680 WNZK MI Westland-Dearborn Heights: night operation on this frequency has begun, daytime operation remains on 690 kHz.
820 *New NC Paw Creek: new station grant mentioned above will replace CP for WMPF-820 Charlotte, NC which was never built and subsequently cancelled.
840 *App CA Marina: application for new station filed in competition with the grant for new KRKL-840 in Yountville, CA has been DENIED giving the green light for KRKL to begin construction.
870 WPRQ TN Colonial Heights: silent station is back ON THE AIR with BRN format

910 WORD SC Spartanburg: silent station is back ON THE AIR with relay of WFBC-1330 Greenville, SC.
920 WMEL FL Melbourne: station is SILENT
1040 KCBR CO Monument: station is SILENT
1060 KFNA TX El Paso: silent station has been sold, may return
1190 KYII TX Dallas: new station has taken over this vacated frequency with news format as KLIF goes to 570
1270 KPBA AR Pine Bluff: silent station is being sold and is expected to return to the air
1400 WWXX GA Alpharetta: boy, were we fed some bogus info on this station. Previous reports that they had surrendered their license after failing to find a buyer were obviously WRONG as this silent station is back ON THE AIR relaying WRAF (FM) Toccoa Falls
1490 WDXB TN Chattanooga: station is SILENT
1500 KRCK CA Burbank: the target date for this often delayed new station is now being given as summer 1991
1530 WTME ME Auburn: station is SILENT
1550 WOCC IN Corydon: silent as WGBB, is back ON THE AIR
1570 WOKG OH Warren: station is back ON THE AIR following a short silent period during ownership change, is presently simulcasting WNRB-1540 Niles daytime and sports at night. We assume they will drop the simulcast once they have their studios built since there is no real advantage to this relay, they have nearly identical coverage and are right next to each other both on the dial and geographically. We'd expect the change to WAZP to take place when they begin regular programming.

■ **HOT STUFF!!!** Perry Crabill reports hearing a news broadcast from CHOW-1470, Welland, ON at 2200 on December 5th. The report went something like... *This is Sims(?) Broadcast News. The president of the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation has announced that \$108 million will be slashed from the Corporation's budget. Eleven hundred jobs will be axed. These are the largest budget cuts and layoffs in CBC's history. Three CBC stations are being closed; eight others are being downsized. In many provinces, local news broadcasts are being eliminated and will be replaced by one regional newscast for the province. The identity of the closed and downsized stations was not given...but I'm sure we'll hear from one or more of our Canadian reporters with more details. Thanks to Perry, you read it here first!*

■ **DX Don Trelford** writes to say he has noted several reports lately saying they heard CIAO and CHIN broadcasting in FF. Well...not so, says he. They both specialize in Italian programming as are owned by Italian-Canadians. In fact, CHIN is owned by Johnny Lombardi, and is operated over an Italian supermarket right in the heart of Little Italy. Mama Mia!

■ Now that the "Official NRC Abbreviation List" has hit print (see Issue 9), everyone PLEASE limit your abbreviations to those in the list. Example: Commercials are "ads", not "spots". Spots are something on your living room carpet. Or Dalmatians. Or things before your eyes. And on and on.

■ Welcome aboard, new reporter Bob Straube of Palmyra, Nebraska who debuts this issue with a plea for help on an unID as well as a solid report on a CPC-sponsored DX Test.

Just imagine, if you will...Paul Harvey...reading the news...to himself.

640 **WBMX MI ZEBELAND** - 11/17 1448 noted with **Kenny Loggins** mx, also UC rap mx, ex:C&W; if you're just on to keep the license, play heavy metal so I can get some enjoyment out of it, hi; 1330-WKTA no longer does, so I'm having withdrawal symptoms (WPF-IN) [Stay tuned, there's more. -Ed.]

WBMX MI ZEBELAND - 12/2 article in today's newspaper says their transmitter was hit by lightning in September, causing the silent period of over a month; they now have live DJs and a NOS/EZL format; also carries *News 8* at 1800 from WOTV, channel 8 in Grand Rapids (PLB-MI) [But wait...here's an even later update... -Ed.]

WBMX MI ZEBELAND - 12/9 newspaper article says they went silent (again) on 12/5 when equipment was repossessed due to debts; they've lost their studio building, too; **WBMX is SILENT**, perhaps for good (PLB-MI)

680 &

690 **WNZK MI DEARBORN HEIGHTS** - bi-frequency operation went into effect 11/29; operates 24 hrs/day as follows: LSR - LSS on 690 and LSS - LSR on 680; change from Westland to Dearborn Heights took effect same day; so far, when they change frequencies they simply make the switch with no advance warning; legal ID: *WNZK Dearborn Heights - Detroit broadcasting on 690 days, 680 nights to serve more even better [with a new excitement in radio]*, the part in brackets is optional; I note no difference in signal strength when they switch from one frequency to the other, so 680 is now a lost cause here; along with CHYR-710/730 this makes two of these insipid split-frequency operations in North America and they're both local; I guess the FCC wanted to prove that the CRTS doesn't have a monopoly on stupidity (REH-ON)

730 **KKDA TX GRAND PRAIRIE** - is U2 and 500 watts at night, per verie (MH-NE)

760 **WJR MI DETROIT** - 11/30 0100 noted OFF THE AIR, nothing but SS stuff heard in its absence; is this a fluke, or does this much-hated pest now have a regular SP? as this was a Friday morning, I doubt it (RF-OH)

790 **WMRZ FL SOUTH MIAMI** - 11/29 1848 with **Al Martino's I Love You More and More Every Day** followed by **WMRZ** call ID drop-in and then *I Want To Be Wanted* by

Brenda Lee; also hrd slogan: *More great songs and wonderful memories on WMRZ. All memories all the time*; looks like the "Great Space Bird" has carried off another station; ex:WNWS & NWS/TLK (REH-ON)

820 **WPNT IL CHICAGO** - 11/18 1348 noted with singing non-ID *100 point 3, The Point, AC/CHR* mx; Sun-Times says this happened 11/15, noted 11/20 @ 0400 with new call; simulcast with 100.3 FM obviously; ex:WXEZ & EZL (WPF-IN)

WPNT IL CHICAGO - non-IDs as *The Point*; ex:WXEZ; format a cross between CHR & AC; 100% simulcast of 100.3 FM (RK-IL)

WPNT IL CHICAGO - is now simulcasting **WPNT-FM**; ex:WXEZ (RD-IA3)

WPNT IL CHICAGO - 11/27 1820 fair with UC/CHR | 100.3 FM; new CLs and format (DS-TN)

Editors Note...this is the LAST issue WPNT's change of format will be listed in "Special". Promise.

1060 **WPMX MS TUPELO** - 11/27 1920 on PSSA with UC format and *Power Mix 1060* non-ID; after *Me and Mrs. Jones* by **Billy Paul** had *The WPMX weather forecast for Tupelo and vicinity* followed by slogan *Tupelo's all new Power Mix 1060. Your favorites first, all from compact disc*; no sign of KYW; ex:WCFB & REL (REH-ON)

WPMX MS TUPELO - 11/28 1959 ID: *Your new power station, WPMX 1060, UC format*; very weak (MH-NE)

1160 **WAMB TN DONELSON** - 11/28 1822 w/NOS | FM, or FM is | to AM; gives AM IDs only, no mention of 106.7 while I was listening; no hint of Cuban QRM (DS-TN)

1240 **WEDC IL CHICAGO** - 11/23 noted off the air from 1716 to WCRW's sign-on at 1800, probably due to the fact they didn't sell the airtime or tape of scheduled program didn't come in; back on RS at 2000 (RK-IL)

WKDA TN NASHVILLE - 11/28 now CNN *Headline News* | the cable channel (DS-TN)

1310 **WIBA WI MADISON** - re: issue 30 logging & **Wendell Ford's** note...WIBA is definitely not all news. They are, however, darn close, with just a few AC songs aired, mostly late at night. Format is pretty similar to WGN (DS-WI) [See, sooner or later we answer all the questions -Ed.]

1330 **WYWR OH CAMPBELL** - 11/25 1650 with call-in show on PCs and software; after BRN disclaimer had 1700 ID: *We are ??? WYWR Campbell, Youngstown and Warren - BRN N;* lost at 1702 pattern change; was mostly under semi-local pest WELW; is not Youngstown now U2 5000 as in Log; is licensed to Campbell and I believe power is U4 500 1000 (REH-ON) [Maybe we can get a reading on this from Buffalo K. Foonman?-Ed.]

1400 **WINC VA WINCHESTER** - recent QSL states they simulcast their FM station, WINK, and only ID as **WINC** on the top of the hour and say that only 3% of their audience listens on AM (DT-ON)

1430 **WFXX IN INDIANAPOLIS** - 12/5 with new CLs & now simulcasting with sister FM *The Fox 103 FM*, meaning acid rock; they also carry *Indiana University BKB*; Log changing time again (DLH-IN)

1520 **WTCV KY GREENUP** - 11/29 1805 ending REL song with quickie sign-off: *This is the Christian Voice. WTCV, 1520-AM, Greenup - Portsmouth - Ashland*; unbr but noted Log still shows this as WLGC even tho has been WTCV for over a year (REH-ON) [I always thought *Greenup* was some kinda lawn application?? -Ed.]

1530 **WYGR MI WYOMING** - carries *Daynet* as well as Sun Network talk; schedule is now LSR - LSS (x-1000-1700) (PLB-MI)

EXTD OK WAGONER - do not wait your stamps by sending [reports] to address in Log; mine was returned with *No Forwarding Address Left*; try sending to WWLS-640, with whom they are | (MH-NE)

1580 **WVKO OH COLUMBUS** - re: report in Vol 58, Issue 6...QSL states the operator put on daytime power 1 hour too early that date (10/13); says day power is 1kw, nites is 250 watts, sted Log (1kw/1kw) (DT-ON)

UNIDS AND UNID HELP (or, Give and Take)

560 **UNID ??** - 11/22 2215 unknown REL talk station; very weak behind WIND, lost at 2220; Who's this? (FY-MI)

610 **UNID QC** - 12/3 0230+ good, mostly atop with FF stuff; no ID or city mentioned, although Quebec mentioned several times; I assume this was CHNC as Log sez CFLO not 24 hrs; Anyone know which one this was? (RF-ON)

- 800 UNID ?? - 11/26 0200-0340 Who carries the Larry King Show? has been hrd here for more than a year (KG-PA)
- 900 UNID ?? - 11/25 0601 from out of nowhere (probably power-up from nite to PSRA power) with CBN N_x 'til 0605 then - Gospel Hymn Time with southern-accented anncr; TC at 0611 indicated a live show rather than transcription; eventually lost to CHML and WILC; even tho this was a Sunday, CBN N_x suggests a fulltime GOS/REL format (REH-ON)
- 950 UNID ?? - 11/26 1720-1800 Who carried the Stan Hoffman REL pgn from WWGM-1560, complete with WWGM anncs and Sandy from WWGM inviting listeners to tune in to future programs? Looped toward the SW (KG-PA)
- 960 UNID ?? - 12/4 0107 o/u WFIR w/ad for Turbo Gasoline Stores...look for Turbo Gasoline Stores in...?., Red Bank (?), ...?., and all Turbo Guaranteed locations in western ...?.; 0108 anncr Ron Casing live thru ...?., this is Satellite Radio Network, then - Game of the Night from Winnipeg; lost to WFIR at 0110; DF seemed from NW; CFAC?? (RF-OH)
- 990 UNID ?? - 12/3 1836 strong with OLD and AOR; 100% fade at :36; did anyone else hear this one? (MH-NE)
- 1020 CKVH AB HIGH PRAIRIE - is Shawn Axelrod's unID of 11/5 (Issue 9); per SO BYB, they are U1 1000 400 and I CPOK-1370, but also has some local programming; add to your Log (REH-ON)
- 1030 UNID ?? - 11/23 0420 way under WBZ with The Larry King Show; no ID at half-hour break and gone by 0500; only LK listed in Log [on 1030] is WOSO-PR; any other possibilities here? (REH-ON)
- 1130 UNID ?? - 11/28 0208 very good signal with UC mx, B-96 mentioned many times; I monitored for over 30 minutes as was ruling the frequency over WNEW/KWKH (BP-NC)
- 1170 UNID ?? - 11/15 1824 fair under KVOO with 4:24 TC (which should be MST) and chatter by male DJ - C&W tune; the Log sez CKGY fits this description like a glove; can anyone confirm? (RD-IA1)
- 1210 UNID ?? - 12/8 0715 sign-on with two rooster crows (MH-NE)
- 1220 UNID ?? - 12/4 2223-2225 with Neil Myers on Talknet - Discover Card ad, Bruce Williams endorsing a product - Talknet (BS-NE)
- 1360 WBKN NY BINGHAMTON - this was probably REH-ON's station in Issue 8 with News Director Kathy Whyte giving nx and wx at 0830; however the Stevie Wonder song at 0817 came from another station since WBKN is all talk & biz nx (KG-PA)
- 1430 WRTH ?? - 12/7 1840 ID: The new 1430 worth, WRTH; anyone have a QTH for this? (MH-NE)
- 1450 UNID ?? - 11/22 1904-1916 carrying Washington-Dallas FB game; VA or MD? (DT-ON)
- 1460 CKRB QC ST. GEORGES DE BEAUCE - is Laura McCusker's unID of 10/30 (Issue 8) (REH-ON)
- 1560 UNID ?? - 11/12 0120-0230 very strong on ET with Good Time Rock and Roll programming plus several local ads; no ID during time I was tuned in; could this have been WCDN? off by 0245 (KG-PA)

- 610 KOJM MT HAVRE - 12/3 0210-0230 occ. CIDs; WDAF dominant; MT #9 (MH-NE)
- KOJM MT HAVRE - 12/3 0200-0230 not hrd...freq too crowded (RF-OH) ...not a chance...too much WMT splatter (RD-IA3)
- 690 KSTL MO ST. LOUIS - 11/25 0101-0200 heavy splash from CFTR, snatches of CLA heard, but not enough for ID; likely CBC...CBF or CBU? (DT-ON)
- KSTL MO ST. LOUIS - 11/25 0101 noted very weakly under CBF with PoP test and DX Test; the next hour and 45 minutes was announced; have hrd this on SSS also, so I tuned out right away (WPF-IN)
- KSTL MO ST. LOUIS - 11/25 0101-0103 This is KSTL, St. Louis repeated 3 times and This is a performance test; lost in KNBR/WLW slop (BS-NE)
- KSTL MO ST. LOUIS - 11/25 0106-0153 sign-off, very strong with CBF nulled and some Caribbean Beacon QRM; various tones, then pgn of polka mx and VIDs mentioning 1000 watts of non-directional power and transmitting facilities in East St. Louis, IL; nearly 100% readable (KG-PA)
- KSTL MO ST. LOUIS - 11/25 0141 fair - good on DX Test with TT & ID (RK-IL)
- 760 WJR MI DE-TROIT - 11/30 0010 tune-in 'til 0422 sign-on, off for testing; TTs noted but very weak, must have been using a dummy load; Cuba, Colombia, Costa Rica and Mexico noted in their near absence; was hoping for Texas, Florida or Colorado but not even a hint of EE on the channel (REH-ON)

- 770 KATL MT MILES CITY - 12/2 0700-0730 not heard (RF-OH) ...not hrd; conditions to the west were mediocre and local WJR-760 splash was destroying 770; nulling WJR didn't help since this also nulled KATL (REH-ON)
- 800 CKLW ON WINDSOR - 11/26 0150-0340 off the air, with OC on briefly at 0200; in CKLW's absence, WSVS dominant with C&W mx; also FF talk (possibly CHRC) and unID with Larry King; CKLW back at 0340 (KG-PA)
- 1300 KLER ID OROFINO - 12/1 DX Test not hrd; too much WLIF/WAVZ/etc (KG-PA) ...not heard (RF-OH) ...not heard (RD-IA1)
- 1350 WCOB GA WARNER ROBINS - 11/11 0431-0455 beautiful signal on DX Test, over WSLR with organ mx and VIDs/CIDs (KG-PA)

RE: Your memo of November 16, 1990

First off, my apologies for not responding to your memo earlier. I have been working on the results of the vote taken among the ANARC Executive and club representatives and trying to put together a game plan for the future of ANARC. Yes, it looks like there is still going to be an ANARC. This might come as a surprise to a number of your readers, but the ballots have been cast and there is an overwhelming desire to see ANARC continue, but it really needs to be tuned up somewhat.

You have asked me to relay to you the true and accurate story of what is going on with ANARC. Yes, we have gone through some turmoil in recent months, and yes, announcements were made at ANARC09 in Virginia Beach and publicly on certain radio broadcasts and in publications that

ANARC was no more. There was pressure put upon me at the Virginia Beach ANARCON to make the announcement that ANARC was dead. There was discussion at the convention of the possibility of a new organization being organized. Although I personally did not agree with this, I reacted (incorrectly I should say) by formally announcing that ANARC was ceasing operation, effective immediately. This was done at the ANARCON banquet and was subsequently reported on various international shortwave stations.

After reflecting on the developments which had taken place, I decided to write a memo to all club representatives, club presidents, ANARC Executive Council members and ANARC staff members to state my feelings on the situation and to express my desire for the organization to continue with me at the helm. I included a ballot requesting a vote on a number of questions regarding the future of ANARC and my desire to take over the vacant Executive Secretary position. In response to this memo, Bob Brown, NASWA's ANARC representative and ANARC Executive Council member wrote and circulated a counter-memo expressing the NASWA stand on the situation and the contents of my memo. These two memos caused quite a stir in the radio community and many comments, pro and con, about me, NASWA, Bob Brown and ANARC. Finally when the ballots were submitted and the votes tabulated, it was clear that there was a desire to see ANARC continue, although changes would have to be made. One of the major concerns expressed was that people did not want me to hold the Executive Secretary position without first giving up my presidency of the Canadian International DX Club. According to the ANARC constitution, this is a prerequisite. An ANARC Executive Secretary cannot be an executive member of one of the ANARC clubs. It is not my desire to resign from my post as CIDX President, therefore clearly I do not qualify as a potential Executive Secretary. Unfortunately, in the ballots only two names were put forward as nominations for the post, namely Harold Cones and David Snyder. Confirmation has yet to be received, but I have been told indirectly that Harold Cones would not accept the nomination. David Snyder, the present Computer Information Committee Chairman nominated himself for the post.

There seems to be major concern that I cannot adequately handle the two positions and besides, I don't meet the requirements of the ANARC constitution. I have therefore proposed in a memo of December 7, that I continue to hold the post of Interim Director until such time as a successor to Robert Horvitz can be found, or during such time, if I prove that I can handle the two tasks, that a constitutional amendment be considered allowing me to hold both positions. The jury is out.

In your memo, you indicate the existence of the traditional comments of the non-SWL clubs to insist that ANARC has existed only to promote the interests of the shortwave clubs. I personally agree that this has been true, but I also feel that it is not only the job of ANARC to promote, but the job of the clubs themselves to promote their existence. As most of your readers are probably aware, I classify myself as an all-band radio hobbyist. I do have a great interest in SWRC but I am also into mediumwave DXing, utilities, ham band DX'ing, plus I also dabble from time to time with FM/TV DXing and most recently, scanners. In the last two years, I have probably spent more time talking to people about radio than I have listening to the radio. I have given many talks at amateur radio clubs. I have organized radio exhibitions and participated in various hobby shows. I have written several articles for newspapers, magazines and ethnic publications promoting the radio hobby. I have been teaching a course on radio monitoring in Montreal for the last 3 years. I have guested on several radio and television broadcasts over the years, particularly open line radio shows, promoting radio. In all of these endeavours I have tried to introduce our pastime to the public at large, with no particular emphasis on one aspect of radio.

I do feel that it is somewhat easier to promote shortwave radio than it might be to promote utilities, mediumwave or FM/TV dx-ing, simply because it has more mass appeal than the other categories and it not quite so specialized. I think that someone who gets involved in shortwave radio might easily evolve into the other areas of radio as well. There are many areas in which ANARC can help out all its member clubs, but we need the help in return from the clubs themselves. ANARC can propose some ideas to help promote your existence, but it has to be a two-way street. I am always open to suggestions and dialogue. I feel that radio in general is worth promoting and needs to be promoted, but it is not a one man show. I have offered to share my experiences with club members in all clubs in the past as to how to go about organizing promotional events such as exhibits at hobby shows, open line radio

appearances, radio festivals, etc., but I have received little response in return.

In the past, perhaps the questions "What is ANARC doing for the clubs?" and "What are the clubs doing for ANARC?" have been asked. I don't know how these questions were answered or even if they were answered. But that is the past. I'm ready to answer these questions now and I'm willing to hear your side of the story as well. We need a two-way dialogue between ANARC and its member clubs. It's not a one way street. So I'd appreciate any comments about ANARC and what you think we can do for each other. Should I stay on as the head of ANARC, I would like to see the clubs become more familiar with each other and work together on common goals. Please feel free to contact me with your ideas.
