**WASHINGTON THIS WEEK**

Inside Radio reports that USA Digital has received an experimental license for, and signed on with the first AM in-band DAB station operating in the Cincinnati area on 1650 AM. Inside Radio says USA Digital is still in the early stages of developing an in-band DAB system for AM; it's further along on a similar FM system and also plans to be on the air with a DAB signal "broadcasting under an existing analog FM station" shortly.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK (cont'd)

The licenses of Dixie Broadcasting's WHOS/WDRM Decatur, Ala., have been designated for hearing according to an FCC statement released August 21. The NAACP and National Black Media Coalition had filed petitions to deny those licenses on employment practice grounds. Even after Dixie settled with the groups, the FCC still believes that "Dixie's submissions raised substantial and material questions of fact as to whether it misrepresented or lacked candor in providing information to the FCC concerning its recruitment and employment practices."

ELSEWHERE

The Radio Advertising Bureau reports that combined local and national revenue is down 3% for July, despite a 2% increase in local sales over July '91. National revenue was down 15% in July, falling 15% in the east, 18% in the southeast, 19% in the southwest, and 20% in the west. The Midwest was the least hard hit with a 4% drop in national. For local revenue, the west was flat and the east was off 1%, but the Midwest was up 2%, the southeast was up 5%, and the southwest was up six percent. Network revenue was off 8%. If you look at the first seven months of the year, all revenue is flat, local is up 3%, and national is down 10%.

In an effort to get "more radio station specific comments," Arbitron is changing the open-ended comments part of its English and Spanish-language diaries. The wording will change from "Use this space to tell us how you feel about radio. Make any comments you like about stations, announcers, or programs" to "Use this space to make any comments you like about specific stations, announcers, or programs." Also, Arbitron has announced its survey dates for 1994. They are winter (Jan. 6-Mar. 30), spring (March 31-Jun. 22), summer (Jun. 23-Sept. 14), and fall (Sept. 22-Dec. 14). Meanwhile, Arbitron's ever-expanding rival, Willhight Research--with some help from the Corporation for Public Broadcasting--has announced the addition of Midwest and east coast markets, in addition to its usual Pacific Northwest stronghold, during 1992-93. New markets include Bangor, Me., Bowling Green, Ky., Hilton Head Island, S.C., Morgantown, W. Va., and Duluth, Minn.

The Chicago Sun-Times reports that WGCI-FM overnighter Irene Mojica is in the process of suing that station again. Two years ago, Mojica charged WGCI-FM with racial discrimination, sexual discrimination, and sexual harassment. Only the first charge was upheld, but Mojica won \$150,000 in damages which was subsequently reduced to \$45,000. Both sides are now appealing and Mojica claims she was passed over for a recent promotion from overnights to nights as a disciplinary action for the first lawsuit. Mojica has just taken this complaint to the EEOC as a preamble to court action.

As the growth of the southern gospel format continues, a new satellite network has debuted that will mix southern gospel with lyrically compatible country songs like Garth Brooks' "The River" or the Judds' "Love Can Build A Bridge." WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

This week's issue of the M Street Journal is going to press early so we can head down to the National Assn. of Broadcasters' fall radio show which will be taking place in New Orleans about the time you read this. However, at press-time, it appeared that the FCC's long-pending new radio rules should finally take effect by next Monday, Sept. 14. At deadline on Sept. 4, the new rules had just been published at the commission, meaning that they were headed for the Federal Register next.

Susan Platt, the National Assn. of Broadcasters' administrative director of government relations has been upped to VP of the NAB's radio department replacing Joy Dunlap who is moving to Florida.

ELSEWHERE

ASCAP and the Radio Music License Committee have reached a compromise on the fate of those stations carrying EFM's Rush Limbaugh program. Limbaugh, who drops in portions of songs at will, but tells stations, "We don't have to show you any stinking cue sheets," has created problems for stations on ASCAP per program licenses. The compromise is that stations will now pay 45% of what they would pay for a regular show for the hours they carry Limbaugh.

Pyramid Broadcasting has announced a merger with another Boston-area firm, Atlantic Radio. That merger will give Pyramid five stations in Boston (WXKS-AM-FM, WRKO, WBMX, and the newly acquired WEEL) as well as four in Rochester, N.Y., (WRMM-AM-FM and WPXY-AM-FM). In other "what was once duopoly is now habit" news, Ragan Henry's US Radio, which just closed on KMGR-FM, Salt Lake City has announced an LMA-to-buy arrangement with crosstown KBBX/KBCK.

The Radio Advertising Bureau has announced that its membership is up to 2,965 stations--its highest level in three years and a marked change from the 2,341 stations NAB was claiming a year ago before its new management took hold. RAB has also announced its annual series of Radio Sales University two day programs to be held in 11 cities between Sept. 18 and Dec. 11. For more info, call RAB at 212-254-4800.

RADAR 45, the spring '92 study of network listening is out, and the rankings of the top eight networks are unchanged. ABC Prime is up 0.3% to keep its lock on first place, followed by Mutual which, like all the Westwood One networks, was down--1.4% in this case. Rounding out the big 8 are ABC Platinum (+3.5%), CBS Spectrum (+0.5%), ABC Genesis (+0.9%), Unistar Super (+1.2%), Unistar Ultimate (+2.1%), and the still-normally named CBS Network (+3.3%). Off sharply were WW1's NBC (-3.4%) and its WONE network (-8.4%). The biggest gain was posted by the American Urban Radio Networks--the newly merged Sheridan and NBN webs--up 13.4. The top nine most listened to radio programs go to ABC, five of those, including the top three, are Paul Harvey broadcasts led by the 8:30 a.m. cast, the 12:06 p.m. cast, and Saturday morning's "The Rest Of The Story" show. In other network news, MCT Broadcasting will preview its new E! Entertainment Radio net at the fall NAB confab.

**WASHINGTON THIS WEEK**

After an incubation period just slightly longer than that of the average TV movie, the FCC's new ownership rules finally went into effect on Sept. 16, following their publication in that day's Federal Register. The first official filing by LMA broadcasters who wanted to stop shacking up and become legal was a 12:01 AM filing by WAPE, Jacksonville, Fla., owner Evergreen for the purchase of Metroplex's crosstown WFYV.

Not surprisingly, the pending ownership changes made for a lively National Assn. of Broadcasters convention in New Orleans this Sept. 9-12. But the most telling discussion was one that took place between the FCC's mass media bureau chief Roy Stewart and Westwood One's Norm Pattiz that took place at this year's Radio Business Report-sponsored convention breakfast.

There wasn't a bombshell at this year's RBR breakfast on the level of Stewart's mea culpa for Docket 80-90 last year. But Stewart did tell Pattiz at one point that broadcasters were thinking too much about the new ownership rules and not enough about pending technological changes, especially the rise of DAB. When Pattiz responded that the product was more important than the delivery system--and that radio had survived technological changes before--Stewart shot back, "Then I take it you know where the spectrum is coming from for DAB ... If we don't find the spectrum, the people in this room aren't going to be here next year."

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK (cont'd)

Perhaps because broadcasters are so eager to see an in-band DAB solution, there were uniformly glowing reviews--especially in the other trades--for USA Digital Radio's demonstrations on in-band AM and FM DAB. Radio & Records, for instance, announced that USA Digital had "wowed" NAB attendees and referred to USA Digital's staffers as "top technological wizards." We feel compelled to point out that on the final morning of the convention, M Street's Sean Ross was given the A/B demonstration of WNOE, New Orleans' AM signal vs. the DAB version of the same programming. At that point, Ross and the USA Digital rep noticed that the two bands were NOT running the same programming. A sheepish USA Digital rep thanked us for our interest, promised to look into it, and quickly turned his attention elsewhere. Meanwhile, the demonstration of the new AMAX tuners--which didn't get anywhere near the same amount of press--were pretty impressive in their own right with the AM signal sounding louder and cleaner than its AM counterpart, although both bands were receiving closed circuit broadcasts.

NAB attendees also laced into the Electronic Industries Assn. for its clamor to come up with a fast DAB standard. Viacom Radio's Bill Figenshu, for his part, compared the DAB issue to "Republicans talking about family values when the real issue is the economy ... I'm not sure what I'm supposed to be doing about (DAB) right now."

Back on the duopoly front, Figenshu also told the audience at the group heads panel, "It's okay to be scared about the change, but for God's sake, stop whining about it." While people would lose their jobs, he added, "the good people will survive," and the ones who would be made redundant would be those for whom radio was "just a paycheck." (This brings up the question of whether the unemployed radio people you know already--and there undoubtedly are some--are all clock-watcher types. But we digress.) Otherwise, the only real new ground covered on this topic now, as opposed to six months or a year ago, were the number of "what if" questions posed to Stewart about both the new rules and the new political spot rules. Mindful, perhaps, of the time in Vegas six months ago when different FCC people gave different answers in different rooms at the same time, the FCC's Bob Pettit announced that the FCC was going to "stop giving off the cuff answers."

The most explosive NAB panel was probably one that ended up having little to do with radio, except in the abstract, the face-off between Republican committee chairman Rich Bond and Democratic chairman Ron Brown. Brown has an interest in WKYS, Washington, D.C., and got applause when he noted that, in today's economy, GM Skip Finley "spends more time talking to lenders than vendors." Otherwise, moderator Larry King kept the debate from ever touching on radio issues, deflecting one question about broadcaster access to capitol as too complex to be touched on there. There was one ironic moment, however, where--in response to Brown's suggestion that there be national economic planning--Bond reiterated the Bush Administration's commitment to the sanctity of the small businessman, something that seems almost entirely at odds with the duopoly-mating-call-among-titans air at the FCC over the last year, and something which went entirely unchallenged by the audience.

Also at the convention, NAB announced that it would be joining in a Federal Appeals Court suit over the size of FCC fines--the case in question actually stems from a telephone company fine, not from radio. 10 days earlier, WREM, Monticello, Me., had been fined \$10,000 for an unauthorized transfer of control, something which two FCC commissioners called a little harsh in light of the fact that WREM had just sold for \$2,000.

With George Bush having signed the new bill limiting indecent broadcasts to midnight-6 a.m., R&R reports that the FCC was expected to start the public comment period that would lead to its implementation of the new rules. Of course, with the FCC sworn to uphold the new rules, there's not much that a public comment period can change.

After reviewing allegations by the NAACP and the NBMC against three Ohio stations, the Commission renewed the licenses of all three. WCLV, Cleveland OH was granted an unconditional renewal. WOBL, Oberlin OH and WPHR Cleveland OH renewals were granted subject to EEO reporting conditions. WNIL/WAOR-FM in Niles, MI were also granted EEO-conditional renewals.

Two other stations weren't so lucky. WOKD and WXKT Arcadia, FL, were fined \$18,000 for EEO violations after failing to respond to a Notice of Apparent Liability.

In several other actions, the Commission:

--denied a petition by Steelville Communications, Inc. to amend the FM table for Steelville IL because of short spacing requirements.

--denied a petition by Innovative Women's Media Association for reconsideration of a decision affirming the dismissal of its application for failure to prosecute involving competing applications for a new FM in Shreveport LA on 102.9 MHz.

--affirmed a \$950 forfeiture penalty against KPUP Salinas, CA for tower enclosure violations.

--denied Beth Knight review of a decision to add financial qualifications issues against her in the proceeding involving five competing applications for a new FM in Sebastopol, CA on 93.7 MHz.

--denied St. Vrain Communications Company reconsideration of the return of its application for a new FM on 104.3 MHz in Longmont, CO.

--denied Design Media review or a Review Board dismissal of its application for a new FM on 92.5 MHz in Zebulon, GA.

--denied Sumter Radio Partners review of a Board grant of the application of Iris Communications, Inc. for a new FM on 94.7 MHz in Sumter, SC.

--denied Red Rock Broadcasting, Inc. a review of return of its application for a new FM at St. George, UT.

--denied Charles C. Babbs' request for a review of a Mass Media Bureau decision which denied Babbs' petition to deny and request for reconsideration of the grant of applications filed by Community Service Broadcasting for an extension of time to construct unbuilt station KDGB Dodge City, KS, and for consent to assign the construction permit to Lesso, Inc.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The Federal Communications Commission proposed on Sept. 17 to update its Emergency Broadcast System. Among its suggestions: replacing EBS outright with a new emergency alerting system, modernizing EBS equipment with "a new emergency alert device" that could be partially automated, and to mandate equipment standards. The FCC is also seeking public comment on changing the EBS name, incorporating other technologies (including cellular and cable), and soliciting amateur radio participation in EBS.

The National Assn. of Broadcasters and the Radio Advertising Bureau have announced that the RAB will have an expanded presence at the NAB's two annual conventions--April 19-22 in Las Vegas and the September 8-11 radio show in Dallas. Of course, given the number of conversions to country taking place in any given week, you might think that NAB would just want to merge its conventions with the Country Radio Seminar. The newly announced theme for next year's CRS, to be held March 3-6 at Opryland in Nashville, is "We've Got What's Hot." Back at the NAB, they'll conduct a seminar on "new broadcast technologies" at the International Broadcasting and Telecommunications Show to be held in Milan, October 15-19. NAB wasn't planning to be in Europe, but since they DID have to be there to return the Eureka-147 DAB unit in person...

ELSEWHERE

The Interep Radio Store's Torbet Radio has announced that it will acquire Schubert Radio and become the Torbet Radio Group. Schubert president Jerry Schubert will become chairman for the combined operation. Concurrently, Interep has "resigned" (read dropped) 200 stations where, it says "the direct out of pocket cost to represent stations below a certain commission level made [this action] inevitable."

"Vulture capital" outlet Zell/Chillmark has finally taken over 69% of the outstanding shares of Jacor in return for chopping its debt from \$148-million to \$82-million, according to *Inside Radio* ... WLUP-AM-FM, Chicago moves AM afternoon hosts Steve Dahl & Gary Meier to mornings on both stations. Jonathon Brandmeier moves to afternoons on the FM station, making way for the expected, but still unannounced, debut of Howard Stern in mornings on WLUP-AM.

The New York State Department of Health has found the hospital where WABC programming legend Rick Sklar died during minor surgery to be "deficient." *Inside Radio* reports that doctors knew about a malfunctioning piece of monitoring equipment but decided to go ahead anyway.

WWRC Washington, D.C., talk host Morton Downey, Jr., will go national shortly through D.C.-based syndicator Radio America. Original CNN anchor Don Miller has launched the syndicated "Don Miller Newsmagazine" talk and interview program. Miller is based out of WEEB, Southern Pines, N.C., at 919-692-7440.

Britain's first national commercial outlet, the fine arts formatted Classic FM, launched Sept. 7 with Handel's "God Save The Queen." Classic FM will be located between 100 and 102 FM, depending on the locale. Elsewhere in the UK, London's temporary-license modern rock outlet X-FM came back on the air for another month long stint on Sept. 14.
