THREE FOR THREE. . . . John Douglas isn't leaving the L.A. market after all. Radio Business Report says Douglas will buy gospel KGFJ, Los Angeles for \$5.625 million under a new company called "Personal Achievement Radio." East-West Broadcasting has owned the station for almost a decade. But Douglas isn't stopping there. He'll also buy Spanish AC KTSJ, Pomona from American Sunrise Communications for \$875,000 and gospel KPPC, Pasadena from Universal Broadcasting for approx. \$800,000. Douglas recently sold three L.A.-area FM stations for approx. \$40 million. An interesting note: KGFJ and KPPC have overlapping coverage that, under a technical agreement between them and the FCC, requires them to accept all interference. These stations could not be licensed as the FCC rules exist today.

WIEGNER ANOTHER IN THE LIST OF GUILTY BLOCH ACCOMPLICES. . . . The U.S. Dept. of Justice put another nail in the case against former financial broadcaster Sonny Bloch as the former President of his Independent Broadcaster's Network pleaded guilty to conspiracy and wire fraud, stating that he acted with Bloch to defraud investors of almost \$21 million. Steven E. Wiegner pleaded guilty to wire fraud and conspiracy to commit wire fraud. Wiegner faces five years in prison and a \$250,000 fine. Among other things, Wiegner overstated the rates on Bloch's three radio stations and understated expenses to falsify the financial conditions of Bloch's companies.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The Commission granted Central Valley Broadcasting, Inc.'s, KAMB, Merced, CA to change status from commercial to noncommercial.

Michael Katz is stepping down as the FCC's Chief Economist, effective January 1, 1996. He's been with the Commission two years and is leaving to explore other opportunities.

Karen Gulick has been named Special Counsel to FCC General Counsel William E. Kennard. She will specialize in advising on policy and constitutional issues. She was previously with the Washington, DC law firm of Latham & Watkins.

ELSEWHERE

It may be crumbs compared to the now-sunken mega merger, but Citicasters and OmniAmerica were able to put together a deal after all. Citicasters will buy Omni's Columbus duopoly of AC WLOH and country WHOK, both Lancaster, OH; and country WLLD, Upper Arlington, OH. Citicasters already owns talker WTVN and rock WLVQ there. Terms weren't disclosed.

Pinnacle Broadcasting is buying a second FM in the Myrtle Beach market to create a duopoly there. It's picking up talker WRNN for \$550,000 from Kings Road Radio, Inc. Pinnacle already owns classic rock WYAV, Conway, SC, in that market.

Radio revenues are up for the 38th consecutive month as the industry enjoyed a four percent growth rate for October over the same month in 1994. Local revenue was up six percent while national decreased two percent. Year-to-date national and combined were up nine percent, while local dollars were up ten percent over the same period last year. Local revenue was up in every region of the country for October, with the southwest enjoying the highest growth rate of ten percent.

Arbitron's Radio Advisory Council has five new board members. Terry Bond of WIKY-FM, Evansville, IN, takes the AC non-continuously measured markets seat. Don Howe of Jacor's KBPI/KRFX, Denver, CO fills the AOR all markets spot. Chuck Morgan of KMGZ, Lawton, OK, steps in to the CHR/Top 40 non-continuously measured markets spot. KXKL-AM & FM, Denver's Robert Zuroweste handles responsibilities for Gold/Oldies all markets; and David Lykes of Tichenor's Houston duop. KLAT/KLTN, Houston, TX fills the Spanish all markets slot. Saga Communications' Chairman Steve Goldstein will serve as Chairman. KASE/KVET, Austin, TX President Ron Rogers will serve as vice chairman. RAB President Gary Fries was reappointed representative-at-large.

Radio Syndicator Jones Satellite Networks has spawned a new country format--this one is for television. JSN's parent company, Jones International Networks, will launch the "Great American Country" television network on December 31, 1995. The 24-hour cable channel will offer four minutes per hour to cable systems for local ad sales. Jones is one of the largest cable operators in the U.S.

The Electronics Industries Association is rolling into its second phase of its national Radio Data System (RDS) program. Station managers in markets 11-25 will soon receive RDS sign-up kits from the EIA which provide the opportunity for stations to receive RDS encoders, radios, and software at no cost to top-25 market FM broadcasters. Over 100 top 10 market stations have signed up so far. RDS allows broadcasters to send data streams to radios that then display the messages. The data can include ID's and station format, weather, traffic, and other information. For more info, contact Steve Hill at (212) 986-6668.

Radio & Records reports ABC Radio's The Fabulous Sports Babe is the next nationally-syndicated radio personality to sign a book deal in the lair of Harper Collins editor Judith Regan. Regan has handled books for both Howard Stern and Rush Limbaugh. The book, entitled, "The Babe in Boyland," should hit bookstore shelves sometime in 1996.

1660 KHz re-revisited... In September we reported that 1530 WJDM, Elizabeth, NJ was to begin testing on its 1660 KHz Expanded Band channel. An April article covered USA Digital Radio's digital audio broadcasting (DAB) demonstrator KUSA, which was established for the NAB's 1995 convention in Las Vegas...on 1660.

Broadcast band DXers responded with reception reports of the short-lived 10,000 watt KUSA. Chicago-based USADR has recently distributed a summary and has rewarded its sharp-eared listeners with special QSL cards. The non-directional station reached an impressive geographic area while being blessed with minimal interference in its part of the spectrum.

Two reports each were received from CA, CO, IL, MA, and NC. Single reports were contributed from FL, MO, NH, NJ, NY, OH, OR, PA, and UT, as well as Ontario, Australia, and Poggiorenatico. (No, that wasn't an April Fool spoof.) Also noted with interest was a collection of six reports from New Zealand.

EVERGREEN GETS 6 TO 12 MONTHS IN CHICAGO. . . The Commission has approved the \$300+ million merger between Evergreen Media and Pyramid Communications, but the new company didn't get everything it asked for this holiday season. The Commission wouldn't grant a twelve month waiver to allow Evergreen to acquire WNUA, Chicago. They got six months instead. The company did get a 12 month waiver of the national ownership rules which limit a company's station count per band to 20. The company has 24 FM stations, including four in Charlotte and five in Chicago. Two of the Chicago FM's must be sold by March 29, 1996 (one year after the Commission approved Evergreen's purchase of Broadcasting Partners.) Six months after this deal is closed, another Chicago FM has to go. Pyramid/Evergreen have a year to rid themselves of two Charlotte FM's. Closing is scheduled for January.

TRIATHLON'S TALE OF TWO CITIES. . . Norm Feuer's Triathlon Broadcasting is buying up two more Nebraska FM stations to cover the Omaha market. Valley Broadcasting is selling country KXKT, Omaha for \$8.125 million. Triathlon will combo that with new rock KRRK, Bennington, NE, which it's buying from 93.3, Inc. for \$2.7 million. When all of the Triathlon purchases are completed, the company will have six stations in the Omaha/Lincoln area. It currently owns country KZKX, Seward, NE and album rock KTGL, Beatrice, NE, and is buying album rock KIBZ, Lincoln and new rock KKNB, Crete, NE.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

Chancellor Broadcasting and Shamrock Broadcasting got the go-ahead from the FCC this week to merge with temporary 12-month waivers to keep three FM's in Minneapolis and one station over the national limit of 20. Closing is expected sometime during next year's first quarter.

The Commission has affirmed an action by the Mass Media Bureau which denied Kidd Communications' petition for reconsideration of the dismissal of its application to replace an expired construction permit for new station KJRC, South Lake Tahoe, CA. The Bureau held that Kidd failed to provide any new facts or changed circumstances or demonstrated that the construction permit's cancellation was based on errors of fact or law.

The Commission's Mass Media Bureau has appointed Jonathan V. Cohen to Assistant Chief for Law. Cohen joined the FCC in April, 1993, as Special Assistant to then-Chairman James Quello and was most recently Senior Counsel in the Office of Plans and Policy.

ELSEWHERE

Three Phoenix FM's that have been living together have decided to merge. New rock simulcast KEDJ, Sun City and KHOT-FM, Globe; and talk/sports KGME, Glendale, AZ will become a group that is partially-owned by some of the principals of New Century Media, which owns Seattle duop KJR-AM & FM and KUBE. Resource Media is the other partner. The two will form a company called "New Century Arizona" to manage the Phoenix stations.

Another on-again, off-again deal. This time ARS and Marlin Broadcasting have decided to slam the door on a \$50 million deal that would have put two major market stations in ARS' portfolio--classical stations WFLN-FM, Philadelphia and WQRS, Detroit. In a story in Inside Radio, ARS says the deal, which was announced in October, was only to the letter of intent stage anyway.

Wayne Gardner's Gardner Broadcasting is buying Terry Robinson's duopoly in Mobile, AL. For \$11 million, Gardner is buying country simulcast WKSJ (AM), Prichard/WKSJ-FM, Mobile, AL, as well as country sister WMYC, Mobile. This is a replacement for the deal which Triathlon called-off last week.

Stevens Broadcasting sold its contemporary Christian WJRV, Loretto, PA to Allegheny Broadcasting Corp. for \$75,000. None of the parties have any other broadcast interests. Ray Rosenblum was the broker.

Tapscan, Inc. has promoted John Barlett to General Manager of its Strategic Development Unit. He'll oversee the company's international sales efforts and marketing expansion, as well as domestic strategic relationships with data suppliers, outside service providers, and rep firms. Barlett is an eight-year veteran of the firm.

Chad Brown has been named Eastern Regional Manager and New York Sales Manager for CBS Radio Reps. He'll be responsible for the Boston and New York spot sales offices. Brown was most recently managing CBS Radio Reps' Chicago office.

Jones Satellite Networks is upgrading its satellite technology to a new digital SCPC system designed by Wegener Communications. All of its in-house format networks will make the transition beginning in May, 1996. The conversion will take approximately 14 months.

Dave Hunter has joined Jones Satellite Networks' Adult Hit format to handle morning drive. Dave has 15 years in the business in markets ranging in size from Cheyenne to Denver.

Radio and cable TV can be friends. According to a study by Interep, radio is generally part of a comprehensive media plan that can include many different mixes. Interep's EVP/Dir. Research Marla Pirner points out, "If paired wisely. . . the strengths of each are augmented, creating a media mix that exceeds the individual [strengths] possible from each separate medium." The report shows both radio and cable offer a better focus on prime demos than network television. It also shows heavy users of both radio and cable deliver a higher than average percentage of affluent households. For more info on the study, call (212) 916-0700.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

Budget squabbling has forced the U.S. Government to shut down again, leaving darkened halls at the FCC. Word is things should be settled before the new year.

It's renewal time for all AM, FM, and FM translators in Indiana, Kentucky, and Tennessee, and FM translators only in New Mexico. License renewal booklets will be mailed in mid-January. Licensees in these states should ensure their official FCC mailing address is accurate by faxing any changes of address to (202) 418-1411. Corrections must be submitted by January 5. For more info, call Claudia Patterson at the FCC at (202) 418-2780.

ELSEWHERE

Inside Radio reports broadcast deregulation is the last issue holding up the telecommunications bill. Hagglng between the House and Senate over ownership limits is the final stumbling block before the issue goes to a vote. House members are proposing no limits on radio ownership, but if you're in the top 25 markets, there must be 10 independently-owned "broadcast voices." Markets 26-100 must have six voices. Over market 100 must have three. Inside Radio believes the Senate will make a counter offer before it's all said and done.

Fritz Broadcasting will buy up its SMA partner in Saginaw-Bay City, MI to create a duopoly there. It will buy soft AC WGER-FM, Saginaw from F-B Communications for \$4.2 million. Fritz owns news-talker WSGW, Saginaw and adult hits WIOG, Bay City and has been operating WGER in an SMA since 1992. Fritz also owns stations in Toledo and Bowling Green, OH.

If you're a shortwave listener and enjoy Radio Canada International programming, you'll have to find something else soon. The Canadian Broadcasting Corporation will scrap the 50-year-old International service on March 31, 1996 to save money, putting 125 employees out the door. RCI broadcasts in eight languages to most regions of the globe, including a satellite service to Canadian troops abroad.

ELSEWHERE (cont'd)

In a surprise move, the EIA filed an application with the Commission for experimental DAB testing, using L-Band frequencies to field test the Eureka 147 digital audio system. Canada already plans to utilize the L-Band for their system. European DAB systems utilize the L-Band, as well. But, most of the U.S. L-Band frequencies are in use by the military, and the NAB has lobbied strongly for in-band, on-channel DAB. Field testing will begin in February, 1996 in San Francisco. Canada has already has plans to implement L-Band DAB in the near future.

NPR member stations can look forward to all News and Cultural programs to be delivered to them in stereo beginning January 3, 1996. NPR's board has voted to push the buttons necessary to use stereo on the programming, which has been produced in stereo, but delivered in mono. There's no truth to the rumor that they'll be favoring the left channel.

Ballots will be cast January 5, 1996 for new NAB board members as nominations were completed this past week. Twelve seats are up for grabs in each of the even numbered Districts 2-24. 27 candidates are on the ballot, six are incumbents.
