JONES TEAMS UP FOR NEW SPORTS NET... Denver-based Jones Satellite Network and Colfax Communications' WTEM Bethesda MD (Washington DC) will launch a 24-hour sports talk format March 1. WTEM will syndicate all of its programming, but stations will be offered the opportunity to integrate local programming and play-by-play.

STEVE & D.C. BACK IN ST. LOUIS AFTER STATIONS SWAP FREQUENCIES... Zimmer Broadcasting, who owns WKKX Jerseyville IL and has been in an LMA-to-buy Evergreen's KASP St. Louis and WKBQ Granite City IL, has now purchased the stations and moved WKKX's country format to 106.5 MHz, while WKBQ's CHR will move to 104.1 MHz (see map, page 12). The move is to take advantage of the better signal on 106.5 MHz. As you'll recall, Steve & D.C. got into a ton of trouble with the local NAACP and the Urban League after racial comments on-the-air last year. The duo was fired by the previous owners of the station, worked very briefly in Denver (where public outcry got them fired again), made their peace with St. Louis black leaders, and rehired by the new owners, Zimmer Broadcasting.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

Inferring that the Commission is beginning to tire of the indecency complaints against Howard Stern, FCC Commissioner James Quello has confirmed that the agency will hold up Infinity Broadcasting's purchase of WPGC AM & FM Morningside MD (Washington DC), and KRTH Los Angeles until the new complaints can be investigated and resolved. According to a story in the New York Times, the delays could cost Infinity millions of dollars each month, since the purchase price of KRTH is tied to cash flow.

In response to a remand by the Court of Appeals, the Commission has remanded the proceeding for a new FM on 101.1 MHz in Richmond VA to the presiding Administrative Law Judge for induction of additional evidence and preparation of an initial decision on financial reporting issues previously designated by the review board, along with misrepresentation and real party-in-interest issues.

The Commission has granted a request filed by the Association of Federal Communications Consulting Engineers requesting an extension of the reply comment period in the matter of an inquiry into the Commission's policies and rules regarding AM Directional Antenna Performance Verification. Replies are now due March 1.

The Commission has denied a petition by Maria Ochoa for reconsideration of the decision to grant a new station (now known as WKVS) on 103.3 MHz in Lenoir NC. It also reaffirmed that Ochoa was dismissed on character grounds. However, it granted a motion for the addition of misrepresentation issues against Foothills Broadcasting, Inc., the licensee of WKVS.

Two stations have been ordered to show cause why their licenses should not be revoked. Wesley College's WCSP (AM) in Crystal Springs MS has been off without authorization since October 11, 1991. Keyboard Broadcasting Communications' WCSA (AM) in Ripley MS has been off since September 1, 1991. Each station has 30 days after receipt of their notices to respond.

Radio and Records reports the FCC's Mass Media Bureau Chief Roy Stewart will be hiring six new attorneys to the agency's EEO branch. Combining the forthcoming new policy on EEO penalties and the new attorneys, the license renewal process with regard to EEO indecency complaints should flow much smoother.

ELSEWHERE

Keymarket Communications has announced their intent to purchase Fairmont's WLAC-AM & FM Nashville for an undisclosed price. Keymarket, just last week, announced its purchase of WWKB and WKSE-FM Buffalo NY from Price Communications. Keymarket has just filed to buy LMA partner WOGY-FM Memphis TN, which they will combo with WRVR-FM and WJCE Memphis.

The NewMarket group announced it will sell all of its stations to Radio Equity Partners for \$100 million. The nine-station group owns WREC/WEGR Memphis TN and WRXQ Olive Branch MS (Memphis), WSJS/WTQR Winston-Salem NC, KXXY-AM & FM Oklahoma City OK, and WNOE-AM & FM New Orleans LA. The sale also provides for the acquisition of KGTR Port Sulphur LA (New Orleans) and KOQL Oklahoma City OK, which are under purchase contracts by NewMarket.

Pyramid Broadcasting has gone on a duopoly spending spree, picking up WJMN Boston from Ardman Broadcasting for \$22 million to combo with WXKS Everett MA & WXKS-FM Medford MA. At press time, Pyramid announced it will purchase Malrite's last station, WJJZ Philadelphia, to combo with WYXR.

Clear Channel Communications announced its intent to pick up Ackerly's WAXY Ft. Lauderdale FL (Miami) for \$14 million. WAXY is currently in an LMA with WHYI Ft. Lauderdale, which is owned by Metroplex Communications. Late last year, Clear Channel and Metroplex stated their intention to merge.

Capitalizing on the NAB's decision to include non-radio media to its Fall convention, Inside Radio has announced it will hold its own Radio Only convention in Princeton NJ May 13-15 at the Scanticon Conference Center. The three day schedule is packed with interactive seminars, forums, and motivating sessions including The Generation X Live Focus Group, Spring Book Analysis Clinic and How to Cure Cold Call Turn-Offs. The RAB reports spot radio revenue was up 14% in November making the overall November radio revenue up 10%.

The NAB has joined with 10 other trade associations and professional societies in challenging the constitutionality of a series of special rules dealing with associations' lobbying expenditures contained in provisions of the Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1993. The groups state that the lobbying provisions violate their first amendment rights of free expression and petition by imposing higher penalties on the groups for petitioning the government than they would an individual or corporation. The other provisions would make associations pay a "proxy tax" on any monies spent on lobbying or inform their members that the part of their dues that goes to lobbying is not tax deductible and make the associations pay tax on monitoring and research used for lobbying. The NAB has put out "The 1993 Tax Act: What it Means" and discusses the Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act in it. Cost is \$65 for members and \$130 for non-members. 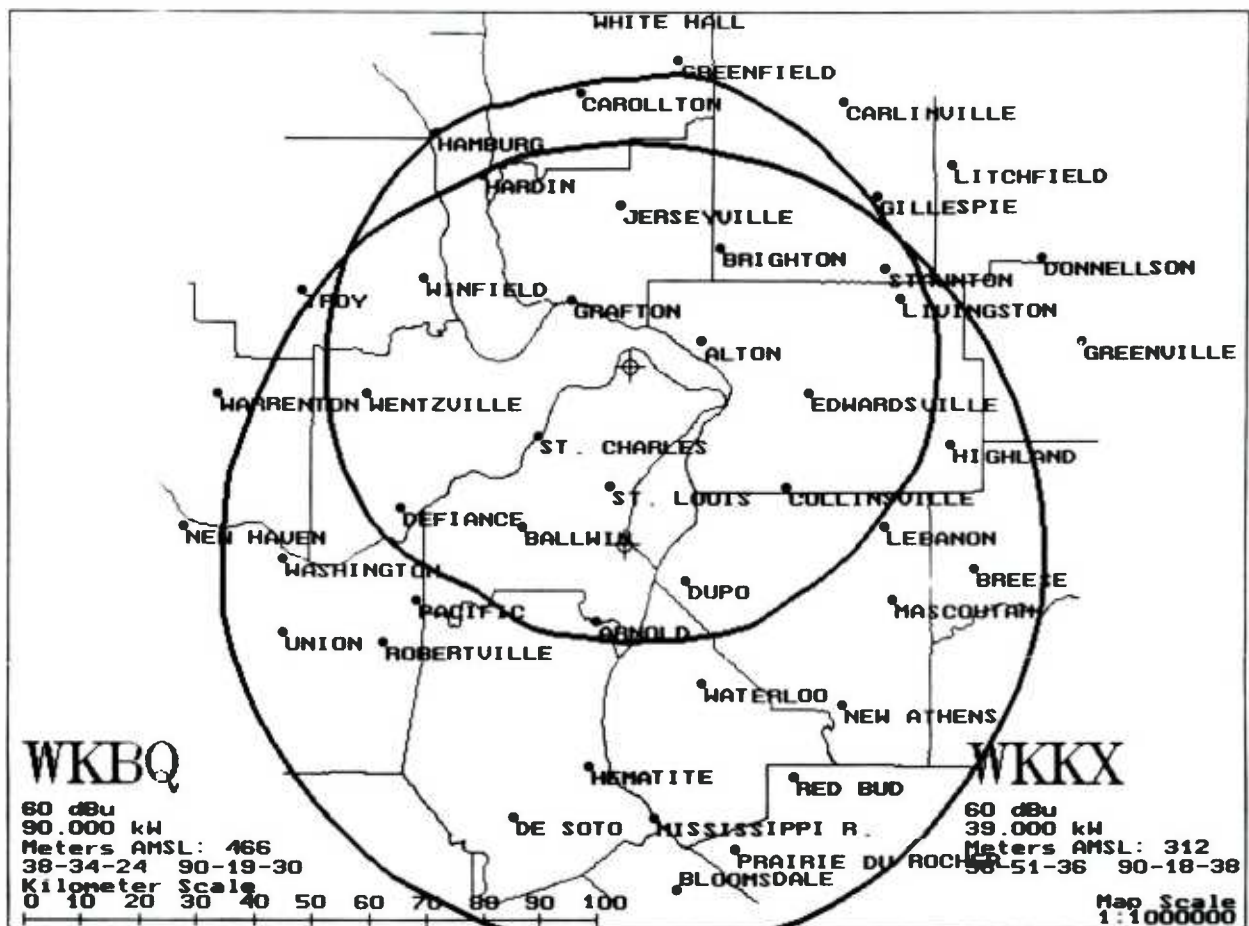

CANADA THIS WEEK

The Canadian Radio-television and Telecommunications Commission (CRTC) approved the sale of CHQM from CHUM Limited to a company indirectly owned and controlled by James Ho with 20% holdings split between Chinese Commercial Radio Ltd., Wayne Lee and George Feng. The station will be running ethnic programming to enrich the communities in the Vancouver market. By condition of licence, the new company must devote the full broadcast week (126 hours) to programs directed to at least seven ethnocultural groups, including aboriginal Canadians, in a minimum of seven different languages. The company is expected to increase to 12 groups and 12 languages by the following year. CRTC granted CHQM a six-year licence term, expiring August 31, 1999, so that it may consider the renewal of this licence at the same time as those of other radio stations in the Vancouver area.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The Commission doled out a few fines this week for broadcasting telephone conversations without prior authorization. WEG Broadcasting's WPMC Goldsboro NC got hit for \$3,500, as did Apollo Radio's KKAT Salt Lake City UT. Radio WBAW, Inc.'s WBAW Barnwell SC spent \$5,000 for the violation.

The NAB is urging Washington to shut down TV Marti, the U.S. government broadcast service that beams anti-Castro TV programming to Cuba, claiming that the program "is not worth continued funding." The NAB is complaining that the broadcasts have triggered Cuban retaliatory actions resulting in the jamming of U.S. AM stations.

ELSEWHERE

This week's mystery station comes to us from beautiful downtown Merkel, Texas; population 2,493. Back in the 80's, this sleepy metropolis relied on 250 watt daytimer KMXO, 1500 kHz on the dial, for music, community news, and, of course, traffic reports. The station went silent in the late 80's and the Commission canceled the station's license and deleted its call letters in May of 1993. Now, its seven years later and reports are starting to pop up that the station is back on the air, despite the fact that, according to the Commission, its not a licensed facility. Well, the mystery has been solved. After talking to our insider at the Commish, we found out that station licensee Ray Silva found out that the license renewal was dismissed, he filed a petition for reconsideration this past June. The Commission granted his petition and restored KMXO's operating authority as of Dec. 6, 1993. When it came time to process the paperwork, the Commission just forgot to change the station's status from "canceled" to "operational."

A "battle of the stars" is brewing in the Windy City after Cox's WYSY-FM Aurora IL went on the air as "Star 107.9." According to Robert Feder's column in the Chicago Sun-Times, it seems that Cox forgot to check with the state before using the slogan. Right in their backyard, WZSR Woodstock IL ("Star 105.5") has been using the slogan for two years. WYSY's coverage overlaps about 50 percent of WZSR's. Nothing's been worked out yet. . .

ELSEWHERE

According to Radio Ink, the Radio Advertising Bureau has decided to relocate much of its operation to Dallas TX. The announcement came during the RAB's Winter Board meeting. The move is expected to save the RAB between 15% and 20% per year. RAB will maintain portions of its member service and marketing functions in New York.

Heritage Media will be picking up a third station in St. Louis, as it has agreed to acquire KRJY from Communications Fund, Inc. to combo with WRTH & WIL-FM. Price was not disclosed.

Paul Colford at New York Newsday reports that Bloomberg Business News' WBBR programming is now being syndicated to stations that add a Bloomberg business terminal. The first station to sign up is WPTR Albany NY.

National Public Radio has added a London cable system as an affiliate. United Artists cable, which has 55,000 subs, will begin carrying the programming soon. Stockholm-based Swedish Radio is also starting an English news service that will carry one hour of NPR's Morning Edition.

Following the demise of New York's classical WNCN over the holidays, the WNCN listeners guild, the group that successfully held up the license renewal of the station after it switched formats in the 80's, is calling to arms. The listener's guild is sending out flyers to recruit new members to help "restore the WNCN classical music format to the air."

The Radio Advertising Bureau has announced its call for entries in the Radio-Mercury Awards, advertising's richest awards program. Over \$200,000 in cash and prizes will be offered for the best radio spots in a number of categories. Entry deadline is March 4. For more information call the RAB at (212) 387-2100.

The RAB will open its Small Market Advisory Committee meeting to all conference attendees. The meeting will cover the impact of LMA's and duopolies on small market radio, the increasing regionalization of the banking industry, and the increase in sample size of Arbitron metro areas at the expense of non-metro counties. The four hour meeting starts at noon on Thursday, Feb. 17. For more information, or to register, call (800) 722-7355.

Phoenix-based Equity Radio Network has announced the availability of "Classic Radio Theater," weekly programs highlighting many of the "old-time" radio shows. The programming is available via satellite on a barter basis. Call (602) 483-8762 for more info.

CANADA THIS WEEK

The first Canadian station to take advantage of the relaxed CRTC programming rules that allow stations to broadcast single-faith religion programming has hit the airwaves in Vancouver BC. CHRX switched from its classic rock format last week to a contemporary Christian format, changing call letters to CKBD, and calling itself "The Bridge." Any guesses as to the last song played before the switch? "Stairway to Heaven."

CBC Radio, in conjunction with Industry Canada, is adding some of its fare to the Internet computer network. An experimental database containing sound and text from the CBC programs "Quirks and Quarks," "Basic Black," and "Sunday Morning" will be transmitted from Industry Canada's Ottawa research center. The capability to transmit audio material only recently became available on Internet.

The FCC Field Offices were busy this week as they handed out \$51,750 in fines for various violations. In the public notice, it was nice to see what the violations were for, rather than the usual "various violations." WHSY AM & FM Hattiesburg MS got hit for \$11,300 for an incomplete public inspection file, inoperative remote control metering, and not maintaining an EBS test log (because the equipment was inoperative). Many of the fines were for public inspection files lacking program lists, inoperative EBS equipment, and the inability to observe AM transmitter metering from operating position. WHLV Hattiesburg MS was fined \$9,000 for "tower enclosure fence destroyed." Others with fines were:

The NAB announced that James Quello will receive the NAB's Distinguished Service Award March 21st in a special presentation during the opening session of NAB '94, in Las Vegas, NV. Commissioner Quello is being recognized for his service as interim FCC chairman and his many years of service as FCC Commissioner.

ELSEWHERE

Four of the stations that Clear Channel Communications was going to sell to Snowden Broadcasting are being sold off to other groups, "in a move to ultimately consummate its previous merger with Metroplex Communications," according to a press release. KQAM and KEYN-FM Wichita KS will go to Radio Management, Inc., headed by Norm Feuer and Terry Robinson, for \$2 million. KTAM and KORA Bryan TX will be sold to Springer Broadcasting, Inc. for \$2.25 million. Snowden is buying seven other stations from Clear Channel, including three in the New Haven CT market. Those three are now being challenged with a petition to deny on the basis that the sale would allegedly put Clear Channel over the ownership limits because Clear Channel owns 80% of the non-voting stock in Snowden.

Verenigde Nederlandse Uitgeversbedrijven BV (VNU) in conjunction with the BPI corporate management have agreed to acquire 100% of BPI Communications for reportedly \$220 Million. BPI is the publisher of Billboard and 18 other specialty magazines. VNU is the publisher of various women's, regional and business periodicals in Sweden. BPI was owned by various investors, including the New York Times Group and Associated Publications.

The Arbitron Company announced that it will implement its radio survey sample increase plan in an additional 85 markets effective with the Spring 1994 survey. 25 of these markets are continuously measured and will receive a 70% increase by Spring 1996. The remaining 60 markets are Spring or Spring/Fall measured markets and will receive a 40% increase by Spring 1996. Together with the 32 continuously measured markets for which full sample target increases were announced on November 15, 1993, a total of 117 markets have taken advantage of Arbitron's offer to increase their sample under the plan put forward by the company and the Radio Advisory Council on August 10, 1993.

Broadcast Equities, Inc., the parent company of StandardNews, announced that StandardNews will supply Metro Networks (over 1,000 stations) with national and international news. Metro Networks will feed back local news to StandardNews.

Sports Entertainment Network has recently had its controlling interest acquired by One-On-One Sports and will be renamed One-On-One Sports Entertainment Network. Network headquarters will be moved to Chicago by April. The company has named Richard Morley as President, Rich Pemenko as Programming Director and Chuck Duncan as VP/Director of Affiliate Relations.

"Block Group Coding" is the subject of a special session at the RAB '94 Managing Sales Conference and Executive Symposium. "Block Group Coding" enables radio stations to define their audiences in terms of highly-targeted geographic "Block groups" in which households share common social and economic characteristics, and its implications for radio in today's target-marketing environment.

Court Shakes Up FCC Policy by Gregg P. Skall, Pepper & Corazzini

Last month, the United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia handed the FCC a holiday greeting it will not soon forget. For the second straight time, in *Bechtel v FCC* it over turned the Commission's reliance on the integration credit, the heart of the comparative selection criteria employed by the FCC since issuing its 1965 Comparative Policy Statement. (The integration credit awards a preference to an applicant who proposes to have its owners work full time at the station.) In doing so it may well have set the course irrevocably to overturning other icons of Commission policy, such as its diversity criteria, whereby existing broadcasters are dealt a death blow in mutually exclusive application proceedings.

The Bechtel applicant proposed no integration of ownership within the management of the station. Rather, the applicant proposed to hire a full time professional manager, arguing that an experienced manager would provide a better radio station service to the community than she would herself - but that she would hire the best manager she could find. She argued further that FCC rule changes which no longer require a licensee to hold a station for three years, and no longer require recognition of "passive" investor broadcasters, have so eviscerated the integration criteria that it is no longer a valid indicator of station performance. Although she lost at the Commission, Bechtel appealed to the Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit.

Court Shakes Up FCC Policy (cont'd)

In last month's decision, the Court found that the FCC had not met the burden of justifying its policy. While recognizing that courts should show deference to the Commission's predictive judgments in its area of expertise, the court held that the agency must respond to challenges and be ready to consider the underlying validity of its policies. Having failed to do so, the court concluded that continued application of the integration preference is arbitrary and capricious, and therefore unlawful.

Following this case, the FCC may no longer award integration preferences unless and until it concludes a rule making by which it is able to justify the integration criteria. Based on the strong and well reasoned language of the decision, it is doubtful that the Commission would be able to do so - or that it will even try.

The implications for comparative hearings are major! There may be no further hearings for some time. The FCC or another party in the Bechtel case may ask for a rehearing by the full Court of Appeals, or may take a further appeal to the U.S. Supreme Court. Any commission decision in a rule making is likely to face requests for reconsideration and a long appeals process of its own. Until the matter is resolved, it is unclear upon what policies the FCC would make a selection between applicants.

While the court rejected all of the FCC's rationales for quantitative integrations credit, it did not attack the basis for awarding credit for local ownership, civic involvement or minority ownership. However, the Commission's policies justified awarding these preferences only as enhancements of the integration credit. Thus, they were only valid as a part of, and to the extent that the applicant received credit for integration. Without the integration credit, it is questionable whether the Commission will feel comfortable continuing to award these preferences, or whether it must hold a new rule making proceeding in order to grant them recognition without integration.

The only significant remaining criteria is diversity of media control. However, diversity is subject to the same lack of verification criticism as was the integration criteria. Moreover, there is a challenge to the diversity criteria coming soon in another case. Thus even if the Commission wanted to proceed in mutually exclusive situations, it would not know how to do so unless all but one applicant were found to be basically (legal, technical or financial) unqualified.

If upon challenge the FCC will now have to sustain with evidence any policies based upon its predictive judgments, then many of its policies are in danger. Without empirical data to back them up over time, the non-hearing minority policies of tax certificates and distress sales may be challengeable, along with the minority enhancement to the integration criteria (Congress did endorse these policies in an FCC appropriation bill, but that may not be enough to save them because of the wording of that bill.)

The silver lining in this for broadcasters is that the diversity criteria and the multiple ownership limits created by the Commission may now also be subject to successful attack. These policies are based upon the Commission's belief that they are necessary to protect the concept embodied in the 1945 Supreme Court case *Associated Press v U.S.* that the First Amendment "rests on the assumption that the widest possible dissemination of information from diverse and antagonistic sources is essential to the welfare of the public." But the Commission has conducted no empirical studies to demonstrate that these rules are effective in, or even directly related to, promoting the *Associated Press* policy and the technological, and economic developments in mass media over the last 20 years have undermined many of the assumptions which underlie the presumed nexus between them. Indeed, the clamor in Washington is to be a part of the political forces shaping the so-called "information superhighway." This new assumption underlying the coming government policies is that there will be a plethora of avenues for speech and thought. Thus the limits on broadcasting may soon be deemed artificial, and would then fall.

Ackerly Communications has announced a partnership with Century Management that will combo KJR & KLTX with KUBE in Seattle. New Century Seattle Partners will take over KJR/KLTX with Ackerly remaining as a limited partner, and will purchase KUBE from Cook Inlet Radio Partners.

Greater Media's rock ledgend WRIF Detroit will co-habit with Great American TV & Radio's WCSX Birmingham MI, with the sights on buying the classic rocker in the future.
