LIVING LIKE ROYALTY: The Recording Industry Assn. of America's longtime push for a performance royalty picked up again on July 1 with the introduction of the Sound Recordings Act of 1993 by Intellectual Property subcommittee chairman Howard Berman (D-CA) and Rep. William Hughes (D-NJ). The bill, which would give owners of sound recordings the exclusive right to control digital transmission of their works is, not surprisingly, opposed by the NAB which believes that broadcasters pay enough royalties as it is, and besides digital broadcasting--should it ever exist--is the real enemy of copyright holders. GREEN BAY PACK: Look for one of the few remaining medium-market CHR battles to end shortly now that the acquisition of WHET Sturgeon Bay, Wisc., and WOZZ New London, Wisc., by Midwest Communications has closed, giving those stations an effective FM tri-opoly with CHR WIXX. WHET, currently WIXX's CHR rival, will become country WGEE-FM, doing a separate hot country format from legendary AM outlet WGEE. WOZZ, which is currently satellite classic rock, will do a local "classic hits" format similar to WKLH Milwaukee. This week's full format info follows:

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The NAB's Radio TechCheck reports that the Commission received between 700 and 800 applications to migrate to the new expanded AM band. The ranking process, designed to prioritize the list by the station's potential to reduce interference, begins soon, which will result in 200-250 allotments. The applicants are expected to be announced soon. The Commission will then issue a public notice, followed by a short comment period. The allotments will then be calculated, followed by another notice with a 30 day comment period. Approvals will then begin followed by a filing period for any unused allotments. Competing applications will not be accepted during the approval process, but parties may file petitions to deny. Call John Marino at the NAB with questions--(202) 429-5391.

The Commission designated for hearing two renewal applications. One for KSRK Lufkin TX, and one for WBRL Berlin NH. Both stations are silent. The Commission upheld a \$7,500 fine to non-commercial WMPR Jackson MS for broadcasting commercials.

Edens Broadcasting's soon-to-be-sold KOY-AM-FM Phoenix has been hit with a \$25,000 fine and a short term license renewal (through 1995) for EEO recruiting violations. The license renewal does, however, clear the way for the long-delayed sale to Sundance Broadcasting and the duopoly with crosstown KZON/KOYT to go through.

Nominees for this year's NAB Marconi Awards have been announced; the winners will be named at this year's NAB radio show in Dallas, Sept. 8-11. This year's legendary station of the year nominees are KIRO Seattle, WHO Des Moines, WJR Detroit, WMT Cedar Rapids, and WOR New York. A few interesting notes here: Satellite kids' flagship WWTC Minneapolis is nominated as best MOR station. Also, Unistar AM Only affiliate WMTR Morristown, N.J., is nominated as best Big Band outlet, leading one to wonder whether this was meant to be a vote of confidence for stations that use satellite programming, or if those doing the nominating just didn't know. And as a sign of the times indicator for CHR, nominators were only able to come up with four stations instead of the usual five; only religious, Spanish, and MOR have as few nominees. Also, football legend Roger Staubach has been announced as a keynoter for the fall NAB.

ELSEWHERE

Inside Radio reports that Arbitron will try start selling diary comments on a trial basis in six or so markets for the spring book. DiaryLink will cost \$350-600 depending on market size and while its purpose is to save some small-market folks a trip to Laurel, the comments will be entered post-ascription, so that any mentions of Z100 New York will be shown as WHTZ and NOT by identifier which might be the thing some people are looking for.

Beasley Broadcasting has announced that it will sell its New Orleans oldies outlet KQLD to NewMarket, owners of crosstown WNOE-AM-FM, for \$3.35 million. NewMarket has entered into an LMA with a purchase option with Beasley in the interim.

HOW OLD IS OLD: KSMG San Antonio is trying to downplay the format change that took place last week from conventional oldies to what it is billing on air as the "best mix of the '60s, '70s, and '80s." KSMG is telling some callers that it's still an oldies station; we've gone ahead and made the change to gold-based AC since positioning is nine-tenths of the law in this case and having dropped the oldies position for a very AC-sounding slogan and having added '80s music, KSMG's repositioning sure sounds like a format change to us. This does, however, bring up some interesting questions. What then is WCBS-FM New York which still throws in some currents and whose single most-played oldie seems to be another '80s title "Part Time Lover" by Stevie Wonder? After several years in which oldies stations were generally agreed on 1971-73 as a cutoff point, we're starting to hear more of the AC '70s in the mix around the country, which sort of brings the format back to where it was 10 years ago before its explosion. We'd be interested in knowing what the oldies stations in your market are sounding these days. This week's news begins on page 6. Full format info starts below.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The FCC has decided that newly syndicated talk host G. Gordon Liddy's repeated attacks on former co-conspirator John Dean do not violate its personal attack clause. Dean is still taking Liddy to court for allegedly defamatory comments about him and his wife Maureen. All of which makes you glad that the Watergate guys were too busy arguing with each other to actually subvert the constitution at the time.

Inside Radio reports that the FCC has fined WHOS/WDRM Decatur, Ala., \$50,000 and given it a short-term renewal for violations not in EEO hiring but EEO reporting. WHOS allegedly cooked the number of hires it reported to the FCC to make its seven black employees seem like a larger percentage of the staff. The punchline is that seven people would still have been enough to avoid discrimination charges if the correct number had been reported.

Several years after its debut in the states, satellite pay audio has been authorized in Canada this week following a CRTC decision to allow DMX Canada to offer 38 subscription channels over the next two years. This being the CRTC, the decision requires the CRTC to offer five Canadian content channels including one featuring environmental sound effects and one featuring undiscovered Canadian artists.

ELSEWHERE

A year ago, when we ran the format count for our annual M Street Radio Directory, the AM/FM split in the country format was still about 50/50. Now it's 56/46 FM/AM due to the recent spate of FM building in the format and a series of AM defections to news/talk and southern gospel. Country remains the leading format this year, but it's not up as dramatically as you might think, going from 2,526 stations to 2,601. AC remains the #2 format, but it's off sharply again this year (1,701-1,598). N/T moves 4-3 (763-986) ahead of non-music-based religious formats (766-763) and oldies (721-737). CHR remains the #6 format but is off 666-529. You can see the full chart next month when the 1993-94 edition of the M Street Radio Directory comes out.

If you're a Satellite Music Network affiliate, you may have noticed occasional periods of pink noise on its feed that began at roughly 11 AM Saturday and continued for about 24 hours. The interference--which SMN attributed to interference from testing on an adjacent channel feed--reportedly affected eight of SMN's 10 formats. No other network was plagued by the pink noise which resulted in a slew of frantic calls to the network as late as Monday morning.

Remember Steve & DC? They're the guys who said the "N" word on WKBQ St. Louis, then got fired for their racial slur ... eventually. Now they're back in action in mornings at Jacor's hard-rock KAZY Denver. There's a little irony at work here when you consider that KAZY is now the LMA partner of KOA, connecting it to the legacy of talk host Alan Berg who was killed by the white supremacist groups that dot that part of the country. Not that we would suggest that there's any connection between propagating low-level racism to get attention and people actually acting on it or anything...

After weeks of speculation, the Group W/Viacom Washington/Houston swap is official. Viacom gets WCXR Washington to add to its WMZQ-AM-FM. Group W gets the top two country AM/FM combos, KIKK and KILT. Viacom has announced that WCXR will stay classic rock.

Columbia Univ.'s quarterly Media Studies Journal has turned its attention to radio, something it does only once every several years. The journal's "Radio: The Forgotten Medium" features articles by "Empire Of The Air" author Tom Lewis, Radio Inc.'s Eric Rhodes, and M Street's own Sean Ross among many others and can be ordered from 212-678-6600.

Veteran GM Tom Hoyt, most recently with Intersport in Chicago, is the new director of major market sales and affiliate relations for Unistar ... Arbitron senior client service rep Andrea Rainey joins the Radio Advertising Bureau as director of research; RAB analyst Lisa Brumme becomes associate director of research.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The FCC has announced the streamlining of its application process for upgrades on adjacent and co-channels as well as modifications to adjacent channels of the same class, and downgrades to adjacent channels. Broadcasters previously had to petition for a rulemaking, then file an application. Now the first step has been eliminated "in circumstances where it largely duplicates the application process."

The National Assn. of Broadcasters has asked the FCC to take action against state and local laws that "unreasonably keep broadcasters and other communications companies from building FCC licensed ... towers." Citing "myriad examples" of broadcasters who can't build CPs that they've been granted, the NAB accuses local authorities of "un-licensing FCC licensed facilities."

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK (cont'd)

In other NAB news, KARN Little Rock owner Ted Snider has been named the recipient of the NAB's National Radio Award to be presented at the NAB's fall radio convention in Dallas, Sept. 8-11. And the association is sponsoring its first regional career seminar in Atlanta Sept. 1-2. For more information, call Karen Hunter at 202-429-5498.

ELSEWHERE

By the time you read this, we'll be less than a week away from the long-awaited Shamrock/Malrite merger but the other shoe has already dropped for several Shamrite/Malrock employees. KLAC/KZLA LA GM Norm Epstein, KNEW/KSAN San Francisco GM Bruce Blevins, and KABL/San Francisco GM Mike Grinsell are already out and should be replaced by the time you read this. Also, R&R suggests that WHTZ New York morning man Gary Bryan will also leave this month. The sale is expected to close on July 28, the day of Z100's 10th anniversary concert.

In her latest action against the station, former WHFS Annapolis/ Washington NSM Patti Ebbert has filed against that station's sale from Duchossois to Liberty. Ebbert is claiming wrongful dismissal following her crusade on behalf of speech-impaired announcer hubby Damian Einstein and has, in recent years, levelled a slew of charges against the station including contest fixing and overcharging advertisers.

Two more stations have been cited by Arbitron for ratings bias stemming from "if anyone asks" type promos. WYEZ South Bend is getting a page 5(b) notice and computer tape flag. WIAI Danville, Ill., is getting a page 5(b) notice.

Tom Holbein, president of Scarborough Research, has exited. His duties are being overseen by Terry Kent, Exec. VP of parent VNU BIS for now.

In another sign that he's recovered from his midlife crisis, Garrison Keiller has announced that his "American Radio Company" will revert to its original name, "A Prairie Home Companion," beginning with the new season that begins Oct. 2. Keiller had already returned to his former home base of St. Paul last year and seems to have given up on that thing about "living the life of a shy person" from a few years back.

Boot In Mouth department: The Washington Post reports that former WMZQ Washington morning team Jim London & Mary Ball had an awkward moment when they joined crosstown oldies outlet WBIG-FM recently. Tom Kelly, the p.m. driver who had been holding down mornings until the team got there, commented that the pair came from a station that played music for the "lowest common denominator." GM Catherine Meloy later apologized in the Post for the comment, pointing out the traditional sharing that has always existed between country and oldies stations.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

Ready for the Fairness Doctrine again? R&R says the doctrine "appears likely to return to haunt broadcasters after it was warmly embraced at a congressional hearing." In anticipation of this, Inside Radio notes that Infinity's Mel Karmazin noted to stockholders that right wing host G. Gordon Liddy was already giving exposure to "the other side," although we doubt this means John Dean will be heard casting aspersions on the character of Liddy's wife anytime soon.

Inside Radio reports that Southern Broadcasting Co., has been fined \$17,500 for signing its WSTT Thomasville, Ga., off the air after a fire in 1980 and not notifying the commission within 30 days. The FCC is also upset that the public file wasn't available while the station was off.

ELSEWHERE

WNIS Norfolk has been given a sticker and a 5(b) note from Arbitron for alleged ratings distortion that took place on a computer bulletin board. GM Bob Sinclair told R&R that the note--from a host who went to another station may have been intentional sabotage. Arbitron says it doesn't care. WJNO/WJNX West Palm Beach has gotten a page 5(b) note for a TV spot with the line, "If it's news or talk radio you're hearing, it's WJNO you're hearing." Arbitron thinks that will cause people to misreport listening to other N/T stations which would also suggest that the more common line, "When you hear oldies, you're listening to XXXX" is also a problem. WMXB Richmond got a 5(b) note for an ad, targeted at advertisers, thanking the "1,212 diary recipients who mentioned WMXB in the fall book."

Hello, Cousin Stockholders! IPO-mania continues with the \$7-million, 1-million NASDAQ share initial public offering of Cousin Bruce Morrow's Multi-Market Radio last week (7-22). Morrow and partner Robert F.X. Sillerman maintain voting control of the company with an investment of approximately \$2 million. Also, the Chicago Sun-Times reports that Barry Mayo's Broadcasting Partners Inc., also is expected to go public soon. And Saga Communications plans to put another 685,000 shares up for grabs shortly according to Inside Radio.

This was still unconfirmed at presstime, but R&R was reporting that Evergreen Media was "very close" to purchasing the remaining Cook-Inlet stations: WPGC Washington, KUBE Seattle, and KBXX Houston. One theory advanced in Inside Radio is that KUBE would then be spun off to Shamrock, owner of KXXR Seattle, in exchange for its recently acquired WHTZ (Z100) New York, thus giving Shamrock a Seattle duopoly and relieving it of having to either do CHR on Z100 or find another hole. In other new duopoly news, KDFC-AM-FM San Francisco goes from Sundial to Brown (KKSF) for \$13 million.

It was less than a year ago that non-Hispanic broadcasters were insisting that the success of regional Mexican music, specifically banda, at KLAX Los Angeles had to be a fluke. Now the GMS of Chicago's Spanish-language stations insist that their failure to receive any sort of ratings benefit from banda-mania must be a fluke. A Chicago Tribune story this week focuses on the combined 3.0 12-plus number that Chicago's four Spanish-language outlets share amongst themselves. WIND/WOJO GM Chuck Brooks lashes into Arbitron for using only 379 households and for using census data showing Chicago to be only 11.1 Hispanic. He also complains that not everybody who identifies themselves as Hispanic to Arbitron speaks Spanish or listens to Spanish-language radio, which we didn't know was a requirement for being Hispanic. Arbitron in its defense points out that it has special diary incentives and bilingual diaries.

Here are the nominees for the CMA's station of the year award to be handed out, along with personality of the year, on the CMA broadcast Sept. 29. Large market: WKHX Atlanta, WYAY Gainesville-WYAI LaGrange GA (Atlanta), WPOC Baltimore, WUSN Chicago, WGAR Cleveland, WWWW-FM Detroit, and KNIX-FM Phoenix. Medium: KASE Austin, KYKR Beaumont TX, WTCR Kenova WV (Huntington), WGKX Memphis, and KRMD-FM Shreveport LA. Small: KEAN-FM Abilene TX, WQCB Brewer ME (Bangor), WKNN-FM Pascagoula MS (Biloxi), KHAK-FM Cedar Rapids IA, WAXX Eau Claire WI, KGEE Monahans TX (Odessa), KTTS-FM Springfield MO, and WTXT Fayette AL (Tuscaloosa).

Now infamous morning team Steve & D.C. are out, after eight broadcasts, at Jacor's KAZY Denver. Despite the station's attempt to take control of the situation by making the duo's racial slur-induced firing from KKBQ St. Louis part of their announcement, outside media attention finally forced the team off the air again.
