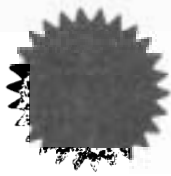

I have a little DX to report. CX have tapered off & DXing has not been very exciting recently. Nor have the veries. On several mornings I have started out DXing very keenly but threw in the towel at lam. New loggings are: 12/11- WJDM-1530 @ SSS 4:24-4:29pm, then WCOU-1240 at midnight. 12/13- WISS-1090. fair on TEST from 2:37-2:55; unnn CJON-930 was on top the channel @ 2:30-3:01 but I couldn't hear its satellites CJOX-710 nor CJCN-680; unnn WLOB-1310 AN atop the channel @ 3:05. 12/27- WGOE-1590 r/c-TT 12:45-12:59; unnn 4VEC-830 poor u/WCCO w/DX & another report sent to them; there were traces of KAYQ-1190 around 1:16-1:24 but not enough to say for sure. 1/8- WICK-1400 briefly @ 12:52am. New veries are CJON-710 WISS-1090 WJDM-1530. I was most pleased to receive an answer from CJOX-710. It was my sixth request for a verie & they finally came through. They have a new manager, who mentioned he is new on the job. They have one standa rd v/q which they use for CJON CJOX CJCN. Reports should be sent to CJON. I can hear the AN FFC on 1230 which everyone else is getting, but they never seem to ID. I would suspect CJSA because there are a lot of AN ski parties in Ste. Agathe at this time of year. (IRCA says it's CHVD, Dolbeau, Andy - ERC) During the above period I heard traces of WQVA-1240 WKIX-1350 & WCTR-1530. All those would be new loggings if I ever could copy program detail enough to send out a report. KNX-1070 has been audible here very often after CBA's s/off; that is the first consistant Cal. reception here in a long time. At night, pest CKRS-1240 has been less dominant than in prior years & I may be able to log something through them. Maybe nearby WNEZ-1240 will finally squeak through them in the daytime. 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heard. Bad news - KABC-790, L.A., now NSP. Second surprise, KATA-1340 Arcata, Cal. testing & requesting reports from 4:54 to 5:13. The second 1580k station was KLOU, Lake Charles, La. with Markets at 6:05 & ID @ 6:10. Last was KAMX-1520, Albuquerque, N.M. @ 6:48, SS. On 1/12 I received 73 of the new NRC Report Forms, & on 1/13, 150. Of the three reports typed this morning, double spaced, of course, two had to be completed on the back. Actual delivery date varies from Saturday to Tuesday or Wednesday depending upon distance, the P.O., etc. If you hit Ernie's deadline right when we're running weekly the turnaround should be about a week and a half; certainly no more than two weeks unless the PO has it in for you.  - 680 Mexico. Re my unID of 1/8 IDXD, here IDs are as follows (translation confirmed by PT) "Ondas del seiscientos (you meant "seiscientos"?-ed) setenta (setenta = 70, tho-ed), D-B followed by a whistle pitched thusly: F (an octave above middle C) - D - B^b, F - D - B^b and notes were descending, i.e. a downward sequence of 3 notes repeated twice). Then a few moments later an ID: "En las ondas del seiscientos setenta, es la MUSICA (accented with heavy emphasis) D-B" and this with much reverb, as well as much enthusiasm. Mentions of Santa Cala, Extrema California, too. Help. (Edmunds, NJ)
 - 730 Guatemala. TGN s/off in Spanish, probably late for holidays 0828 12/27(WGH)
 - 760 Colombia. unID, "Radio Cadena Nacional" noted here AN under Reloj Nacional, HJAJ used to carry RCN, but RNC Zambrano is supposed to be here. What gives? (Schatz, Miami FL)
 - 840 Colombia. HJBI hrd 12/23 at 0359 with anmts for HJBI and HKBI (FM outlet) and with nice signals, from Wrightwood QTH. (Finkle, Cal.--+also, 844 item)
 - 844 G.E.I.C. Tarawa hrd 1/3 at 0740 to 0753 with pgm of native mx. Sigs poor.
 - 1030 Cuba. Cadena Agramonte, Camaguey hrd with instr mx till 0458 on 1/8 when s/off with Cuban NA. For those interested, Castro has named 1972 as "Año de la Evolución Socialista". (Objio, D.R.)
 - 1034 Estonia. Finally Tallinn hrd here o/u Porto 0630 1/10. (Edmunds)
 - 1088 Nigeria. Lagos has to be the one here under BBC with much drumming, African mx, male voices in "chorus" 0605 1/10. (Edmunds)
 - 1116 Panama. "La Montunita" stn hrd several times late at night with this ID.1/8 at 0531 they also mentioned telephone no 25 67 63 just in case anybody wishes to call. As to my knowledge, "Montuno" is a lively part of a popular Latin dance mx, it changes in tempo from a slow to a faster tune. So I think that "Montunita" must be 'a small one'. An example of this would be Radio Guarachita; guaracha is a popular Cuban dance tune. (Objio, D.R.)
 - 1241 France. Common wave hrd here 0615 1/9 and quite strong against 1240 domestics. (Edmunds, NJ)
 - 1270 Chile. Radio Sociedad Nacional de Minería, Viña del Mar with ID hrd very clear at 0500 on 1/10 when s/off, after that the signal was cut very suddenly after the anmt. This was hrd for the first time. (Objio, Dom. Rep.)
 - 1286 Senegal. French atop here, looping 95° and quite possibly // 1502, for Dakar with French female vocals, slow 0626 1/10. (Edmunds, NJ)
 - 1295 USSR? Hrd opera and typical Mayak male-female ancrs, though well past E20 time for Baku, under BBC here 0600 1/9 (Edmunds, NJ) (also 1304 item)
 - 1304 Algeria. Oran/Constantine here with Arabic "music" and chantings, was under Poland earlier, then pretty much alone though quite weak later 0605 1/9/72.
 - 1398 Nigeria. Ibadan hrd with strange squeaking, warbling "music" and a deep-voiced male ancr with a harsh sounding lang sounding not unlike that on that "Olatunji - Drums of Passion" album that was "in" a few years back. Looped appx 95° so really little else it could be. 0545 1/9. (Edmunds, NJ)

- 1376 Asiatic RSFSR. Vladivostok hrd 12/29 at 1135 to 1217 tuneout. When tuned in, had a 5-minute dissertation in Russian on the music being played (was classical orchestral). At 1200 had a newscast with man and woman in Russian. At 1215 gave anmt as "govorit vladivostok" and folo with more cl mx. Had good s-6 to 9 signals and made a nice tape. Hope they QSL. (Finkle, CA)
- 1394 unID. Female vocal, quite similar to that noted on 1578 item, definitely in the African genre and looping about 95 - 100° 0535-0545 1/9. Perhaps Togo but was too weak under Tirana to tell. (Edmunds, NJ)
- 1412 Spain. A monumental echo from multiple carriers and audios of Spanish common wave, EAK-variety with light MoR 1/9 0713. (Edmunds, NJ)
- ** 1424 Colombia. Manizales, "Radio Reloj" here from 1422 and still is AN. (Schatz)

- 1502 Senegal. Hrd French atop, looping 95°, in a long-winded commentary well atop the Spanish common wave 0618 1/10. (Tambacounda) (Edmunds, NJ)

- 1578 Ivory Coast. Abidjan hrd here 1/9 with 750 Hz tone 0655-0700, OC 0700 to 0705 then a brief s/on anmt by deep male voice in French, then an IS or part of an anthem, then female vocal about 20% closer to mx than an Arabic chant for country 86. (Edmunds, NJ) (also 1594 items)
