available? (Arctic)

ABU DHABI. Abu Dhabi Radio is currently operating on 809 kHz with the following schedule: 0230-0450, 1200-1950. (Editor)

TRUCIAL AMIRATE OF SHARJA. Regarding our recent query for further information on the exact location of this station which operates on 737 and 1250 kHz and gives an address in Dubai, Don Jensen sends along the following information taken from a recent letter from the engineer in charge. The station, Saut as Sahil, the Voice of the Coast, is operated by the British Government and was started to provide a local information service at a time when there was no local radio in the Trucial States. **The MW outlets are 10 kw Marconi transmitters operating in parallel and, while the transmitter is located in Abu Dhabi (coordinates 25.21.30N, 55.23E), the administrative offices and mailing address are in Dhuhai about 22 miles away. Later this year the present transmitters will be moved to Dubai, however, and a new 50 kw Continental MW transmitter will be added. So much for the great Sharja/Dubai mystery...**

AZORES. Em. Club Asas do Atlantico was recently noted in Finland signing off at 2300 GMT on about 1500 kHz. (ARC)

KENYA. The Voice of Kenya is currently heard in Sweden testing on 953 with what appears to be a new transmitter. Not too much hope for North America, though, since these Kenya outlets usually are directional N-S. (Arctic)

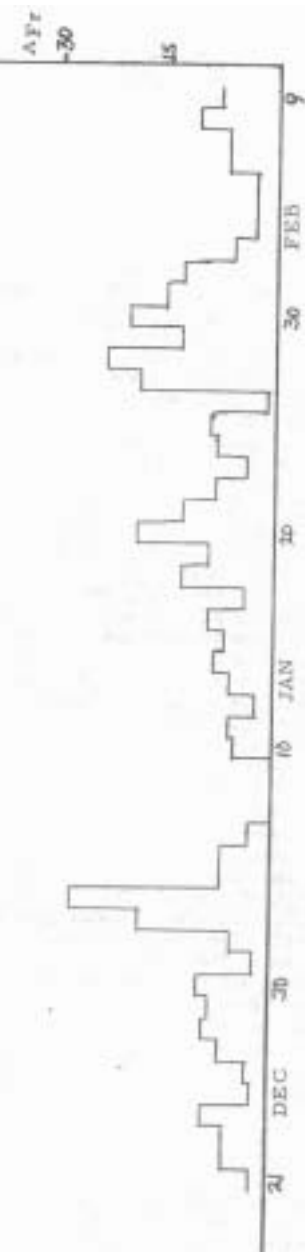
INTERNATIONAL WATERS...

BELGIUM/NETHERLANDS. Radio Nordsee International has returned to the air once again and is being heard in Sweden with much stronger signals than before on 1367 kHz. **On January 7th the MEBO II was moved to their new location about 5 miles off the coast of Belgium off Cadsand. If you haven't managed to snag Nordsee before, better go after them quickly; this may be their last stand... (or is it float?). (Bengt Ericson, Sweden)**

PROPOSED OPERATIONS...

Radio Mashed, IRAN, to go to 400 kW on 725 kHz... **ZAMBIA** is still awaiting delivery of the three high powered MW transmitters promised long ago by Red China... Deutsche Welle is going ahead with construction of their new 600 kW station on **MALTA...** (Editor)

This graph shows the daily values of A_{pr} , the Fredericksburg index of geomagnetic/auroral disturbances in the Earth's magnetic field. High values of A_{pr} occur during a heavy influx of electrically charged particles into the upper atmosphere as the result of certain types of solar disturbances. The median wave signal absorption produced by one of these events is strongest in high latitudes and persists for some days following the initial particle influx. Values of A_{pr} above about 20 are tentatively associated with high levels of absorption along high-latitude TA and TP signal paths. Very high values (above about 40) are usually accompanied by E-layer blanketing over North America and Europe; on such a night stations from the South will appear to dominate most of America. Long periods of low geomagnetic/auroral activity are necessary but not sufficient to guarantee adversely mass what would otherwise be periods of excellent reception on high latitude paths during periods of continued low geomagnetic/auroral activity.

In Suriname, the lingo is "talkie-talkie", roughly a mixture of English and Dutch. PJB-800 does not carry any Papiamentu but concentrates on Spanish, Portuguese, English and Dutch, in that order of use. PJD2 carries English only. English is the normal language of St. Martin. PJC2 on 855 does not have similar pgms to PJB. "Curcm" is mostly Dutch with some Spanish. Anything similar to PJB would be PJA6 on 925 which is mostly English. For Papiamentu, try to hear PJB2 on 1385, if you can get past 4VS." ---Ron Schatz.

Underground Radio In Kuibishev

MOSCOW.—Unlicensed "pirate" radio stations, somewhat on the model of the British Radio Caroline, have been springing up throughout the Soviet Union, broadcasting Western rock and roll music and "politically inspired gossip and decadent title-tattle." An official crack-down is said to be meeting with a degree of open opposition.

"Radio hooliganism," as pirate radio is officially called, stems from an educational handbook on do-it-yourself radio building issued in the middle Sixties. The hobby was soon taken up in earnest. Recently in one industrial area 115 illegal broadcasts were recorded in a five-hour period.

As with Radio Caroline, one official complaint is that the unlicensed transmitters interfere with emergency communications. A newspaper in the Volga region, for instance, reported a case where pirate broadcasts interfered with an airstrip's control tower wavelength and prevented the talking down of a crippled plane. Another paper declared, "The wanton sons of the ether are stifling the State's radio communication lines."

Some stations are criticized for their political commentary. Radio Camomile, run by a young girl, is said to have peddled "full-blooded reactionary ruminations" in the area of Kuibishev. But Lyevstik reports that it received a number of dissenting letters when it ran an article attacking the pirates.

Town goes on the air in N.W.T.

600 KHZ

TUKTOYAKTUK, N. W. T.
(CP) — Radio-Tuktoyaktuk went on the air Wednesday night for the first time, broadcasting in Eskimo and English to the 600 residents of the remote community on the Arctic Ocean.

The station carried no advertising—although an official said they would be glad to get some—but plans to carry news broadcasts, local messages and information, Eskimo stories and music.

The first four-hour broadcast from the 1,000-watt station consisted of messages of congratulations from officials and other residents of the hamlet 1,385 miles north of Edmonton. Included was a taped message from William Dennison, Mayor of Toronto.

The station was set up under a "twinning" arrangement with CHUM radio in Toronto. CHUM agreed to cover the costs of establishment and provide up to \$10,000 a year for operating.

The station's initial staff consists of two announcers, Radio specialists from the nearby DEW line station have agreed to look after the transmitter and other technical aspects of the operation.

The station's call letters are CFCT. The organizers hope that its signal will extend for 100 miles or at least to Inuvik, 65 miles away, which has population of about 3,000.

A 100-mile range would also reach the 600 persons in Aklavik.

All three communities are situated on or near the Mackenzie River delta.

The station cost about \$25,000 and overcame a number of difficulties.

PAUL K. HART - 2105 Muse - Fort Worth, Texas - 76112
CX here have been unbelievably poor ever since last weekend 1/24. SSS is non-existent, & at night regulars KNX-1070 & WCCO-830 are non-existent. They both run S-6 under normal (not good) CX. WBBM-780 normally S-9 plus 30 is runnin S 5-7 w/many fades completely into the mud. Here I am all fired up to go, & I can't hear anything out of my own backyard. Only things of interest, KXLF-1370 copied @ s/off 1/26 @ 2am. In order to copy anything on 1370, I have to null KXOL-1360 & then WSPD usually dominates.
